ADVERTISERS DEPLOYING **GENERATIVE** AI must obtain the necessary authorisations and licences for uploaded materials, including copyrighted and trademarked content; they must avoid prohibited input prompts and upskill "human" labour in editorial oversight and compliance to avoid employee displacement, the Advertising Standards Council of India (ASCI) said on Tuesday.

Releasing a whitepaper on generative AI along with Khaitan & Co, ASCI highlighting the opportunities, risks, and legal considerations around the use of AI in advertising. The whitepaper addresses issues such as potential copyright infringement, prevention of unlawful content, and data privacy concerns and concerns around its potential misuse and manipulation.

While it offers numerous benefits in terms of cost reducand productivity improvement, the current nascent AI landscape makes it imperative for advertisers and marketers to evaluate issues around ownership of content, data security, inherent bias, the authenticity of prompts, etc. Since AI is a trained model, there is a fair chance that advertising that uses AI will end up being non-objective,

Consumption of Use alternative power in July grows by 8.4%

THE COUNTRY'S POWER consumption grew by 8.4% to 139 billion units in July this year compared to the same month last year. In the year-ago period, power consumption stood at 128.25 billion units (BU), higher than 123.72 BU in July 2021, according to the government data. The peak power demand met, which is the highest supply in a day, rose to 208.82 GW in July 2023. The peak power supply stood at 190.35 GW in July 2022 and 200.53 GW in July 2021. The power ministry had estimated the country's electricity demand to touch 229 GW.

Power consumption was affected in March, April, May and June this year due to widespread rains in the country. Experts said that unseasonal rains in March, April, May and June affected the power consumption in the country. **PTI**

FOR DOMESTIC EXPLO-**RATION**, mining and refining of critical mineral resources used in lithium-ion batteries, a Niti Aayog report has suggested incentives by way of taxes, royalties and production-linked incentives (PLI) for the sector.

As India gradually moves toward electric vehicles (EVs) to cut its carbon footprint, the country's advanced chemistry cell manufacturing industry will need around 1,93,000 tons/annum of cathode active material to produce about 100 GWh / annum of batteries by 2030. Critical minerals and their active materials used in the production of lithium-ion batteries (LIB) account for approximately 33%-48% of the overall LIB pack cost depending on cathode chemistry and supply chain costs for mining and refining of critical minerals. The Niti report has suggested national stockpiling

The Niti Aayog report has suggested national stockpiling of refined mineral precursors used in LIB electrodes

of refined mineral precursors used in LIB electrodes. "PLI (is needed) for setting up critical mineral processing/refining units, especially for Li2CO3 / LiOH, NiSO4, CoSO4 and Spherical graphite," it said. Similarly, it added that PLI is needed to extract critical minerals through recycling LIBs.

Atomic Minerals Directorate for Exploration and Research (AMD) is carrying out exploration for lithium in potential geological domains in parts of Mandya (estimated 1,600 tons) and Yadgir districts of Karnataka. In February 2023, the Geological Survey of India established lithium inferred resources (of 5.9 million tons in the Salal-Haimana area of the Reasi District of Jammu & Kashmir.

Besides domestic explo-

ration, the Niti Aayog report suggested the government strengthen Indian missions in critical mineral-bearing foreign countries to facilitate due diligence of greenfield/brownfield mining assets, acquisition and investment by Indian companies. It has also suggested the establishment of supply chain linkages with friendly foreign countries. "G20 Critical Minerals Security Partnership" (G20-CMSP) should focus on building a resilient supply chain of critical battery minerals, including stockpiles in different member countries as per comparative advantages in extraction and processing, it said.

Key stakeholders should prioritise Critical Battery Minerals Supply Chain as a key pillar of Indo-Pacific economic framework and a key factor in diplomatic outreach with mineral-bearing foreign countries, it added.

ADVERTISERS DEPLOYING GENERATIVE AI must obtain the necessary authorisations and licences for uploaded materials, including copyrighted and trademarked content; they must avoid prohibited input prompts and upskill "human" labour in editorial oversight and compliance to avoid employee displacement, the Advertising Standards Council of India (ASCI) said on Tuesday.

Releasing a whitepaper on generative AI along with Khaitan & Co, ASCI highlighting the opportunities, risks, and legal considerations around the use of AI in advertising. The whitepaper addresses issues such as potential copyright infringement, prevention of unlawful content, and data privacy concerns and concerns around its potential misuse and manipulation.

critical minerals in EV batteries

FOR DOMESTIC EXPLO-**RATION**, mining and refining of critical mineral resources used in lithium-ion batteries, a Niti Aayog report has suggested incentives by way of taxes, royalties and production-linked incentives (PLI) for the sector.

As India gradually moves

toward electric vehicles (EVs) to cut its carbon footprint, the country's advanced chemistry cell manufacturing industry will need around 1,93,000 tons/annum of cathode active material to produce about 100 GWh / annum of batteries by 2030. Critical minerals and their active materials used in the production of lithium-ion batteries (LIB) account for approximately 33%-48% of the overall LIB pack cost depending on cathode chemistry and supply chain costs for mining and refining of critical minerals. The Niti report has suggested national stockpiling

The Niti Aayog report has suggested national stockpiling of refined mineral precursors used in LIB electrodes

of refined mineral precursors used in LIB electrodes. "PLI (is needed) for setting up critical mineral processing/refining units, especially for Li2CO3 / LiOH, NiSO4, CoSO4 and Spherical graphite," it said. Similarly, it added that PLI is needed to extract critical minerals through recycling LIBs.

Atomic Minerals Directorate for Exploration and Research (AMD) is carrying out exploration for lithium in potential geological domains in parts of Mandya (estimated 1,600 tons) and Yadgir districts of Karnataka. In February 2023, the Geological Survey of India established lithium inferred resources (of 5.9 million tons in the Salal-Haimana area of the

Reasi District of Jammu & Kashmir.

Besides domestic explo-

ration, the Niti Aayog report suggested the government strengthen Indian missions in critical mineral-bearing foreign countries to facilitate due diligence of greenfield/brownfield mining assets, acquisition and investment by Indian companies. It has also suggested the establishment of supply chain linkages with friendly foreign countries. "G20 Critical Minerals Security Partnership" (G20-CMSP) should focus on building a resilient supply chain of critical battery minerals, including stockpiles in different member countries as per comparative advantages in extraction and processing, it said.

Key stakeholders should prioritise Critical Battery Minerals Supply Chain as a key pillar of Indo-Pacific economic framework and a key factor in diplomatic outreach with mineral-bearing foreign countries, it added.


