Twin INDIA bloc meetings decide on inclusion & equity

MANOJ CG & VALLABH OZARKAR NEW DELHI, MUMBAI JAN 9

IN A meeting in Delhi Tuesday, INDIA and MVA members decided to include Prakash Ambedkar's Vanchit Bahujan Aghadi (VBA) in the Opposition alliance, and in another huddle of the bloc members, the Congress and the SP formally started discussions on seat sharing to be worked out in Uttar Pradesh for the 2024 Lok Sabha polls.

In the earlier meeting, a decision to include Prakash Ambedkar's Vanchit Bahujan Aghadi (VBA) into the Opposition's INDIA alliance and Maha Vikas Aghadi (MVA) has been taken in a meeting of MVA leaders held in the national capital, Shiv Sena (UBT) Sanjay Raut said Tuesday night after the meeting.

A meeting of leaders of the Congress, NCP and Sena (UBT) was held at the residence of Congress leader Mukul Wasnik in Delhi to discuss the seat sharing for the upcoming Lok Sabha polls. After the meeting, Raut said discussions on seat sharing were positive but the formula will be decided later. "As you can see we all have come out of the meeting. We all sat down to discuss seat-sharing. I want to assure everyone that we will fight elections together. We have no differences about seat sharing... We discussed in detail about each seat," Raut said in Delhi.

"We had a detailed discussion about including VBA and

Prakash Ambedkar in the Opposition bloc and after that all partners of MVA and INDIA have agreed to include the VBA in MVA and INDIA," Raut said, adding that seat sharing with VBA will be decided later. Earlier in the day, Raut had said that Sena (UBT) has staked claim on 23 seats and they will get 23 seats to contest in the LS polls since the party has been contesting from the 23 seats for many decades.

"We will get 23 seats from the state that include seats from Mumbai and Thane, which have been our bastions. If there are any differences, we will sit and discuss. Our senior leaders, Uddhav Thackeray, Sharad Pawar, Mallickarjun Kharge, Rahul Gandhi will meet and decide if there are any issues. I don't see any clashes here. This is our fight against the dictatorship going on in the country. Under the leadership of Uddhav Thackeray,

we have selected 23 seats after testing our base in 48 constituencies. You will see a new candidate for the post of Prime Minister in 2024," Raut said. In another meeting that followed immediately after, leaders of the Congress and the Samajwadi Party (SP), both constituents of the INDIA bloc, Tuesday formally started discussions on the seat-sharing formula to be worked out in Uttar Pradesh for the Lok Sabha elections against the backdrop of claims by the SP that it wants to contest in 65 of the 80 seats. The meeting, which both sides called it cordial, lasted barely 30 minutes. Sources said both the parties did not go into the minute details of the arrangement and decided to meet again on January 12.

"The Congress knows that the SP, as the largest party in the state, wants to contest in roughly 65 seats. We will get into those

details in the next meeting," an SP leader said.

Senior leader and Rajya Sabha MP Ram Gopal Yadav and his party colleague Javed Ali Khan represented the SP. Ties between both the parties had come under strain after the Congress refused to enter into a seat-sharing pact with the SP for the Madhya Pradesh Assembly elections.

The meeting took place against the backdrop of newly appointed AICC general secretary in charge of Uttar Pradesh Avinash Pandey's remarks that all like-minded parties must come together to defeat the BJP and that only one candidate should be fielded against the BJP in every seat.

Sources said when SP leaders grilled Pandey on his remark, which was seen as an overture to the Bahujan Samaj Party (BSP), Pandey had not made any statement regarding Mayawati's party. The SP has already told the Congress that the BSP should not be invited to join the INDIA bloc. SP leaders told the Congress that it will not field candidates in Sonia Gandhi's Lok Sabha constituency Rae Bareilly, and Amethi where Rahul Gandhi lost in 2019.

The Rashtriya Lok Dal (RLD) did not attend the meeting, which was attended by senior Congress leaders Ashok Gehlot, Mukul Wasnik, Salman Khurshid and Mohan Prakash, all of them members of the party's national alliance committee, besides the Congress's Uttar Pradesh unit chief Ajai Rai and CLP leader Aradhana Misra Mona.

TN Gov withdraws notification over appointment of V-Cs

DAYS AFTER Tamil Nadu Chief Minister M K Stalin met Governor R N Ravi, Raj Bhavan on Tuesday withdrew notifications in connection with the appointment of vice-chancellors to three state-run universities.

Ravi's move — the first after the meeting between Stalin and him following a recent suggestion of the Supreme Court to resolve their differences — came with a rider. Raj Bhavan said it is "confident" that the state government, too, would withdraw its notifications and reissue them in line with University Grants Commission

(UGC) regulations and judgments of the apex court and high courts.

Though "outcome of the Governor's withdrawal of notification is anyone's guess, it is the first sign of the possibility of a thaw in ties between Raj Bhavan and the DMK government". The tussle between the government and the Governor over several issues including pending bills, policy matters, and premature release of prisoners is known.

As the chancellor of state universities, the Governor issued three notifications on September 6, 2023, constituting search committees to identify suitable candidates for appointment as vice-chancellors for the Bharathiar University, Tamil Nadu Teachers

Education University, and University of Madras. Referring to the state government's gazette notifications on the same, Raj Bhavan — in an official release in Chennai — said "these were not in accordance with the UGC regulations".

Citing the Madras HC judgment in "V Palaniappas vs Secretary to Chancellor, Puducherry Technological University, and others (December 2023)", Raj Bhavan said the verdict mandates relevant statutory provisions should conform to UGC regulations 2018. In view of this "clear enunciation of the law", the Governor is confident that in deference to constitutional propriety and legality, the "Government of Tamil Nadu would withdraw its notifications".

CM: UP orders school holiday, liquor sale ban on Jan 22

Lucknow: Referring to the consecration ceremony of the Ram Temple in Ayodhya, slated for January 22, as a "rashtira utsav" (national festival), Chief Minister Yogi Adityanath on Tuesday directed all educational institutes across the state to observe a holiday on January 22. He also said that sale of liquor would not be allowed across the state on the day. Adityanath was in Ayodhya on Tuesday to review the preparations for the consecration ceremony, in which Prime Minister Narendra Modi along with several other dignitaries from across the country would be participating.

The CM, who offered prayers to Ram Lalla and also visited Hanuman Gari temple in Ayodhya, reviewed the progress of development works and held a meeting with sadhus. He also met Niritya Gopal Das, Chairman of the Ram Janmabhoomi Teerth Kshetra Trust.

'Stones hurled' at procession for Ram Mandir in MP, 8 held

EIGHT PEOPLE were arrested and prohibitory orders were imposed in parts of Madhya Pradesh's Shajapur city after participants of a religious procession were pelted with stones. One person was injured in the incident.

During the procession, which started at 7:30 pm on Monday, youths associated with Hindu organisations distributed yellow rice for the consecration ceremony of the Ram Temple in Ayodhya, police said. At around 8:30 pm, around seven-eight persons stopped them and told them not to take out the procession in the area, an officer said.

This argument then grew into a physical confrontation, when some of the participants

were allegedly "manhandled and stones were pelted at them", the officer added.

"Eight persons have been arrested in this incident and search is on to apprehend the other accused," said Shajapur Superintendent of Police Yashpal Rajput. "The city is peaceful. We have also set up multiple patrolling parties to maintain peace in the city. Restrictions have been imposed under Section 144 of the Code of Criminal Procedure in three areas of Shajapur city — Magaria, Kachhiwada and Lalpura," the SP said.

Lalit, one of the injured, said, "I was part of the rally of 30 people and were raising 'Jai Shri Ram' slogans. Then suddenly, they started pelting stones and raising their own slogans. They caught hold of me, and they overpowered us."

After the incident, a large number of workers of Hindu organisations reached the police station on Monday night. The protesters demanded that the accused be arrested immediately and that their houses be bulldozed. Local MLA Arun Bhimawad also turned up at the police station and addressed the protesters, assuring strict action against the accused.

Police registered an FIR against 24 identified people and 15-20 unidentified people. Dewas MP Mahendra Solanki reached Shajapur on Tuesday and had a series of discussions with the senior police officers, following which he said the administration would "take any action necessary, including bulldozing homes of the accused, to maintain peace".

Strict action will be taken against those who pelted stones on the yatra. Eight accused have been arrested, the search for the rest is on. If necessary, they will also break the houses of the accused," Solanki said.

The Congress has called for a fair investigation into the incident, with its spokesperson alleging that the BJP may have been behind the incident.

"There should be a fair investigation into the incident. Whoever is the accused should be unmasked. But before the elections, why was there a riot? Who did this? There should be an investigation. We have our doubts that the Sangh Parivar and the BJP are involved in this incident. There is an attempt to spread terror and reap political dividends," Congress spokesperson KK Mishra said

Karnataka Lokayukta raids unearth Rs 50-cr assets from 6 officials

THE KARNATAKA Lokayukta Tuesday conducted search operations in connection with disproportionate assets cases registered against six government officials in Bengaluru City and Ramanagara police stations and seized assets worth Rs 50.2 crore. Simultaneous searches were conducted at the residences and offices of the relatives of the accused government officers across 35 locations, a Lokayukta press release stated. Sleuths recovered assets worth Rs 6.3 crore from ML Nagaraj, the chief general manager with Bangalore Electricity Supply Company Limited (Bescom) in Bengaluru.

Raids were conducted at seven places and the search yielded 13 sites, two houses, 12-30 acres of agriculture land, Rs 16 lakh's worth of jewellery and Rs 13 lakh's worth of vehicles. The Lokayukta police seized Rs 25 crore's worth of assets from HS Suresh, a member of Channahalli gram panchayat at Tavarekere Hobli in Bengaluru south taluk.

Searches were conducted across six places during which 16 sites, a house, 7.6 acres of agriculture land, Rs 2 crore's worth of vehicles, and other prized possessions were seized. The Lokayukta police also seized assets worth Rs 5.9 crore from DM Padmanabha, the panchayat development officer of gram panchayat at Devanahalli taluk in Bengaluru.

After praising Tharoor, BJP leader backtracks: 'BJP will win Thiruvananthapuram'

HOURS AFTER praising Congress MP Shashi Tharoor for "winning again and again" from Thiruvananthapuram, veteran BJP leader O Rajagopal backtracked from his statement, saying his opinion was misinterpreted. Speaking at a public event, in which Karnataka Deputy Chief Minister D K Sivakumar gave an award instituted by a media foundation to Tharoor in Thiruvananthapuram on Monday, the 94-year-old BJP leader indicated that it is tough to defeat the Congress MP in the coming Lok Sabha elections.

Eulogising Tharoor, Rajagopal, a former Union minister of state during the Atal Bihari Vajpayee regime, said: "He (Tharoor) has succeeded in influencing the mind of the people of Thiruvananthapuram. That is why he is winning again and again from there. I doubt whether someone else would get a chance from Thiruvananthapuram in near future."

The remarks came two days after Union External Affairs Minister S Jaishankar inaugurated the Viksit Bharat Sankalp Yatra in Thiruvananthapuram, where BJP sees a chance of victory in the Lok Sabha polls. Thiruvananthapuram parliamentary constituency is top on the BJP's agenda. In the last two Lok Sabha elections, it is the only constituency in Kerala where the BJP finished second. Its best show

was in 2014 when O Rajagopal, who got 32.32% votes, narrowly lost out to Tharoor who received 34.09% votes. Rajagopal had increased his vote share by more than 20 percentage points when compared to the 2009 elections. Apparently after the party took strong exception to Rajagopal's praise for Tharoor, the former Nemom MLA who had won the first Assembly seat for the BJP in Kerala in 2016, came out with an explanation. "In the changed political scenario and on account of (Narendra) Modi government's performance, chances of (BJP) winning Thiruvananthapuram is high. My personal and political stand is that BJP will win Thiruvananthapuram this time. Tharoor's presence in the constituency is insignificant," he said.

Reacting to the development, Tharoor on Tuesday said Rajagopal might have changed his stand following the party's intervention. "He is leading a sanyasi life. He does not have any political requirements from BJP or Congress. I am sure that people would decide. If the party allows me, I would contest again and seek votes. People will make the decision not based on Rajagopal's words. When he contested against me in 2014, I had given him the respect due to a rival. He is very senior and he should be given that benefit," he said. The BJP has not officially commented on Rajagopal's praise for Tharoor, but party sources said he came out with the explanation at the intervention of the party. Rajagopal has embarrassed the party many times in the past. In November last year, when the BJP boycotted a CPI(M) government cultural extravaganza in the state capital, Rajagopal took part openly coming out against the boycott. Ahead of 2021 Assembly polls, Rajagopal, then sitting legislator of Nemom, had made a similar prediction. Referring to BJP candidate Kummamam Rajasekharan, who was fielded at Nemom, Rajagopal had said "Rajasekharan's chances were dim".

Sena UBT goes to SC over Shinde, Narwekar meet

New Delhi: The Shiv Sena (UBT) Court objecting to a meeting between Maharashtra Speaker Rahul Narwekar and Chief Minister Eknath Shinde just days before the court's deadline to Narwekar to decide on disqualification pleas against rebel MLAs led by Shinde was set to expire. Under the deadline set by the SC, Narwekar has until 4 pm on January 10 to decide on the fate of Shinde and his MLAs, whose rebellion split the Sena and led to the fall of Uddhav-led Maha Vikas Aghadi government in June 2022.
