Karnataka min to quit over contractor death

Eshwarappa is facing charges of abetment to suicide

Karnataka Minister K S Eshwarappa, who is facing charges of abetment to suicide in connection with the death of civil contractor Santosh K Patil in Udupi, on Thursday, announced his resignation, ending days of defiance.

Addressing a press meet in Shivamogga, Eshwarappa said, "I have served as the Rural Development and Panchayat Raj Minister in the Karnataka government. I have taken a decision today to resign from my ministerial position." He further said he would tender his resignation letter to Chief Minister Basavaraj Bommai on Friday.

"I decided to resign because I don't want to put those who helped me rise to this position, like CM Basavaraj Bommai and our national leaders, in an uncomfortable situation," Eshwarappa said. "I will go to Bengaluru tomorrow and tender my resignation to Bommai," he added.

The announcement comes a day after he was named in the FIR registered in connec-

tion with the death of Patil, who had charged Eshwarappa with corruption. Asked whether there was any pressure from the party high command, Eshwarappa said he has spoken to those he was supposed to.

Meanwhile, opposition Congress stepped up its attack

on the Eshwarappa demanding his arrest as the next step. Bommai, meanwhile, clarified that Eshwarappa decided to resign on his own and there was no pressure from the party high command. "There was no pressure from the party high command. He has morality, he has decided on his own to resign," Bommai said.

The CM also said that Eshwarappa has asked him to complete the investigation into Patil's death at the earliest. "Eshwarappa has said truth will prevail and he will come out clean. Till then he wished not to continue in his position." On Congress' criticism over the issue, the CM said the opposition party had no moral rights to comment on the matter.

Stepping up pressure, Congress said mere resignation will not do and sought his arrest. "The abetment to suicide is a heinous crime and not just a non-bailable offence. In all heinous crimes, accused person should be arrested but in Eshwarappa's case it has not happened," Leader of Opposition in the assembly, Siddaramaiah, said.

At 413 mn, Rlys ticket bookings still 61% of pre-Covid levels

Hit by Covid waves and slow-down, the Indian Railways has still not been able to return to its pre-pandemic passenger traffic, data by Ministry of Railways has revealed.

In February, the national transporter received 413 million ticket bookings — 43 per cent higher than the previous year, but only 61 per cent of the 675 million in February 2020. According to the statistics, that was the last time the Railways saw more than 500 million bookings in a single month.

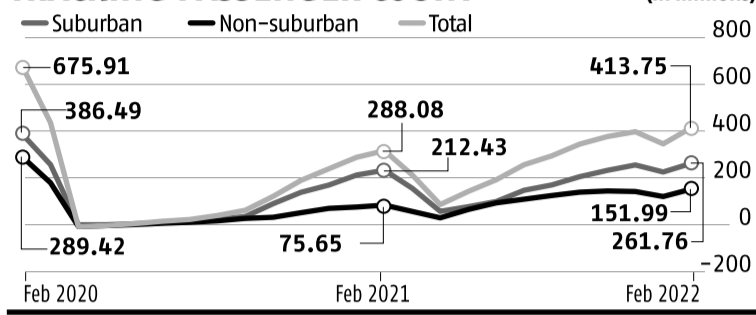
In the 2019-20 financial year, Railways received 8,109 million bookings, including suburban and non-suburban segments, which roughly average at 675 million bookings a month. In 2020-21, annual bookings received dropped to 1,250 million — a low of 104.5 million monthly bookings.

While April and May 2020 had seen a complete shutdown of railway services, the ensuing months also saw muted booking activity (see chart), driving the low figures.

In 2021-22, up to February, the national transporter received 3,204 million bookings at an average of 291 million. The ministry had an annual target of 8,594 million passengers in the Budget, which it had to revise down to 3,533 million later. Data shows that by the beginning

of the last fiscal year, passenger demand had increased almost eightfold in seven months, which fell sharply again after the second wave. While a return to normalcy following the Delta wave reflected in higher ticket bookings, a comparison of July 2021-February 2022 with the corresponding period two years ago shows a significant gap.

"The difference between pre-pandemic and current figures is definitely concerning. Recovery of Railways is

slower than many other sectors. While trade and work-related travel and tourism have declined, roughly 80 per cent of the passengers come from unreserved sections and general class. The gap could not have been that high without the general segment population avoiding travel," a sector expert said, requesting anonymity.

The Ministry of Railways, however, believes that the annual recovery is encouraging. "During the pandemic, train services were briefly

suspended, especially in unreserved class. Slowly those are being reconstituted. As we return to 100 per cent capacity, passenger booking numbers will return to pre-pandemic levels. In reserved classes, we are introducing new services such as 400 Vande Bharat trains, which will augur well for travellers. In view of this, we are poised to have much better numbers in the passenger sector overall — evident from the 43 per cent increase in passenger bookings since last year," Gaurav Krishna Bansal, senior railway spokesperson, told Business Standard.

However, latest government data shows that the Railways is already running at 91 per cent capacity, with mail/express and suburban trains are at 101 per cent and 99 per cent capacity, respectively. According to experts, these two segments contribute to a large volume of passenger traffic, and the national transporter should have had higher numbers at this capacity utilisation.

A Mumbai-based analyst also suggested that lower passenger figures could augur well for the freight side of Railways in the medium- to long-term, as lesser passengers would mean that it could readjust its passenger inventory according to the new demand and use the additional capacity to ferry more goods. Railways primarily earns its revenue from freight, which in turn uses to subsidise passenger transport.

Lenders seek urgent talks between Reddy, Spandana

Concerned over their money, lenders to Spandana Spoorthy urged the microfinance institution (MFI) and Padmaja Reddy to sort out their differences and let the company get on with business.

A senior executive with a financial institution said a few lenders with large exposures have had discussions with Reddy and those involved in managing the MFI. They conveyed that while business is viable, the strife could hit growth prospects.

Given the risks in the MFI sector,

lenders would look to take further exposure only after a settlement is reached, said an executive with a small bank. Spandana Spoorthy, which is backed by private equity fund Kedaara, and Reddy, its founder and former managing director, are moving towards some understanding on payment of dues and clearing-related party transactions.

Dues pertain to Spandana Mutual Benefit Trust, which worked as collection agent for the MFI. There are also dues to third-party firm Abhiram Marketing, where Reddy holds a substantial stake.

Reddy quit abruptly in November

2021, following differences with the private equity investor on the future of the MFI, and on selling it.

Later, she filed a suit in a court seeking reinstatement as the head of the NBFC-MFI while the lender appointed Shalabh Saxena as managing director. Saxena was working earlier with the MFI unit of IndusInd Bank.

Reddy confirmed prodding by the lenders to talk to the company. Meanwhile, Spandana Spoorthy declined to comment.

In November 2021, the company kept disbursements on hold and focused on collections and recoveries. It resumed loan disbursements in the

fourth quarter.

Meanwhile, rating agency CRISIL said it has retained "Rating Watch with Developing Implications" status for the long-term rating of Spandana Spoorthy. It will resolve the rating watch once adequate track record of stable operations has been established. This comes as the new management settles and there is clarity on underlying asset quality and profitability.

Its gross non-performing assets (GNPAs) stood at 5.5 per cent and net NPNAs were at 2.8 per cent as on December 31, 2021.

The company also opted to restructure loans over Q2 of 2022.

Tata...

ReNew Power had snapped up Ostro Energy for ₹10,800 crore (\$1.6 billion) in 2018 as it sought to consolidate its presence in the sector. Tata Power said its broad-based portfolio of energy assets would ensure diversified yet stable revenue sources, including 25-year fixed-price power purchase agreements (PPAs), for grid-connected utility scale projects. The company's renewable energy unit currently has around 4.9 gigawatt (GW) of renewable energy assets, which it proposes to take to over 20 GW in the next five years.

DoT...

They believe patent disputes should be decided in the courts, which is global norm, rather than by the executive because another agency merely creates another layer for dispute settlement.

They also say that foreign patent holders should have been consulted along with other stakeholders and that they should have adequate representation in the proposed board. Currently, this is restricted to Indian academia and government officials.

Borrowing from the examples of Japan, South Korea and China, the proposed Sovereign Patent Fund suggested by the committee will be aggregating the patents of Indian companies to build a better value for them as a bouquet for the overseas market. India could set up either a national level Fund or sector-specific ones, under which the Ministry of Electronics and Information Technology and the DoT could come together and form one for the ICT industry.

Apart from pooling patents the Fund would be responsible for the intellectual property rights lifecycle management for SMEs and start-ups. It could also play a key role in procuring patented licensing for the country in key technologies

such as 5G and 6G, negotiating a country level licence fee, and offering it to Indian industry at a more attractive rate.

It has been suggested that the proposed Fund should call on expert agencies for its day-to-day management through a special purpose vehicle with broad oversight by the government. It should also be given initial funding for procuring intellectual property rights licensing from patent owners for national level licensing for the Indian industry.

Ambuja...

The cost will further rise if there is a rally in the stock price of Ambuja Cement and ACC — not unusual for companies that are potential acquisition targets. The share price of Ambuja Cement has shot up by 20 per cent in the past month on hearsay that Holcim planned to sell its India business.

Analysts also say that Holcim could potentially ask for a 20-25 per cent premium on its two subsidiaries' market price for selling controlling stake in the second-largest player in the world's second-biggest cement market.

Ambuja Cement and ACC were, however, sitting on cash and equivalents worth ₹11,600 crore at the end of December 2021. This will reduce the overall acquisition cost for the acquirer by around \$1.5 billion.

The acquisition of Ambuja Cement and ACC will give the acquirer one of the best managed and profitable cement assets in the country, with a combined revenue share of around 17 per cent — second only to Ultratech Cement that leads the industry with 30 per cent revenue share.

Aditya Birla Group-owned UltraTech Cement tops the leaderboard, with a production capacity of 120 million tonnes per annum (mtpa), while Ambuja Cement and ACC have a combined capacity of 64 mtpa. Ambuja Cement and ACC reported a combined net profit of ₹3,900 crore on revenues of ₹30,000 crore during the year ended December 2021. Both companies are debt-free and cash-free.

The high potential cost, however, means that Holcim's plans to sell its India assets will attract bidders with deep pockets — either from big business houses or independent cement

makers with financial backing from large private equity (PE) players.

Analysts say that the debt-funded acquisition will land the acquirer in financial deep water in the longer term if profitability in the cement industry declines in the future. The recent rise in interest rates globally has further raised the cost of debt funding.

Bankers said not many Indian companies have the funds to acquire Ambuja Cement and ACC and bidders will have to tie up with PE firms to arrange for funds. Among potential bidders, JSW Group declined to comment. Adani Group did not comment on reports. Prashant Bangur, joint managing director, Shree Cement, said, "We are not interested in Holcim's India business and are not participating in its acquisition process."

Swiss firm Holcim said it will not comment on market scuttlebutt. Adani Group has plans to set up greenfield cement plants in Maharashtra and Gujarat and is considered a top contender to acquire Ambuja Cement.

Musk..

Twitter will review the offer with advice from Goldman Sachs and Wilson Sonsini Goodrich & Rosati, a source told Reuters.

Twitter shares rose 1.8 per cent in mid-morning trading to \$46.70. Twitter's share price reaction implied a 10 per cent chance of Musk clinching a deal. Musk said US investment bank Morgan Stanley was acting as financial adviser for his offer. He did not say how he would finance the transaction if it goes ahead. "We think Musk could look to fund the transaction, if approved, through a combination of debt financing and potentially Tesla shares. Given the size of the transaction (about \$43B), we think it is conceivable that some Tesla shares could be sold given much of his wealth is tied to the company," CFRA Research analyst Angelo Zino said.

Bol...

In February, Future Retail had sought two weeks from the Supreme Court to hammer out a solution with lenders on the issue of clearing dues and avoid being tagged a non-performing

asset (NPA).

The counsel to the lenders had suggested an open bid between Amazon and RIL to settle the dispute and ensure recovery for banks.

Several Future Group companies, including FRL, had entered into agreements with their respective lenders in terms of the RBI circular dated August 6, 2020, in which a resolution framework for Covid-related stress was announced.

Future Group companies will conduct meetings of their respective shareholders and creditors between April 20 and 23 to seek their approval for the Rs 24,713-crore deal. The deal is contested by Amazon and is under litigation at various forums, including the Supreme Court, Delhi High Court and Singapore International Arbitration Center.

Monsoon...

The new all-India rainfall normal has been calculated on the basis of rainfall data over a 50-year period from 1971-2020.

"The prediction of a normal monsoon might bring some cooling effect in certain commodities, particularly domestically grown vegetables. But there are issues related to imported inflation as in the case of edible oils. Uncertainty surrounding the Russia-Ukraine conflict would continue to cause inflationary pressure and despite a normal monsoon, inflation is expected to stay in the 6 per cent-plus band, if not higher," Ashok Gulati, Infosys chair professor for agriculture at the Indian Council for Research on International Economic Relations told Business Standard.

The IMD said that La Niña conditions were prevailing over the equatorial Pacific region and the latest climate models indicated that the same might prevail during the monsoon months of June to September as well.

Neutral Indian Ocean Dipole (IOD) conditions are present over the Indian Ocean and the latest forecasts indicate that the neutral IOD conditions are likely to continue until the beginning of southwest monsoon season, it said. "Thereafter, enhanced probability for negative IOD conditions is predicted," the IMD said.
