IRB Infra & its Private InvIT Arm’s collective toll collection for February 2023 ups 27% to Rs. 351.75 Crs, as against Rs. 277.47 Crs in February 2022

Mumbai, March 9, 2023: The collective toll collection across all projects of IRB Infrastructure Developers Limited, India’s leading and largest multi-national infrastructure player in the highways sector and its private InvIT arm, IRB Infrastructure Trust, has gone up by **27%** in February 2023 as against the toll collection in February 2022.

The Company has reported February 2023 toll collection at **Rs. 351.75 Crs**, against Rs. 277.47 Crs in February 2022.
