# Many Indian citizens left out: Assam govt

The Assam government on Saturday claimed that many genuine Indian citizens have been left out of the final National Register of Citizens (NRC) but they need not panic as they can appeal to the Foreigners Tribunal (FT).

The government will provide legal support to the excluded people, Assam Parliamentary Affairs Minister Chandrababoo Patowary said. "One thing is sure that many genuine Indians were left out of the NRC," he

said. "We have increased the number of FTs to 300 from 100. The additional FTs will start functioning from Monday," said Patowary, also the spokesperson of the Assam government.

## BIMAL JALAN: CHAIRMAN, EXPERT COMMITTEE TO REVIEW RBI'S ECONOMIC CAPITAL FRAMEWORK

### The go-to advisor across the political spectrum

In 2007, Bimal Jalan had written a commentary of what he saw in Parliament. It was a period of bitter divisions in both the Houses and the former Reserve Bank governor bluntly expressed his shock as the Rajya Sabha, in the midst of utter pandemonium, pass in a jiffy hundreds of papers, including annual reports of public sector organisations, outcome and performance budgets, action-taken reports, and notifications issued by various departments by a dozen ministers.

These comments on this dereliction of parliamentary duty were captured in his book *Indian Politics: A View from the Backbench* published in 2007. He has gone on to write several other books before and after but this was the most acerbic.

"Three of the highest offices of the state — those of president, vice-president and prime minister — are now held by persons who were nominated at the last minute by the leader of the largest party in the multi-party coalition in power. The elected representatives of the people in Parliament and state legislatures had no prior knowledge but duly voted, where voting was required, to confirm the decision of a select group of party leaders".

Jalan does not pull his punches despite his low-key demeanour. That was evident in the report submitted by the expert committee he chaired to review the extant economic capital framework of the



RBI. The issue had been a febrile one for the government for some months, especially with the underperformance in tax revenues raising the ask for funds transfers from the central bank.

One of the reasons Jalan can afford to be forthright is that he has seen it all in his 78 years. He has successfully held the posts of chief economic advisor, banking secretary and then the finance secretary in the Government of India in 1981-90 before he went on to become the executive director for India at the International Monetary Fund (IMF) from 1991-93. It was the most significant period in India's economic history when the nation lurched into the balance of payments crisis.

Incidentally, Jalan is the only bureaucrat in India who has been executive director at both the IMF

and then the World Bank, successively. After negotiating the IMF bailout as part of India's economic crisis management team under Manmohan Singh, Jalan's next assignment was to convince the World Bank to stand by India instead of putting in a spanner in the works by imposing stiff conditions in its aid programmes.

By the time he returned to India from these assignments, it was possibly inevitable that he would be made the governor of the RBI in 1997. He was there for the longest term for any governor and resigned when he was selected by the Atal Bihari Vajpayee government to become a nominated member of the Upper House in 2003. The current principal secretary in the Prime Minister's Office, Nripendra Mishra, was one of the directors reporting to Jalan when he was

finance secretary. It is not surprising that he was so disillusioned when he saw how Parliament was unable to discuss even the Budget. "As in the previous year and the year before, the Union Budget for 2007-08 was also approved by the two Houses of Parliament within a few minutes without discussion in the midst of scuffle and disruption."

All the same, his experience across the bureaucrat-politician spectrum certainly stood in good stead, making him the go-to man even now for most political parties. He was appointed to the RBI by the Deve Gowda government, and was given an extension on his seat by the first National Democratic Alliance government. The Kolkata-born student of Presidency College was a favourite of the Left Front, too. He subsequently went on to earn his Ph.D from elsewhere. He has studied at both University of Cambridge and at Oxford University.

Jalan has this month released his latest book, *Resurgent India*.

Books by former governors of the RBI including his successor Y V Reddy, D Subba Rao and Raghuram Rajan have become the prism through which commentators now describe much of India's economic history. The launch of each of them have also become the forums for incumbent governments to get a taste of the public mood on key economic policies. Jalan did not disappoint.

Speaking about the proposal for sovereign bonds, he said the government should borrow only long-term fund from the overseas market, and the amount should not exceed 1.5 per cent of GDP under any circumstances. This, just after Rajan and Reddy had criticised the proposal announced by Finance Minister Nirmala Sitharaman in her Budget speech.

# Restrictions lifted in most parts of Kashmir

Restrictions were lifted from most parts of Kashmir on Saturday, a day after strict curbs on the movement of people were imposed in view of Friday congregational prayers, officials said.

Restrictions have been lifted from most areas of the Valley on Saturday morning, the officials said.

They said barricades have been removed from the roads in most areas of the city and elsewhere in the Valley to allow

the movement of people.

However, deployment of security forces continued on the ground to maintain law and order, the officials said.

Strict restrictions on the movement of people were imposed across the valley on Friday in view of apprehensions of law and order problems after congregational prayers.

Only ambulances and people in emergency situations

were allowed to move. The officials said the situation remained peaceful on Friday and no untoward incident was reported from anywhere in the Valley.

However, normal life remained affected across the Valley for the 27th consecutive day on Saturday.

The markets continued to remain shut, while public transport was off the roads, the officials said, adding schools also remained closed. The officials said

telephone services have been restored in most places across the Valley in view of the improving situation, though the services continued to remain snapped in Lal Chowk and Press Enclave here.

The mobile services and internet, including BSNL's Broadband and private leased-line internet, remained snapped since August 5 after the Centre announced its decision to abrogate Jammu and Kashmir's special status under Article 370 of the Constitution and reorganised the state into two Union territories.

# 13 killed in explosions at chemical factory in Maharashtra

Thirteen workers, including six women, were killed and 64 others injured in explosions of nitrogen gas cylinders at a chemical factory in North Maharashtra's Dhule district on Saturday morning, police said.

Preliminary probe revealed that a chemical leak caused a fire which led to serial explosions at the factory of Runit Chemsynth, located at Waghandi village in Shirpur tehsil, at around 9.45 am, a senior police officer told PTI. By evening, the fire had been doused, and search was on for more bodies, if any, in the debris, he said.

"At least 100 workers were present in the factory at the time of the incident," the officer added.

Teams of fire brigade, police, and the State Disaster Response Force conducted the relief and rescue operations.

The deafening sound of explosions caused panic in the vicinity, prompting people to rush out of houses.

Chief Minister Devendra Fadnis expressed grief over the deaths, and announced ₹5 lakh compensation to the kin of the deceased.

"(District) Guardian Minister, Collector, SP (Superintendent of Police) on spot. SDRF team reached...CM Devendra Fadnis also announced ₹5 lakh to the kin of deceased," the Chief Minister's Office (CMO) tweeted.

# OMCs warn Air India of stopping supply at two more airports

Flight services of flag carrier Air India, including those for Haj pilgrimage, may be hit partially after Indian Oil Corporation (IOC)-led oil marketing companies (OMCs) threatened to suspend fuel supplies at two more airports — Hyderabad and Raipur — over non-payment

OMCs at some airports have already stopped supplying fuel to Air India since August 22

The three OMCs — IOC, Hindustan Petroleum and Bharat Petroleum — together have around ₹4,300 crore in dues from Air India.

Though Air India is on cash-and-carry mode since April this year and making a payment of ₹18 crore per day towards daily jet fuel bill, the OMCs have sought clearance of all dues at the earliest.

"The OMCs have asked Air India to make a lump sum payment towards outstanding amount including interest at the earliest, saying if the carrier fails to do so,

they will extend the suspension of fuel supplies to Hyderabad and Raipur airports as well from September 6," a source privy to the development told PTI.

He said that Air India does not have international operations from the six airports where the OMCs have not been supplying jet fuel to its flights since August 22.

"However, if it is stopped in Hyderabad as well, there will be severe impact on some of our overseas flights as well as Haj operations in addition to domestic operations," he said. "Air India's total fuel bill dues were ₹4,600 crore as of March 31, 2019 which came down to ₹4,300 crore by July 31," the source said.
