For the six months ended 30th September 2019, total revenue went up by 47% to Rs. 141.53 crore. H1 Profit after tax shot up

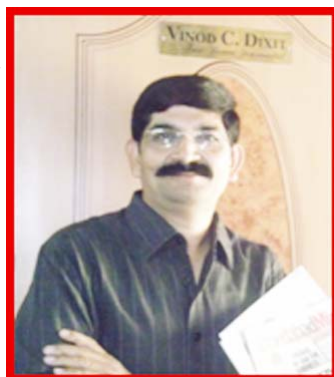
by 66.7% to Rs. 13.21 crore. EPS was reported at Rs. 5.56.
