# Chhattisgarh Cong unveils manifesto for urban body polls; gives 34 promises

RATIPUR, FEB 5 /- Chhattisgarh Congress on Wednesday released its manifesto for the February 11 urban body polls in the state, giving 34 promises. Like doorstep delivery of some important certificates, free Wi-Fi at public places and installation of CCTV cameras near school and colleges.

The party also promised to provide free sanitary pads to female students in school and colleges and regularisation of contractual employees of municipal corporations.

Pradesh Congress Committee president Deepak Bari, former MIA Stayanarayan Sharma, who is the convener of the party's manifesto committee for urban body polls, said the leaders released the manifesto, titled 'Jan Ghoshna Patra', comprising 34 promises, at the party office 'Rajiv Bhavan' here. The key manifesto promises include construction of fully equipped Anganwadi centres in all wards, free sanitary pads to school students in schools and

colleges, home delivery facility for birth, death and marriage certificates, setting up of youth hubs in all municipal areas to provide employment, special initiatives to provide employment to women self-help groups, women's toilet in urban commercial areas and free Wi-Fi facility at public places. Highlighting other promises, Bari said, for women's safety, arrangements will be made to install CCTV cameras at all squares of the cities and near schools and colleges in coordination with the police control room, Bari said.

Under Shradhanjali Rashi Yojana, financial assistance of Rs 2,000 will be given to families belonging to below poverty lines (for last rites after someone from their families dies), he said. "Efforts will be made to regularise contractual employees of corporations. Facility of paying property tax, consolidated tax and water tax in one bill will be provided. In the next six months, wherever an online building permit granting facility is not available, it will be provided. The house allotment process will be simplified and all homeless people will be provided houses as per their eligibility," Bari

said. Information about sanitation staffs working in each ward will be publicly displayed.

A fully-equipped free library facility will be set up in each urban body for students to prepare for competitive exams, he said. Mobile cart vendors will be given protection and suitable space will be provided for business by marking vending zones at prominent places in the wards. Community halls will be provided free of cost in all municipal areas for the marriage of women. Landless persons occupying government land will be given retention rights to hold the land. Meritorious students will be awarded with an encouragement amount in all government schools, he said.

A citizens' charter will be made in all Congress-led municipalities by setting deadlines for the completion of their works. Special discounts will be provided on payment of property tax within the stipulated time and hi-tech rest rooms will be built for journalists in all municipal corporations, he said. Necessary steps will be taken to make the cities free from dust and stray cattle, he added.(PTI)

# Uttarakhand: Live-in relation registered in 10 days after UCC implementation

DEHRADUN, FEB 5 /- Only one live-in relationship has been registered in Uttarakhand's Uniform Civil Code (UCC) portal in the first 10 days of its implementation.

Officials claimed that five applications have been received from live-in couples for the mandatory registration. One has been granted registration while four others are being verified, they said. On January 27, the BJP-ruled Uttarakhand became the first state in Independent India to implement the Uniform Civil Code, which promotes equal laws for every citizen across all religions and standardises personal laws on marriage, divorce and property. On the occasion, Chief Minister Pushkar Singh Dhami launched a portal designed for the mandatory online registration of marriages, divorce and live-in relationships. He was the first to register his marriage on the UCC portal. The UCC's provision for mandatory registration of live-in relationships has been much criticised for its potential to infringe upon people's right to privacy.

However, Chief Minister Pushkar Singh Dhami has justified it by saying mandatory registration of live-in couples would help prevent brutal incidents like the murder of Shradha Walker by her live-in partner Aftab. Section 498A of the UCC, if a live-in couple fails to submit a statement of their relationship within one month of entering into the alliance to the authorities concerned, they shall be punished on conviction by a judicial magistrate with imprisonment for a term which may extend to three months or a fine not exceeding Rs 10,000 or both. The UCC says the punishment will extend to an imprisonment of up to six months and a fine of up to Rs 25,000 or both if live-in couples do not apply for registration.
