बाजारात जूनमध्ये आतापर्यंत १३,६६७ कोटींची गुंतवणूक

मुंबई - विदेशी गुंतवणूक संस्थांनी जूनमध्ये आतापर्यंत भारतीय शेअर बाजारात १३,६६७ कोटींची गुंतवणूक केली आहे. त्यामुळे शेअर बाजारांनी विदेशी गुंतवणूकदारांना आकर्षित करणे चालूच ठेवल्याचे दिसते. तथापि, बाजारातील तज्ज्ञांनी सांगितले की, विदेशी गुंतवणूक संस्थांनी या आठवड्यात शेअर बाजारातून पैसे ही घेतले आहेत. शेअर बाजाराच्या आकडेवारीनुसार विदेशी गुंतवणूक संस्थांनी १ ते १८ जून या कालावधीत १५,३१२ कोटी रु.ची गुंतवणूक केली.

भारत हरित हायड्रोजनवर दोन दिवसांची परिषद घेणार

नवी दिल्ली - भारताने हरित हायड्रोजनसाठी पुढाकार घेतला असून दोन दिवसांची ब्रिक्स परिषद आयोजित केली आहे. ही परिषद २२ आणि २३ जून रोजी होणार आहे. हरित हायड्रोजनसाठी पुढाकार घेणाऱ्या देशांकडून त्याची पुढील पातळी कशी गाठणार आहेत, यावर विचार करण्यासाठी ही परिषद असणार आहे. ही परिषद व्हिडिओ कॉन्फरन्सद्वारे होणार आहे, असे एनटीपीसीने एका निवेदनात म्हटले आहे.

कोरोना संकटामुळे काही काळ जीवन विमा नफ्यावर परिणाम

नवी दिल्ली - कोरोनाच्या दुसऱ्या लाटेमुळे देशांतर्गत जीवन विमा उध्द्योगावर दबाव असल्याने त्यांच्या नफ्यावरही काही काळ परिणाम होऊ शकतो. कारण कोरोनाच्या तिसऱ्या लाटेचा इशारा देण्यात आला आहे, असे आयसीआयसीआय प्रुडेन्शियल लाईफने आपल्या अहवालात म्हटले आहे.

लेदर आणि उत्पादनाच्या निर्यातीत मोठी वाढ

नवी दिल्ली - लेदर आणि त्यांच्या उत्पादनाच्या आणि पादत्राणांच्या देशाच्या निर्यातीत एप्रिल आणि मे २०२१ मध्ये मोठी वाढ झाली असून ती ६४१.७२ दशलक्ष अमेरिकन डॉलर इतकी झाली आहे. तर गेल्या वर्षी वरील कालावधीत ती १४६.७९ दशलक्ष डॉलर निर्यात झाली होती, असे कौन्सिल फॉर लेदर एक्सपोर्ट (सीएलई)ने म्हटले आहे. तसेच ही वाढ आगामी महिन्यातही कायम राहिल, असा अंदाज व्यक्त करण्यात आला.

पीएनबी हाऊसिंगने चार हजार कोटीचे प्रेफेरेन्शियल शेअरचे वितरण थांबवावे

सिक्युरिटीज अँड एक्सचेंज बोर्ड ऑफ इंडिया (सेबी)ने पीएनबी हाऊसिंग फायनान्स कंपनीला चार हजार कोटीचे प्रेफेरेन्शियल इश्यू शेअर कार्टील्ले ग्रुप कंपनीला वितरित करण्याचे थांबवावे, असा आदेश दिला आहे. बाजार नियामक 'सेबी'ने कंपनीला यासंदर्भातील पत्र १८ जून रोजी पाठविले असून त्यात कायदेशीर तरतुदींचे पालन करण्याचे आवाहन करण्यात आले आहे.

सेबीने या पत्रात पुढे म्हटले आहे की, कंपनीचे संचालक मंडळ प्रेफेरेन्शियल शेअर आणि वॉरंट संबंधित कंपनीला वितरित करण्याचा निर्णय घेताना या पत्राचा विचार करील.

तर पीएनबी हाऊसिंग फायनान्स कंपनीने शेअर बाजाराला कळविलेल्या पत्रात म्हटले आहे की,

बाजार नियामक 'सेबी'चा आदेश, चार हजार कोटींच्या कार्टील्ले व्यवहारातील समभागधारकांचा मत देण्याचा अधिकार रद्द

कंपनी आणि त्यांचे संचालक मंडळ सेबीच्या पत्राचा विचार केला आहे.

तसेच सेबीच्या नियमांचे पालन करत असून प्रेफेरेन्शियल शेअर वितरित करण्याचा निर्णय कंपनी, तिचे समभागधारक आणि संबंधित हिस्साधारक यांच्या हितासाठी घेतला होता.

यासंदर्भात कंपनी करावयाच्या उपाययोजनांचे मूल्यमापन करत आहे, असेही या पत्रात म्हटले आहे.

३१ मे रोजी पीएनबी हाऊसिंग फायनान्स कंपनीने जाहीर केले होते की, त्यांच्या संचालक मंडळाने

कार्टील्ले ग्रुपशी संबंधित कंपनीकडून चार हजार कोटी रुपयांचे भांडवल उभारण्यास मंजुरी दिली आहे.

दरम्यान, अगदी दुर्लभ अशी कारवाई करत 'सेबी'ने पीएनबी हाऊसिंग फायनान्सला चार हजार कोटी रुपयांच्या कार्टील्ले ग्रुप सोबतच्या प्रस्तावित व्यवहारातील सदस्यांना मत देण्याचा अधिकार रद्द करण्याची कारवाई केली आहे.

तसेच संबंधित कायदेशीर नियमांच्या तरतुदीनुसार मूल्यमापन प्रक्रिया सुरू करण्याचे आदेश दिले



आहेत. या व्यवहारासंदर्भातील ठरावावर समभागधारक २२ जून रोजी मतदान करणार आहेत. पंजाब नॅशनल बँकेची उपकंपनी असलेल्या पीएनबी हाऊसिंग फायनान्सवर कार्टील्ले ग्रुप हिस्सा वाढवून ताबा घेण्याचा प्रयत्न असल्याची चर्चा सुरू झाल्यानंतर आणि यासंदर्भात चिंता व्यक्त करण्यात आल्यानंतर सेबी आणि भारतीय रिझर्व्ह बँकेच्या रडारवर हा व्यवहार आला.

केर्न प्रकरण : एअर इंडिया जुलैच्या मध्यापर्यंत आव्हान देऊ शकते

एअर इंडियाला जुलैच्या मध्यापर्यंत आव्हान देण्यास वेळ आहे. गेल्या वर्षी डिसेंबरमध्ये भारत सरकार विरोधातील खटला ब्रिटनच्या केर्न एअरजी कंपनीने जिंकला. अमेरिकेच्या फेडरल न्यायालयात केलेल्या खटल्यात केर्न एअरजीला भारत सरकारने १.२६ अब्ज डॉलर देण्याचा आदेश देण्यात आला होता, असे सूत्रांनी सांगितले. एअर इंडिया ही भारत सरकारची कंपनी आहे. त्यामुळे न्यायालयाने लढावाच्या निकालापोटी धाव्याची नुकसान भरपाईपोटी

एअर इंडियाला जबाबदार धरण्यात यावे, असा युक्तीवाद केर्न एअरजीने न्यायालयात केला होता. तीन सदस्यीय आंतरराष्ट्रीय लढावात भारताने नियुक्त केलेल्या एका न्यायाधीशाचा समावेश होता. केर्न एअरजीकडून पूर्वीलकी प्रभावाने कर वसूल करण्यासाठी आणि त्यासाठी विकण्यात आलेले असेल, लाभांश परत करण्याची मागणी भारत सरकारने केली होती. भारत सरकारने गेली चार वर्षे सुनावणीत सहभाग घेऊनही लढावाचा निर्णय मान्य केला नाही. तसेच लढावाचा निर्णय रद्द करण्यासाठी नेदरलँडमध्ये याचिका दाखल केली आहे.

कर्मचारी भविष्य निर्वाह निधीत एप्रिलमध्ये १२.७६ लाख सदस्यांची भर

ईपीएफओ म्हणजेच कर्मचारी भविष्य निर्वाहनिधी कार्यालयाच्या बंद आज (२० जून रोजी) संपिड झालेल्या वेतनपटाच्या तात्पुरत्या माहितीनुसार एप्रिल २०२१ या महिन्यात ईपीएफओमध्ये एकूण १२.७६ लाख कर्मचारी सदस्यांची भर पडली आहे. कोविड-१९ महामारीच्या दुसऱ्या लाटेचा कालखंड असतानाही एप्रिल २०२१ मध्ये

आधीच्या महिन्याशी तुलना करता सभासदांच्या एकूण संख्येत १३.७३ टक्क्यांनी वाढ झाली आहे. मागील महिन्यात वेतनपटाची सभासद संख्या ११.२२ लाखांनी वाढली होती. डेटानुसार मार्च २०२१ च्या तुलनेत एप्रिल २०२१ मधील सभासद संख्या ८७.८२११ ने कमी झाली होती तर पुनःसदस्यत्व घेणाऱ्यांची संख्या १२.८६४ ने वाढली होती. एप्रिल महिन्यात वेतन पटवार

दाखल झालेल्या १२.७६ लाख एकूण सदस्यांपैकी सुमारे ६.८९ लाख हे नवीन सदस्य असून कर्मचारी भविष्य निर्वाह निधीच्या सामाजिक सुरक्षेचा लाभ त्यांना प्रथमच मिळत आहे. एकूण ५.८६ लाख सभासद कर्मचारी भविष्य निर्वाहनिधीतून बाहेर पडले पण आपली नोकरी बदलून कर्मचारी भविष्य निर्वाह निधीची सुरक्षा असलेल्या दुसऱ्या नोकरीत ते दाखल झाले आहेत. या प्रक्रियेत अंतिम हिशोबा

एवजी त्यांनी निधी बदल करून सदस्यत्व कायम राखण्याचा मार्ग अवलंबला. वेतन पटवारतील संख्येची राज्यनिहाय तुलना करता असे दिसून येते की महाराष्ट्र, हरियाणा, गुजरात, तामिळनाडू आणि कर्नाटक या राज्यांमध्ये मिळून महिन्याभरात सभासद संख्येत ७.५८ लाखांनी वाढ झाली. ही संख्यावाढ वेतन पटवारील सर्व वयोगटातील सदस्य संख्येतील एकूण वाढीच्या ९९.४१७ आहे.

खाद्यतेलावरील आयात शुल्क कमी करण्याचा निर्णय झालाच नाहीच

गेल्या काही महिन्यांपासून देशात खाद्यतेलांच्या (एवळलश्रश जळडी) किमतीत चांगलीच वाढ होत असलेली दिसत आहे. कोरोना साधीच्या संकटामुळे आर्थिक चणचणीला तोंड देणाऱ्या सर्वसामान्य जनतेचे घरखर्चाचे बजेट याने कोलमडले आहे. या पार्श्वभूमीवर तेलाच्या किमती कमी करण्यासाठी उपाययोजना करण्याची मागणी होत होती. त्यामुळे खाद्य तेलाच्या किमती कमी होण्याची अपेक्षा निर्माण झाली होती; मात्र या निर्णयाची अंमलबजावणी करण्यापूर्वीच त्याला स्थगिती देण्यात आली. वृत्तानुसार, यामागचे मुख्य कारण आहे आंतरराष्ट्रीय बाजारपेठेत पामतेल तसेच अन्य खाद्य तेलाच्या किमतीत होणारी वाढ. गेल्या दहा दिवसात जागतिक बाजारपेठेत खाद्यतेलाच्या किमती ६ ते ८ टक्क्यांनी कमी झाल्या आहेत. तर महिन्याभरात चार वेळा पामतेलाच्या किमतीत मोठी घसरण झाली आहे.

देशांतर्गत खाद्यतेलाच्या किमती घटत आहेत, गेल्या काही दिवसात खाद्यतेलाच्या किमती २० टक्क्यांनी कमी झाल्या आहेत. त्यामुळे सरकारने आयातशुल्क कपातीच्या निर्णयाला स्थगिती देण्याचा विचार केला. आंतरराष्ट्रीय बाजारपेठेत तेलाच्या किमतीत होणाऱ्या घसरणीमुळे देशातील तेलाबिघा उत्पादक शेतकऱ्यांमध्ये चिंतेचे वातावरण निर्माण होऊ नये, त्यांच्यामध्ये प्रतिकूल संदेश जाऊ नये यासाठी आयातशुल्क कमी करण्याचा निर्णय तूर्त पुढे ढकलण्याची मागणी देशातील तेल उत्पादक कंपन्यांनी सरकारला केली होती. या हंगामातील तेलबिघांची लागवड पूर्ण झाल्यानंतरच आयात शुल्क कपात करणं योग्य ठरेल असा या क्षेत्रात सुचवलेला होत. सध्या कोरोना संकटामुळे लोकडाउन, निर्बंध यामुळे हॉटेल्स, रेस्टॉरंट्स बंद आहेत. त्यामुळे खाद्यतेलाची मागणीही घटली आहे. त्यातच किमती अधिकच कमी झाल्या तर त्याचा फटका तेल उद्योगाला बसेल त्यामुळेही आयात शुल्क कमी करण्याच्या निर्णयाचा फेरविचार करावा अशी मागणी होत होती. या सगळ्या पार्श्वभूमीवर

सरकारने अखेर या निर्णयाला स्थगिती दिली आहे. आंतरराष्ट्रीय बाजारपेठेतील तेलाच्या किमतीत होणारी घट, मागणी आणि पुरवठा या सगळ्या बाबींवर लक्ष ठेवण्यात येत असून, परिस्थितीचा आढावा घेऊन आयात शुल्क कपातीचा फेरनिर्णय घेण्यात येईल, असे अधिकारी सूत्रांनी म्हटले आहे. भारताची दोन तृतीयांश खाद्यतेलाची गरज आयातीतून पूर्ण होते. देशात पामतेलाच्या आयातीवर ३२.५ टक्के शुल्क आकारले जाते, तर कच्चे सोयाबीन आणि सोयाबीन तेलावर ३५ टक्के आयात शुल्क आकारले जाते. इंडोनेशिया, मलेशियाकडून पाम तेल आयात केले जाते तर ऑर्जेन्टोना, ब्राझील, रशिया, युकेन यांच्याकडून सोयाबीन आणि सूर्यफूल तेल आयात केले जाते. सध्या या तेलांच्या किमतीत घसरण होत आहे. परिणामी देशात आयात होणाऱ्या तेलाचा खर्चही कमी होणार असल्याने देशांतर्गत बाजारपेठेत तेलाचे दर उतरत आहेत. त्यामुळे आगामी काळातही खाद्यतेलाचे दर कमी होण्याचा कल कायम राहण्याची शक्यता आहे.

सर्वसामान्यांना दणका; पेट्रोल-डिझेल पुन्हा महागले

एकीकडे देशात कोरोनाचे संकट आणि लोकडाऊनच्या निर्बंधांमुळे आर्थिक संकट देखील ओढवलेले असताना सामान्यांना पेट्रोल-डिझेल दरावाढीने दणका दिला आहे. देशात झालेल्या पाच राज्यांच्या निवडणुकांच्या आधी आणि त्यानंतर मोठ्या प्रमाणावर पेट्रोल आणि डिझेलच्या किमती वाढल्या आहेत. आता तर पेट्रोलने काही भागांमध्ये शंभरी देखील गाठली आहे. त्यामध्ये महाराष्ट्राची राजधानी आणि देशाची आर्थिक राजधानी असा गौरव मिळवणाऱ्या मुंबईचा देखील समावेश आहे. त्यामुळे देशाचे किंवा राज्याचे बजेट नेतेमंडळी काय करतील ते करतील, पण आपले घराचे महिन्याचे बजेट कस सांभाळायचे? असा प्रश्न सामान्यांसमोर उभा राहिला आहे. रिविचारी सामान्यांना हा प्रश्न अधिक कठीण बनला कारण सर्वसामान्यांना पुन्हा इटका बसला तो पेट्रोल-डिझेल दरावाढीचा! काल पेट्रोल-डिझेलच्या दरात वाढ न होता ते स्थिर राहिल्यामुळे



दर कमी होण्याची काहीशी आशा निर्माण झालेली असतानाच आज, रिविचारी पुन्हा दरावाढ झाली. देशाची राजधानी दिल्लीमध्ये रिविचारी पेट्रोल प्रति लिटर १७ रुपये २२ पैसे तर डिझेल प्रति लिटर ८७ रुपये ९७ पैसे दराने विकले जात आहे. दुसरीकडे आर्थिक राजधानी मुंबईमध्ये पेट्रोलसाठी मुंबईकरांना प्रति लिटर १०३ रुपये ३६ पैसे तर डिझेलसाठी ९५ रुपये ४४ पैसे मोजावे लागत आहेत. भोपाळमध्ये हेच दर अनुक्रमे १०५ रुपये ४३ पैसे आणि ९६ रुपये ६५ पैसे इतके आहेत. तर दुसरीकडे पाटण्यामध्ये अनुक्रमे ९९ रुपये २८ पैसे आणि ९३ रुपये ३० पैसे दर झाले आहेत. गेल्या महिन्याभरात देशातील

अनेक शहरांमध्ये पेट्रोल दरांनी शंभरी गाठली आहे. राज्यांच्या राजधान्यांमध्ये सर्वात आधी भोपाळमध्ये पेट्रोल दरांनी शंभरी पार केली. त्यापाठोपाठ जयपूर आणि मुंबईने देखील आपला नंबर लावला. आता या यादीमध्ये हैदराबाद आणि बंगळूरुचा देखील समावेश झाला आहे. आठ राज्ये - केंद्रशासित प्रदेशांमध्ये पेट्रोल दरांची शंभरी राज्यांचा विचार करता गेल्या दीड ते दोन महिन्यांत झालेल्या पेट्रोल दरावाढीमुळे देशातील ८ राज्ये आणि केंद्रशासित प्रदेशांमध्ये पेट्रोलचे भाव शंभरीच्या वर गेले आहेत. यामध्ये राजस्थान, मध्य प्रदेश, महाराष्ट्र, आंध्र प्रदेश, तेलंगणा, कर्नाटक, जम्मू-काश्मीर आणि लडाख यांचा समावेश आहे. एका आकडेवारीनुसार भारत-पाकिस्तान सीमेवरील राजस्थानमधील श्री गंगानगर जिल्हा पेट्रोलचे दर शंभरीपार नेणारा देशातला पहिला जिल्हा ठरला आहे. गेल्या महिन्यात तर तिथे डिझेल देखील प्रति लिटर १०० रुपयांचे वर जाऊन पोहोचले होते.

All Covid-19 deaths certified, but no ex gratia: Centre to SC

To tackle reports of the huge discrepancy in India's Covid-19 death toll, the Centre has submitted an 183-page affidavit to the Supreme Court, promising it will ensure all Covid-19 deaths are certified and take action against doctors who fail to comply with this rule.

Reports have emerged from 6 states showing huge inconsistencies in the fatality figures seen at morgues and crematoriums versus the deaths registered. Till now, the Centre only accounted for the deaths of Covid-19 patients in hospitals. Those who died at home or even at the hospital parking lot before testing were not certified as Covid deaths.

"All deaths with a diagnosis of Covid-19, irrespective of co-morbidities, are to be classified as deaths due to Covid-19. The only exception could be where there is a clear alternative cause of death, that cannot be attributed to Covid-19 (eg accidental trauma, poisoning, acute myocardial infarction, etc), where Covid-19 is an incidental finding," the affidavit filed by the MHA office stated.



INDIA RECORDS 58,419 CASES

NEW DELHI: India recorded less than 60,000 new coronavirus infections after 81 days taking the total tally of cases to 2,98,81,965, while the active cases further reduced to 7,29,243, as per the Union Health Ministry data on Sunday. A total of 58,419 fresh infections were reported in a day. The death toll climbed to 3,86,713 with 1,576 fresh fatalities, the lowest in 63 days. The active cases declined to 7,29,243 comprising 2.44% of the total infections, while the national Covid-19 recovery rate improved to 96.27%, the data showed.

The biggest inconsistency was seen in Bihar, where some 75,000 people died of unexplained circumstances, with symptoms like that Covid. Other states including Madhya Pradesh, Andhra, Tamil Nadu, Karnataka, and Delhi have also shown discrepancies in their death figures, amounting to 4.8 lakh excess deaths in the 5 states.

In response to 2 PILs seeking "minimum standards of relief" and a Rs4 lakh ex gratia to the kin of all Covid-19 deceased, the Centre told the Supreme Court taking such a step would mean exhausting all disaster relief funds and would be "unfair" to cash-strapped states.

Corona wave depends on virus mutation, human error: AIIMS doc

NEW DELHI: With overall Covid-19 cases in India declining consistently over the past few weeks, several states have started easing Covid restrictions, and crowds have started swelling in the markets, where people could be seen not wearing masks and flouting Covid appropriate behaviour that could lead to an increase in cases again.

"In any pandemic, the wave depends on two important factors: One is virus related and second is human-related factors," said Dr Neeraj Nischal, assistant professor department of Medicine AIIMS, New Delhi.

Virus mutation is not in someone's hand but appropriate behaviour can avoid a surge in Covid cases. "Now virus mutates and becomes more infectious. It is something which is beyond our control. But of course, if we do not allow this virus to replicate in our body then maybe this type of mutations can be avoided. What we can do to control is our behaviour. We have been talking about Covid appropriate behaviour for 15-16 months and we know that by Covid appropriate behaviour, one can stop these waves altogether. That had happened in the second wave also," he said.

Cattle 'theft': 3 lynched in Tripura

As many as 10 people were arrested allegedly for knocking down a self-styled cow vigilante by a tempo truck illegally carrying cattle in South Gujarat's Valsad district. In a press release, the Valsad Police on Saturday evening stated the arrested persons were part of an interstate network under which cattle from villages in Valsad were purchased and transported illegally to Bhiwandi, Ahmednagar and Nashik in Maharashtra.

The incident took place on the Dharampur-Valsad road early on Friday morning when 29-year-old Hardik Kansara, a self-styled cow vigilante and local VHP volunteer, tried to stop the cattle-laden vehicle.

Acting on a tip-off a tempo truck carrying cattle began from Barsol village in Valsad's Dharampur taluka towards Bhiwandi, Kansara, his two associates and a police team followed the vehicle. They tried to stop the vehicle by blocking the road but the tempo ran over Kansara, who died on the spot, police said. The tempo driver fled leaving behind his vehicle, carrying 11 animals.

An FIR was lodged at Durgri police station and 10 people, including the tempo owner, driver, and others involved in the illegal transportation of cattle, were arrested from different places.

AGARTALA: Three people were allegedly lynched in the Khowai district of Tripura on suspicion of cattle theft in the early hours of Sunday, police said. Villagers of Namanjyopara spotted a mini-truck heading towards Agartala, carrying 5 cattle, around 4.30 am, SP Kiran Kumar said.

They chased it and managed to stop the vehicle near North Maharipur village. The villagers started thrashing the 3 persons on the mini-truck with "lethal weapons", and lynched two of them, while the other managed to flee, he said.

The mob got hold of the other person at Mungiakami, a tribal hamlet near North Maharipur, and he was lynched there, the officer added. Police reached the two locations immediately and took them first to a nearby hospital and then to the Agartala Government Medical College where the attending doctors declared they were brought dead, Kumar said.

VHP leader held in 2018 Alwar lynching

JAIPUR: A local Vishva Hindu Parishad leader was arrested for his alleged role in the lynching of Rakbar alias Akbar Khan for cattle smuggling in Rajasthan's Alwar in 2018, police said on Sunday. This is the fifth arrest by the Ramgarh Police in the case. Police had filed a charge sheet against Paramjeet Singh, Naresh Sharma, Vijay Kumar and Dharmendra Yadav in 2019. Final arguments are yet to be heard by the court. Alwar SP Tejaswini Gautam said VHP leader Naval Kishore Sharma was arrested 3-4 days ago by the Ramgarh Police and the case was being probed by an ASP-rank officer.

On Father's Day, Chirag announces yatra to mark dad's birthday on July 5

Amid the ongoing tussle for control of the LJP, Chirag Paswan on Sunday (incidentally Father's Day), said he would hold a road show across Bihar on his late father's birth anniversary on July 5. "My father and uncle are 'not' with me anymore, so we've decided to take out 'Sangharsh Yatra' from July 5 from Hajipur. The yatra will pass through all districts. We need more love and blessings from people," Chirag said. He wants to reach the grassroots to establish mass contact.



It was at Hajipur from where his father was elected to Lok Sabha in 1977 with a record margin and earned a berth in Guinness Book. Chirag made the announcement after presiding over a meet of the national executive of the party which he claimed was attended by representatives from 12 states and 90% members of the executive committee. In 2019 LS poll, Ram Vilas did not contest the election from Hajipur and instead fielded Paras, Ram Vilas was a Rajya Sabha member. LJP working committee members expressed their faith in the leadership of Chirag Paswan. Leaders asked the Election Commission not to allow the Paras group to use LJP symbol, bungalow and flag.

LJP workers under Chirag's leadership would cover all villages in 3 months and would help the authorities in flood relief in North Bihar too. Chirag directed workers to help the government make the vaccination drive a success. LJP executive passed a resolution urging PM Modi to honour Ram Vilas posthumously with Bharat Ratna for his 50-year stint as a legislator and parliamentarian. He was first elected to Bihar assembly in 1969. Paswan died on Oct 8, 2020. LJP executive committee passed a resolution denouncing the action of another group led by Chirag's uncle, Pashupati Kumar Paras in splitting the party and "wrongfully" staking claim over the LJP parliamentary party. A delegation of faction led by Chirag called on the Lok Sabha Speaker, Om Birla in New Delhi late on Saturday evening and sought review of the decision to recognise Paras as leader of the LJP parliamentary party. Of 6 LJP members in LS, 5 have expressed solidarity with Paras and Chirag is isolated.

IT rules framed post talks with stakeholders, India tells UN

NEW DELHI: The Permanent Mission of India to the United Nations Office has responded to the concerns raised by Special Procedures Branch of the Human Rights Council regarding India's new IT norms, wherein the Permanent Mission has stressed that India's democratic credentials are well recognised and the new norms were finalised after due consultation with various stakeholders.

The letter by the Mission said: "The Ministry of Electronics and Information Technology and Ministry of Information and Broadcasting undertook broad consultations in 2018 with various stakeholders, including individuals, civil society, industry association and organisations and invited public comments to prepare the draft Rules."

Thereafter an inter-ministerial meeting had discussed in detail the comments received and, accordingly, the rules were finalised. It also told the UN arm: "India's democratic credentials are well recognised."

The right to freedom of speech and expression is guaranteed under the Indian Constitution, the Permanent Mission of India said in its letter, adding the independent judiciary and a robust media are part of India's democratic structure. "The Permanent Mission of India requests that the enclosed information may be brought to the attention of the concerned Special Rapporteurs," it said.

Sedition case: Lakshadweep cops quiz filmmaker Aisha Sultana for over 3 hrs

KAVARATTI: Filmmaker Aisha Sultana, facing sedition charges in Lakshadweep, on Sunday appeared before the Kavaratti police in connection with the case. She reached the Kavaratti police headquarters at 4 pm and was allowed to leave at 7.15 pm after a long session of questioning for 3 hours.

In a video message to reporters, Sultana said the police were cooperative and she has been directed to stay on the islands for 3-4 days.

It has been alleged that the filmmaker, while participating in a debate telecast by a Malayalam news channel on June 7, had said the Centre used "biological weapon" against the people of Lakshadweep.

Putting an end to speculation, Pakistani National Security Adviser Moeed Yusuf said there is "no possibility" of a bilateral meeting with his Indian counterpart Ajit Doval on the sidelines of the Shanghai Cooperation Organization (SCO) meet in Dushanbe.

Doval and Yusuf will be attending the 16th meeting of the Secretaries of the Security Council, SCO in Dushanbe (Tajikistan). This will be an in-person meet from June 23-24. Tajikistan is the chair of the grouping. The participation of both Pakistani and Indian NSAs in the session set off speculation of a likely meeting.

However, Yusuf told Pakistan's 'Dawn': "There is absolutely no possibility of any bilateral meeting with Indian counterpart at SCO.

How the Kota cookie crumbled due to Covid

The Covid onslaught has taken its toll on the coaching hub of the country in Kota. Hardly 10-15 per cent students had stayed back and the entire set up is on the verge of a collapse. Around one lakh people engaged directly or indirectly due to the coaching hub have lost their livelihood. The estimated worth of the edu hub was pegged around Rs 1200 crore before Covid which has now reduced to nearly one-fourth of its value.



Kota was an industrial city of Rajasthan, but for the last four decades it has turned out to be a premier coaching centre of the country. Aspiring students who dream of getting admitted to premium technical and medical institutes of the country, come here to prepare themselves. Around 1.50 lakh students from all over the country register themselves at various institutes. But now the town wears a desolate look.

Kota's 70 per cent economy depends on these students, who spend around Rs 2 to 2.50 lakh rupees per annum.

tels, more than 25,000 PGs, 1,800 mess and a large number of cafes, tiffin centres, breakfast stalls and other businesses with students at the epicentre. Some residents of the city have converted their homes into hostels and PGs and the coaching industry covers three big areas of the city.

"It is like a nightmare for us when hundreds and thousands of students left Kota in fear and haste. The city's economy has crumbled. Hardly 10% hostels and PGs have students. Around 80 per cent employees working in these hostels have lost their jobs and we are facing huge difficulty in repaying our loans," said Naveen Mittal, president of Kota hostel association.

Around 80 per cent mess

which provided food to students have rolled down their shutters. The president of the Mess Association of Kota Jashmesh Singh said, "thousands of people are now unemployed and have migrated to their home towns. We cannot run a mess for 4-5 students, so most of them have down their shutters."

The hope of revival lasts for two months only: Almost 90 per cent students had left Kota last year during the first wave. Different states had run special buses and trains to take away their students from the city. This January we saw some hopes of revival. Around 45000 students had come to Kota in the first two months of 2021 when admission were on at the coaching institutes and people here were hoping for a good

"harvest." But their hopes lasted only two months. The second wave was more horrifying and students had to leave as offline classes and other facilities were shut due to the lockdown imposed in April. The lockdown has been relaxed a bit, but offline classes have not resumed yet. **Online mode has kept us afloat:** There 10 mega, 50 small and individual coaching institutes in Kota. After being mauled by covid-19, the online mode of education has kept the business alive and afloat. One of the representatives of the institutes said on condition of anonymity that admissions have decreased but they are charging for online classes and at the same time their expenses of running offline classes have reduced considerably.

It will take around two years to get back on track: "We are hoping for better times. Students also aren't comfortable with online classes. I have talked to many students and they want of fine classes to resume. We are urging the state government to reopen the institutes but it will take around two years for us to get back on track," said Naveen Mittal.

4 tiger cubs spotted in Ranthambore
