CAA across India in 7 days: Union minister

Meanwhile, Uttarakhand CM Dhama says state to enact UCC soon

New Delhi, 29 January

The Bharatiya Janata Party (BJP) could soon move on two contentious issues from its pending agenda — the Centre implementing the Citizenship Amendment Act (CAA) and some of its state governments initiating the legislative process to adopt the Uniform Civil Code (UCC).

On Monday, Union Minister Shantanu Thakur told a news channel that the CAA would be implemented in the country within a week. Thakur is a BJP MP from West Bengal's Bongaon constituency in the North 24 Parganas. The area, on the Indo-Bangladesh border, has a significant population of the Scheduled Caste Matua community.

The BJP has in the past flagged the persecution of the community in Bangladesh and the need to give Hindu migrants Indian citizenship. The party has also raised illegal migration from the neighbouring country during elections. Thakur, the Union minister of state for ports, shipping and waterways and Matua community leader, made a similar comment on Sunday.

In another development, Uttarakhand Chief Minister Pushkar Singh Dhama posted on X that his government soon to enact the UCC in the state. Dhama said the committee to prepare the UCC draft will submit its report to the state government on

"We shall bring the UCC Bill in the forthcoming Assembly session and pave the way for its implementation in the state," he said. The Budget session

of the Uttarakhand Assembly will begin on February 5. Uttarakhand's UCC draft could look at banning polygamy and amending inheritance laws to ensure an equal share of property for women.

The CAA provides for granting Indian citizenship to persecuted non-Muslim migrants, such as Hindus, Sikhs, Jains, Buddhists, Parsis and Christians from Bangladesh, Pakistan, and Afghanistan who entered India before December 31, 2014.

The Parliament passed the CAA in December 2019. The Congress and other parties had opposed it. The law triggered nationwide protests. According to sources, the rules for the CAA could be notified "much before" the announcement of the Lok Sabha elections. Last month, addressing a meeting in Kolkata, Union Home Minister Amit Shah said the implementation of the CAA was inevitable.

Reacting to Thakur's comments, the Trinamool Congress accused the BJP of trying to "fool" the people on the issue for the last five years and attempting it again. "Our party supremo and Chief Minister Mamata Banerjee have clearly said CAA won't be implemented in West Bengal. The BJP leaders are attempting political gimmickry by making such false promises before the Lok Sabha elections," TMC spokesperson Kunal Ghosh said.

I challenge every challenge, PM tells students at Pariksha event

Prime Minister Narendra Modi on Monday said it was in his nature to "challenge every challenge" and asserted that he looked for a way to deal with poverty in the country instead of just sitting on the issue like others. In reply to a question during his annual 'Pariksha Pe Charcha' programme on how he keeps a positive mindset amid the challenges of his job, Modi said every person has to manage situations and tests, and some people believe in waiting for the crises to pass and circumstances to improve. Such people cannot achieve anything in life, he added.

"Just like mobile phones, human bodies need recharging to function properly, while emphasising that physical health is as important as excelling in academics," Modi said that even though competition and challenges act as inspirations, competition must be healthy.

"A lot of parents keep on giving examples of other children to their children. Parents should avoid doing these things... never sow the seeds of rivalry and competition among students," he said.

"We have also seen that those parents who have not been very successful in their lives have nothing to say or want to tell the world about their successes and achievements, make the report card of their children their visiting card."

The prime minister explained that the stress faced by students is of three types

— induced by peer pressure, by parents and self-induced.

"At times, children take pressure on themselves that they are not performing up to the mark. I suggest that you should set small goals during preparation and gradually improve your performance, this way you will be completely ready before exams," he said.

"Habits like screen time are eating into the required sleep time, which is consid-

ered very important by modern health science," he said. Responding to a question by Deeparsi, a student, the prime minister also touched upon the serious issue of trust deficit in families and asked parents and teachers to tackle it.

He advised students not to use their sleep time for watching reels.

He also asked the students not to keep preparing until the last moment and approach exams with a relaxed mindset.

Amara Raja chief announces 'break' from active politics

Jayadev Galla, chief of Amara Raja Batteries and two-time member of Parliament for the Telugu Desam Party (TDP), said he was taking a break from electoral politics to focus on business "without fear of reprisals and attacks".

Galla, 57, is one of the richest MPs in Lok Sabha with a declared asset of around ₹683 crore. Amara Raja is moving from being a battery manufacturer to a comprehensive provider of energy and mobility solutions. "It is with a heavy heart that I announce my decision to not contest in the upcoming 2024 general elections. I will be taking a break from politics to focus on diversifying the business which is at a crucial stage of leading the world in the transition to a more sustainable future,"

said Galla, who represents Guntur in Parliament.

"As part of this we are investing about ₹9,500 crore for the Amara Raja Giga Corridor, which will have one of the largest manufacturing facilities of lithium-ion batteries and also state-of-the-art research and development center for research in advanced chemistry cells," said Galla, who is chairman and managing director of Amara.

Galla has been part of parliamentary committees on commerce, external affairs, defence, and information technology. Many of his recommendations were accepted and implemented as policy.



No more elections if Modi wins 2024 LS polls: Kharage

Congress president Mallikarjun Kharge on Monday expressed apprehension that the 2024 Lok Sabha elections would be the last opportunity for the people to save democracy, as Prime Minister Narendra Modi might prefer dictatorship in case his party wins the upcoming polls.

He also urged people to keep away from the BJP and its ideology RSS, alleging that they are "like poison".

"This will be the last opportunity for the people to save democracy in India. If Narendra Modi wins another election, there will be dictatorship in the country. The BJP will rule India like Putin in Russia," Kharge said while addressing a party rally.

Launching a scathing attack on the BJP and RSS, Kharge said that the present government under Modi was being run by threatening states and leaders of the opposition. PTI
