Gujarat unveils chip policy, plans to offer sops

THE GUJARAT GOVERNMENT on Wednesday announced a dedicated 'Gujarat Semiconductor Policy 2022-27' with a view to generate at least 2,00,000 new employment opportunities during a period of five years.

With this, Gujarat has become the first state in the country to have dedicated semiconductor policy. In the new policy the state government has decided to give heavy subsidies on power, land and water tariffs for entrepreneurs interested in investing in semiconductors or display fabrication manufacturing in the state.

The policy will facilitate effective and timely execution of the eligible projects for setting up a robust semiconductor and display fabrication ecosystem, said a senior official with the state science and technology department.

It may be mentioned that the central government has recently announced the India Semiconductor Mission (ISM) and it has already come out with four policies providing support to semiconductor and display fab projects.

The Gujarat policy focuses on guiding a significant portion of investments made under these ISM policies towards Gujarat, said an official closely connected with the formation of the policy.

Under the policy Gujarat will provide additional capital assistance at 40% of the capex assistance extended by the Centre for the projects approved under ISM.

As per the policy one project each of semiconductor and display fabrication will get support. In case of multiple applications, the State-appointed high-powered committee will make recommendations on the basis of credentials of projects.

Housing prices rise 15% during April-June

AVERAGE HOUSING PRICE rose up to 15% during April-June across 9 major cities, with Chennai witnessing the highest appreciation of 15%, according to data analytic firm PropEquity.

The weighted average price rose by 15% in Chennai to ₹6,744 per square feet in the June quarter from ₹5,855 per square feet in the year-ago period. Gurugram witnessed 12% increase in prices to ₹11,517 per square feet from ₹10,315 per square feet, and Hyderabad too saw 12% rise to ₹6,472 per square feet from ₹5,764 per square feet.

The average prices in Noida rose 9% to ₹7,411 per square feet. In Bengaluru, the prices were up 8% to ₹6,196 per square feet from ₹5,760 per square feet. Housing prices in Mumbai, Thane and Pune increased by 3%. In Mumbai, the prices of residential properties rose to ₹18,896 per square feet from ₹18,259 per square feet, while in Thane, the rates appreciated to ₹6,325 per square feet from ₹6,165 per square feet.

New UK parliamentary panel to promote trade with India

A NEW CROSS-PARTY UK parliamentary panel has been created to promote trade, investment and people-to-people ties with India, backed up by British Indian think tank 1928 Institute. The India (Trade and Investment) All Party Parliamentary Group was formally registered last week and is made up of 25 members of Parliament. -PTI
