

Indian women archery team reaches Paris

PARIS: Indian women's archery team, led by former world number one Deepika Kumari, reached here on Monday to compete in their Final Olympic Qualification event on June 20.

The women's trio of Deepika, Ankita Bhakat and Komalika Bari will have to finish in top-3 to make the last available berth for the Tokyo Olympics which opens on July 23.

"The Indian women archers are going through a mandatory 10-day quarantine. They went ahead of the men's team because of the Olympic qualifiers," Archery Association of India assistant secretary Gunjan Abrol said. While the men's team has secured the Olympic berth during the 2019 World Championships, India so far has an individual quota among women, achieved by Deepika at the Continental Qualifiers in Bangkok two years ago.

"The men's recurve and compound teams will leave India on Tuesday," Abrol said.

A week after the qualification event, both the teams will compete in the third stage of the World Cup. Indian compound team had missed out on World Cup Stage 1 in Guatemala City following their head coach's "false positive report". In the absence of the compound team, the recurve archers came up with their best ever show in a World Cup, winning three gold medals in April. AGENCIES

Gauff reaches French Open quarter-finals at 17

Coco Gauff served superbly to reach her first Grand Slam quarters with a 6-3, 6-1 victory over Jabeur on Monday

PARIS: A day after Serena Williams was eliminated from the French Open, 17-year-old Gauff showed the future in tennis for American women is bright.

Gauff served superbly to reach her first Grand Slam quarterfinal with a 6-3, 6-1 victory over Ons Jabeur on Monday.

Gauff lost only nine points on her serve and was also highly effective at the net, winning 13 of 17 points when she came forward which was especially impressive against a player who is known for her shot-making skills.

I feel like this has been the most consistent tennis I have played at this level, Gauff said. Hopefully I can keep that going.

Gauff also had a quick match in the previous round, when Jennifer Brady retired with an injured left foot after Gauff won the opening set.

Jabeur said Gauff is a contender to raise the trophy either this year or in the future.

If she's not going to win it now, she's probably going to win another time, the Tunisian said.

It wouldn't be the first time

Gauff claims a title at Roland Garros, having won the girls' singles title in 2018.

Gauff will will next face Barbora Krejickova, who also reached her first quarterfinal at a major by beating 2018 French Open runner-up Sloane Stephens with a similarly lopsided

score 6-2, 6-0. She's young, she's amazing, she's coming up. She's going to be the next star, Krejickova said of Gauff.

Later, 22-year-old Sofia Kenin was to face 17th-seeded Maria Sakkari with another spot in the last eight on the line.

Kenin is the highest-seeded woman left in the women's draw at No. 4. The American lost last year's final at Roland Garros to Iga Swiatek, who meets Marta Kostyuk in the night match on Court Philippe Chatrier.

On Sunday, the 39-year-old Williams lost to Elena Rybakina 6-3, 7-5.

Gauff already announced herself as a contender to become the next great American player when she made a run to the fourth round at Wimbledon as a 15-year-old qualifier two years ago. Now, having gone one step further, she became the youngest American to reach a Grand Slam quarterfinal since Venus Williams did it at 17 at the 1997 U.S. Open.

I'm only going to be 17 once, so you might as well talk about it while I'm 17, Gauff said. Gauff has not dropped a set in Paris this year. She won both the singles and doubles titles at a warmup tournament in Parma before coming to Paris. That came after a run to the semifinals of the Italian Open. In all, she's on a career-best nine-match winning streak.

India's tour of Lanka to be played between July 13 and 25

NEW DELHI: India will play three ODIs and as many T20 Internationals in Sri Lanka between July 13 to 25, broadcaster Sony announced on Monday.

Indian selectors are expected to pick plenty of fringe players for the limited overs tour with Shikhar Dhan and Hardik Pandya in the fray for leading the side. A fully-fit Shreyas Iyer is another captaincy option.

Sony Sports announced the schedule via social media.

"Indian waves will crash against the Sri Lankan shore with #JeetneKiZid," the channel tweeted with the schedule.

The ODIs will take place on July 13, 16 and 18 while the T20s will be played on July 21, 23 and 25.

The venues for the games are yet to be announced.

It will be a rare occasion when two India squads will be playing in different countries at the same time. The Virat Kohli-led side will be preparing for the five-match Test series against England at the same time.

The Test squad is already in the UK for the World Test Championships final against New Zealand from June 18 while the England series begins on August 4.

BCCI may push back IPL final to Oct 15 to reduce double headers



NEW DELHI: The BCCI brass is exploring the option of using the full window of Indian Premier League by pushing the final back to October 15 in order to reduce the number of double headers in the UAE's searing September heat.

As PTI had first reported, the tournament will start on Sunday, September 19 and while the final was tentatively planned for October 10, the BCCI as well as the Emirates Cricket Board are mulling stretching the lucrative T20 event till October 15.

"September 15 to October 15 is the window. Initially, BCCI was thinking of having 10 double headers. But, in third and fourth week of September, having 10 afternoon matches can be physically exhausting for player in such short window," a BCCI source said on the condition of anonymity.

"So if October 15, which is a Friday is zeroed in on, it's basically start of weekend in India and in Dubai, it's a holiday which will allow fans to come in and enjoy a high-

profile game of cricket. It serves dual purpose. Also, the number of double headers could be reduced to five or six, instead of 10," the source said.

Currently, BCCI president Sourav Ganguly, vice-president Rajiv Shukla, acting CEO Hemang Amin, treasurer Arun Dhimal, joint secretary Jayesh George and IPL chairman Brijesh Patel are in the UAE to finalise the arrangements.

Secretary Jay Shah is back in India after a series of meetings with the Emirates Cricket Board officials and a recce of the venues.

The Indian team's last Test in England is in Manchester and if it goes the distance, then it will finish on September 14. The next day, the Indian contingent of IPL players will be flown via a charter flight from Manchester to Dubai. They might have to undergo a three-day hard quarantine in the UAE but that could be waived off since they will be entering from the UK bio-bubble.

TOP PLAYERS PREFER TO TRAIN INDIVIDUALLY COVID-19: Tokyo Olympics preparation going haywire

NEW DELHI: The preparation of the Olympic-bound Indian table tennis contingent seems to be going nowhere with leading players G Sathiyam and Manika Batra confirming their unavailability for the proposed training camp in Sonapat from June 20.

With the Coronavirus-induced restrictions already affecting the players' preparations for the July-August Tokyo Games, top players preferring to work with their individual coaches is also not helping the team's cause.

Amid the second wave of the COVID-19 pandemic in the country, the four Tokyo-bound players -- Sharath Kamal, Sathiyam, Manika and Sutirtha Mukherjee -- have been restricted to individual training since qualifying in March. After not getting his Denmark visa for training, Sharath is looking forward to the national camp in Sonapat but his preparations would be



incomplete if he is not able to train with mixed doubles partner Manika.

India's best shot at an Olympic medal is in the mixed doubles category with the players not expected to go deep into the singles draw.

Table Tennis Federation of India (TTFI) advisor MP Singh said the federation is waiting for SAI's approval for the camp but it can't force the players to attend it.

"The preparations have not been ideal but you could not help it amid the pandemic. We are now awaiting SAI's approval for the 15-day camp. It should come in a day or two," Singh

Ollie Robinson suspended for abusive tweets

LONDON: England fast bowler Ollie Robinson was suspended from international cricket pending an investigation into discriminatory tweets he posted from 2012-13.

Robinson will not be available for the second test against New Zealand starting Thursday, the England and Wales Cricket Board said on Sunday.

Robinson made his test debut in the first match of the series at Lord's, taking seven wickets across New Zealand's two innings and also hitting 42 in England's first innings.

The tweets he posted when he was 18 and 19, which were racist and sexist in nature, resurfaced during the first day of the test and Robinson was close to tears as he issued an apology after stumps.

Judoka Sushila Devi provisionally qualifies for Tokyo Olympics

BUDAPEST: Indian judoka Sushila Devi has provisionally qualified for the Tokyo Olympics by claiming the continental quota but her participation in the Games will be confirmed only after the final list of qualifiers is released on June 28.

Sushila, who lost her first round at the World Judo Championship here on Sunday in the 48kg category, currently has 989 points, which puts her at seventh spot in the Asian list.

"The information shown is provisional and only shows which judoka would be qualified, if the Olympic Games were today," the International Judo Federation website stated.

The continental quotas are allotted based on a judoka's ranking in the region. Asia has 10 quota slots.

"The list will likely change significantly until 28th June 2021, which is the deadline for obtaining points for Olympic qualification," it added.

Copa America drama eclipses World Cup qualifiers

SAO PAULO: South American World Cup qualifiers involving bitter rivals Colombia and Argentina, and Paraguay hosting Brazil, are being overshadowed by a possible player revolt against taking part in the upcoming Copa America.

The South American tournament is scheduled to be played June 13-July 10 in Brazil. Copa America was originally set to be co-hosted by Colombia and Argentina. Colombia was forced to withdraw following social unrest and Argentina reportedly declined to host the continental tournament because of a worsening of the pandemic.

It will now be hosted by Brazil, even though more than 470,000 Brazilians have died so far from the Coronavirus and analysts expect another wave of the virus to hit Brazil by late June.

On the field, Brazil leads the round-robin tournament with 15 points, four ahead of second-place Argentina. The top four teams automatically secure a spot at the 2022 World Cup in Qatar.

The post-match news conference of Brazil coach Tite in Asuncion is more anticipated than the game itself. After the Sele o's 2-0 home win against




Ecuador, Tite said he and his players would make it clear whether they will participate in the next Copa America in a decision that mixes views on pandemic control and internal politics.

We want to speak after the match against Paraguay because we don't want to lose our focus, Brazil captain Casemiro said Friday.

Brazilian media reports say Tite could resign before the tournament begins due to disagreements with the country's soccer confederation. Supporters of Brazil President Jair Bolsonaro are calling for Tite to resign on social media. Bolsonaro has defied social distancing policies, claiming lockdown measures kill more than the virus. The government confirmed Saturday night that Bolsonaro had assured executives of South American soccer body CONMEBOL that Brazil will host the event no matter what.






