Notes

- 1. The Explanatory Statement pursuant to Section 102 of the Companies Act, 2013 setting out material facts in respect of the Special Business of this notice is annexed hereto.
- 2. In view of the continuing Covid-19 Pandemic, the Ministry of Corporate Affairs (MCA) vide MCA vide its General Circular No. 11/2022 dated 28.12.2022 allowed the Companies to conduct their EGMs through Video Conferencing (VC) or Other Audio Visual Means (OAVM) or transact items through postal ballot up to September 30, 2023.
- 3. Since this EGM is being held pursuant to MCA circulars through VC/OAVM, physical attendance of members has been dispensed with. Accordingly, the facility for appointment of proxies by the members will not be available for the Extraordinary General Meeting (EGM) and hence the proxy form and attendance slip are not annexed to this notice. However, the Body Corporate is entitled to appoint authorised representatives to attend the EGM through VC/OAVM and participate thereat and cast their votes through e-Voting.
- 4. The Members can join the EGM in the VC/OAVM mode 15 minutes before and after the scheduled time of the commencement of the Meeting by following the procedure mentioned in the Notice. The facility of participation at the EGM through VC/OAVM will be made available for 1000 members on first come first serve basis. This will not include large Shareholders (Shareholders holding 2% or more shareholding), Promoters, Institutional Investors, Directors, Key Managerial Personnel, the Chairperson of the Audit Committee, Nomination and Remuneration Committee and Stakeholders Relationship Committee, Auditors etc., who are allowed to attend the EGM without restriction on account of first come first serve basis.
- 5. Pursuant to the provisions of Section 108 of the Companies Act, 2013 read with Rule20 of the Companies (Management and Administration) Rules, 2014 (as amended) and Regulation 44 of SEBI (Listing Obligations & Disclosure Requirements) Regulations 2015 (as amended), and the Circulars issued by the Ministry of Corporate Affairs dated 28.12.2022, the Company is providing facility of remote e-Voting to its Members in respect of the business to be transacted at the EGM. For this purpose, the Company has entered into an agreement with National Securities Depository Limited (NSDL) for facilitating voting through electronic means, as the authorized agency. The facility of casting votes by a member using remote e-Voting system as well as e-Voting on the date of the EGM will be provided by NSDL.
- 6. The Company has provided the facility to Members to exercise their right to vote by electronic means both through remote e-Voting and e-Voting during the EGM. The process of remote e-Voting with necessary user id and password is given in the subsequent paragraphs. Such remote e-Voting facility is in addition to voting that will take place at the 43rd EGM being held through VC/OAVM.
- 7. Members joining the Meeting through VC, who have not already cast their vote by means of remote e-Voting, shall be able to exercise their right to vote through e-Voting at the EGM. The Members who have cast their vote by remote e-Voting prior to the EGM may also join the EGM through VC but shall not be entitled to cast their vote again.
- 8. All documents referred to in the accompanying Notice and the Explanatory Statement and other statutory register will be available for inspection by the Members during the EGM. Members may access the same by writing to the Company at its email id cs@pel-india.in.
- 9. Members seeking further information about the accounts are requested to write at least 7 days before the date of the Meeting so that it may be convenient to get the information ready at the Meeting.
- 10. In line with the Ministry of Corporate Affairs (MCA) Circulars, the Notice for EGM has been uploaded on the website of the Company at www.pel-india.in. The Notice can also be accessed from the websites of the Stock Exchange, BSE

- Limited atwww.bseindia.com and the EGM Notice is also available on the website of NSDL (agency for providing the Remote e-Voting facility) i.e.www.evoting.nsdl.com.
- 11. Members who have not registered their e-mail address are requested to register the same in respect of shares held in electronic form with the Depository through their Depository Participant(s) and in respect of shares held in physical form by writing to the Company's Registrar and Share Transfer Agent, Skyline Financial Services Private Limited, compliances@skylinerta.com.
- 12. Any person, who acquires shares of the Company and become member of the Company after dispatch of the Notice of EGM and holding shares as of the cut-off date i.e. March 03, 2022 may obtain the login ID and password by sending a request at evoting@nsdl.co.in or contact Registrar and Share Transfer Agent (Skyline Financial Services Private Limited). However, if you are already registered with NSDL for remote e-Voting then you can use your existing user ID and password for casting your vote. If you forgot your password, you may generate new password by using "Forgot User Details/Password" option available on www.evoting.nsdl.com.
- 13. A person, whose name is recorded in the register of members or in the register of beneficial owners maintained by the depositories as on the cut-off date only shall be entitled to avail the facility of remote e-Voting.
- 14. The Board of Directors has appointed M/s Munish K Sharma & Associates, Company Secretaries, as the Scrutinizer for scrutinizing the e-Voting process in a fair and transparent manner.
 - I. The Scrutinizer, after the conclusion of voting at the EGM, will first count the e-votes cast at the Meeting and thereafter the votes cast through remote e-Voting in the presence of at least two witnesses not in the employment of the Company and shall make, not later than two days of the conclusion of the EGM, a consolidated scrutinizer's report of the total votes cast in favour or against, if any, to the Chairman or a person authorized by him in writing, who shall countersign the same and declare the result of the voting forthwith.
 - II. The results declared along with the report of the Scrutinizer shall be placed on the Company's website www.pelindia.in and on the website of the NSDL immediately after the declaration of result by the Chairman or a person authorized by him in writing. The result shall also be intimated to the Bombay Stock Exchange within Two (2) working days of the conclusion of the EGM.

THE INSTRUCTIONS FOR MEMBERS FOR REMOTE E-VOTING ARE AS UNDER:-

The remote e-Voting period begins on March 03, 2022 (09:00 AM) and ends on March 09, 2022 (05:00 PM). During this period the members of the Company, holding shares either in physical form or in dematerialized form, as on March 03, 2022 (cut-off date) may cast their vote electronically. The remote e-Voting module shall be disabled by NSDL for voting thereafter.

How do I vote electronically using NSDL e-Voting system?

The way to vote electronically on NSDL e-Voting system consists of "Two Steps" which are mentioned below:

- 1. After successful login at Step 1, you will be able to see all the companies "EVEN" in which you are holding shares and whose voting cycle and General Meeting is in active status.
- Select "EVEN" of Company for which you wish to cast your vote during the remote e-Voting period and casting your vote during the General Meeting. For joining virtual Meeting, you need to click on "VC/OAVM" link placed under "Join General Meeting".
- 3. Now you are ready for e-Voting as the Voting page opens.
- 4. Cast your vote by selecting appropriate options i.e., assent or dissent, verify/modify the number of shares for which you wish to cast your vote and click on "Submit" and also "Confirm" when prompted.
- 5. Upon confirmation, the message "Vote cast successfully" will be displayed.
- 6. You can also take the printout of the votes casted by you by clicking on the print option on the confirmation page.
- 7. Once you confirm your vote on the resolution, you will not be allowed to modify your vote.

General Guidelines for shareholders

- 1. - 2. It is strongly recommended not to share your password with any other person and take utmost care to keep your password confidential. EXPLANATORY STATEMENT PURSUANT TO SECTION 102 OF THE COMPANIES ACT, 2013 AND IN TERMS OF REGULATION 36 OF THE SEBI (LISTING OBLIGATIONS AND DISCLOSURE REQUIREMENTS) REGULATIONS, 2015

Item no. 1

Mr. Suresh Vyas was appointed as an Additional Director of the company on February 04, 2023 in terms of Section 161(1) of the Companies Act, 2013 in the category of 'Non-Executive and Independent' in terms of the Companies Act, 2013. Mr. Suresh Vyas, an Additional Director holds office up to the date of the General Meeting of the Company and be eligible for appointment to the office of a Director at General Meeting in terms of Section 160 of the Companies Act, 2013. Mr. Suresh Vyas is not disqualified from being appointed as an Independent Director in terms of Section 164 of the Act and has given his consent to act as Director (in the category of Non-Executive & Independent).

Mr. Suresh Vyas is Chartered Accountant by profession and Managing partner of the Snr. company, he has got about 30 years of experience in the Industry and Profession of handling a number of projects and companies of national and international level. He has mastered the activities relating to the corporate world such as corporate law matters, acquisitions and mergers, liaison with Government agencies etc. While in practice, he has assisted a number of international companies to set up their offices in India and was also associated with Indian companies acquiring projects overseas. Mr. Suresh Vyas was also an Independent Director of the Company.

The Board considers that his association would be of immense benefit to the Company and it is desirable to avail services of Mr. Suresh Vyas as an Independent Director. In order to ensure compliance with the provisions of Regulation 17(1C) of the SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015 approval of shareholders for appointment of a director on the Board of Directors has to be taken at the next general meeting or within a time period of three months from the date of appointment, whichever is earlier.
