Veg prices fall, but no let-up on cereals, pulses, milk

CONCERNS LINGER. Inflation in Aug is expected between 6.55% and 7.2%, impacting purchasing power and prompting policy rate considerations, data show

Vegetable prices may have slowly started to fall, but the prices of other food products, including cereals, pulses, spices and milk may not give comfort for a while. The expectation is that August inflation could be in the range of 6.5 to 7.2 per cent.

Data from the Consumer Data from the Consumer Affairs Ministry tabled in Par-liament show divergent price trends for various food products in different States. The north-eastern States are seeing higher prices in many of the products. The southern states follow close behind.







'No plans to reconsider rice export ban as food inflation spikes'

With food inflation hitting a 39-month high in July 2023, the Centre is not in a position to reconsider the recent export ban on non-basmatirice as ensuring food security within the country remains top priority, top officials have said.

"A decision to roll back the export ban on rice can be the export ban on rice can be taken sometime in the fu-ture only after duly as-sessing production, pro-curement, food stock and domestic prices. Right now the situation is not such that a roll back can be considered especially with food inflation still high. Ensuring food security of our people is the first priority," an official tracking the matter told businessline.

However, India is also not oblivious to the needs of other countries as G2G (government-to-government) supplies of rice to needy countries continues on the basis of requests made by them, the official added.

SPIKE IN NUMBERS
While retail inflation in July 2023 spiked to 7.44 per cent (from 4.87 per cent in June), food inflation stood at 11.51 per cent and inflation in cerals was at 13.04 per cent, per CPI numbers released by

the government on Monday. On July 20, 2023, the government had imposed an export ban on non-basmati rice port ban on non-basmati rice in response to a sharp rise in domestic rice prices. The export ban has led to concerns globally as India accounts for about 40 per cent of the international trade in rice and stopping supplies could lead to a rise in world prices of the cereal. But the government is more worried about domestic prices of rice.

ment is more worried about domestic prices of rice "The measures taken by the government to cool prices of cereals have not yet shown results. Hopefully going forward the situation will be more in control as the moves get fully implemented," the official said.

Micro loans, fall in delinquencies drove MSME lending in FY23: Report

A surge in loans to the micro segment, aided by a parallel fall in delinquencies, drove lending to the MSME sector in FY23, according to Tran-sUnion CIBIL-SIDBI's MSME Pulse Report. The micro-segment, where

The micro-segment, where credit exposure is less than ₹1 crore, registered 23 per cent y-o-y growth in originations value with PSU banks leading value with PSU banks leading on originations. The small segment, where credit exposure is ₹1-10 crore, grew 1 per cent. Originations value in the 'medium' segment, credit exposure of ₹10-50 crore, fell by 19 per cent on year. Credit Micro-segment saw 23 per cent y-o-y growth in originations value with PSU banks leading on originations

supply volumes in micro and small segments small segments grew by 16 per cent and 1 per cent re-spectively, while the medium segment declined by 8 per

cent.

Commercial credit demand

Commercial credit demand, or credit inquiry volumes, rose 33 per cent whereas credit supply volumes grew 11 per cent yoy on the back of improved business activity, the report said.

During Q4FY23, delinquency rates dropped across lenders, falling to 3, per cent for PSU banks and 1.4 per cent for private banks. For NBFCs, the rate declined to 3.6 per cent, witnessing the largest decline from 5.0 per cent a year ago. cent a year ago.

PSUs CONTINUE TO LEAD New to credit (NTC) borrow-ers accounted for 56 per cent of new MSME loan origina-tions and 61 per cent in the micro segment. PSU banks

were the leader in the below ₹50 lakh segment whereas private banks were dominant in the ₹50 lakh to ₹1 crore

in the X50 lakh to 11 crore segment.

"High credit demand within this micro-segment, coupled with positive lender sentiment, has propelled the growth of NTC borrowers, significantly contributing to greater financial inclusion," greater financial inclusion," the report said adding that NTC entities will be instru-

NTC entities will be instru-mental in defining the next phase of MSME credit growth. "India has approximately 6.3 crore MSMEs of which only 2.5 crore have ever availed credit from formal sources," said MD and CEO Raiesh Kumar

Russian crude oil imports to decelerate in Aug-Sept

Crude oil shipments from In-

Crude oil shipments from India's largest supplier have started to decelerate in the current month, which will continue in September as refiners in Russia increased runs coupled with voluntary cuts for both the months.

However, the October-December quarter is likely to witness higher cargoes — 12-15 per cent (against August-September) — by the world's third largest crude oil importer as Russia goes into seasonal refinery maintenance in autumn (second half of September) and continued uncertainty over China's economic recovery.

Energy intelligence firm Kpler expects volumes to hover at 1.6 million barrels per day (mb/d) in August and

day (mb/d) in August and September 2023. "Imports are likely to average at 1.58-1.62 mb/d for August and Septem-



ber. In Q4 (2023), if Chinese ber. In Q4 (2023), if Chinese inventories don't deplete from record levels and economic recovery is delayed, it will import less, which would mean Indian imports from Russia will be higher, averaging at 1.8-1.9 mb/d by 2023-end," a trade source projected. China's crude imports are expected to fall back from near-record highs (June 2023), amid ample inventories, dwindling quotas, and uncertainties regarding the pace of recovery in oil demand,

OPEC said in its monthly oil market report for August.

CHANGING TAX REGIMES Kpler's Lead Analyst (Dirty Products and Refining) An-don Pavlov told *businessline*, "Indeed, we are seeing some solid evidence that Russian refiners are ramping up runs in August, possibly keeping them somewhat elevated over early

For the most part, this has to do with an impending change to Russia's tax regime,

which will slash a part of the state subsidy for domestic re-finers for selling transporta-tion fuels to the domestic market, instead of exporting

market, instead of exporting it, he explained.
"This, and the looming maintenance in September, tell us that refinery runs (i.e. crude demand at home), are at a multi-month high level in Russia currently. This is also a factor behind the observed cuts in Russian crude exports. As for September, this is the first month of Russia's sea-sonal autumn maintenance, first month of Russia's sea-sonal autumn maintenance, so we expect a gradual in-crease in crude exports, in line with the easing of export curbs that Russia has recently announced, "Pavlov added. On expectations of crude oll cargoes appreciating in Oc-tober-December 2023, he said "Yes the lackhustre outlook"

Yes, the lacklustre outlook for Russian refining leaves little options for domestic crude exporters but to look for exports elsewhere, so Q4 looks like a period when we course, to a degree, this is also contingent on Chinese buying, but so far, things look a bit unclear on that front."

Asked whether Urals breaching the G7 price cap and depleting Russian discounts (56-8 per barrel) will impact India's volumes, he said "Indeed, while margins have taken a beating, they are still attractive. DGCA forms panel to find ways to boost gender equality in civil aviation

them to DGCA which the regulator will further circulate among aviation stakeholders to adopt and bring in practice for gender equality. "The committee will submit its report/recommendation within six months from the date of its constitution," the order said.


