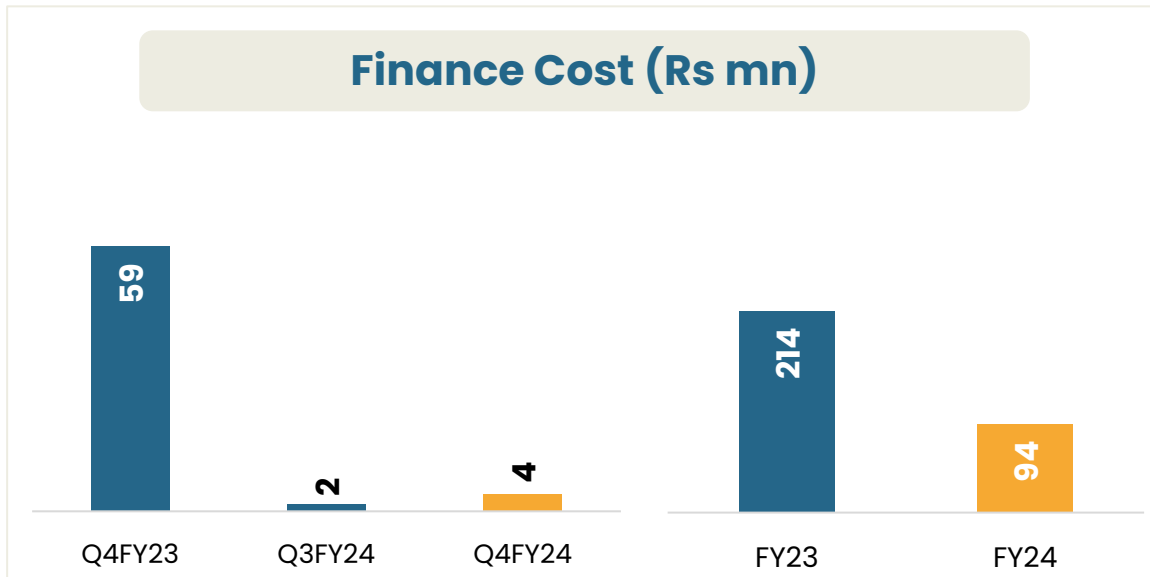
Revenue (Rs mn)



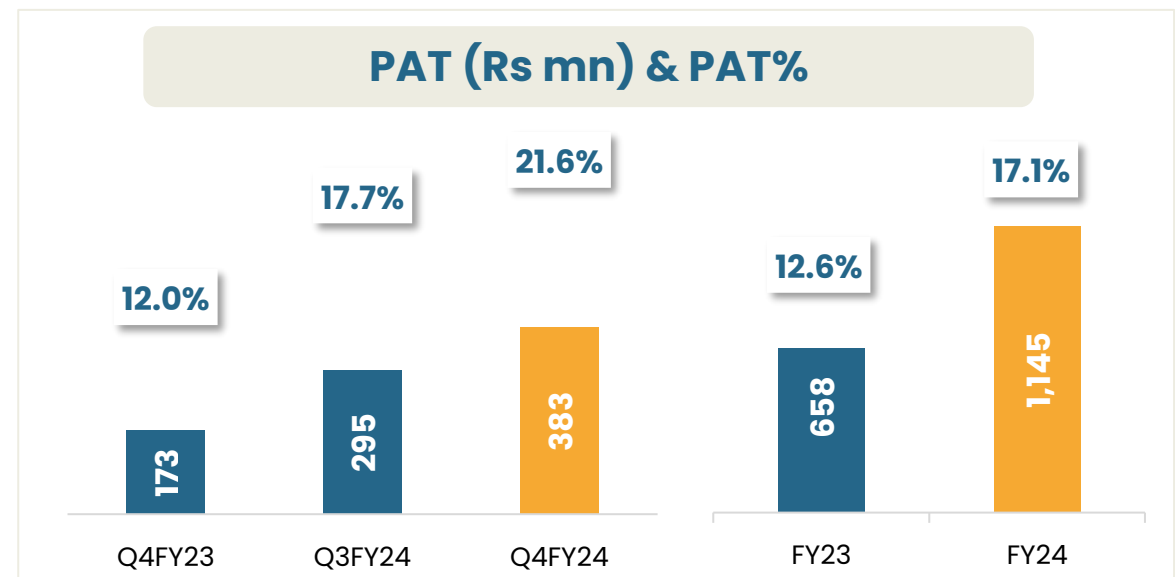
EBITDA (Rs mn) & EBITDA%



Finance Cost (Rs mn)

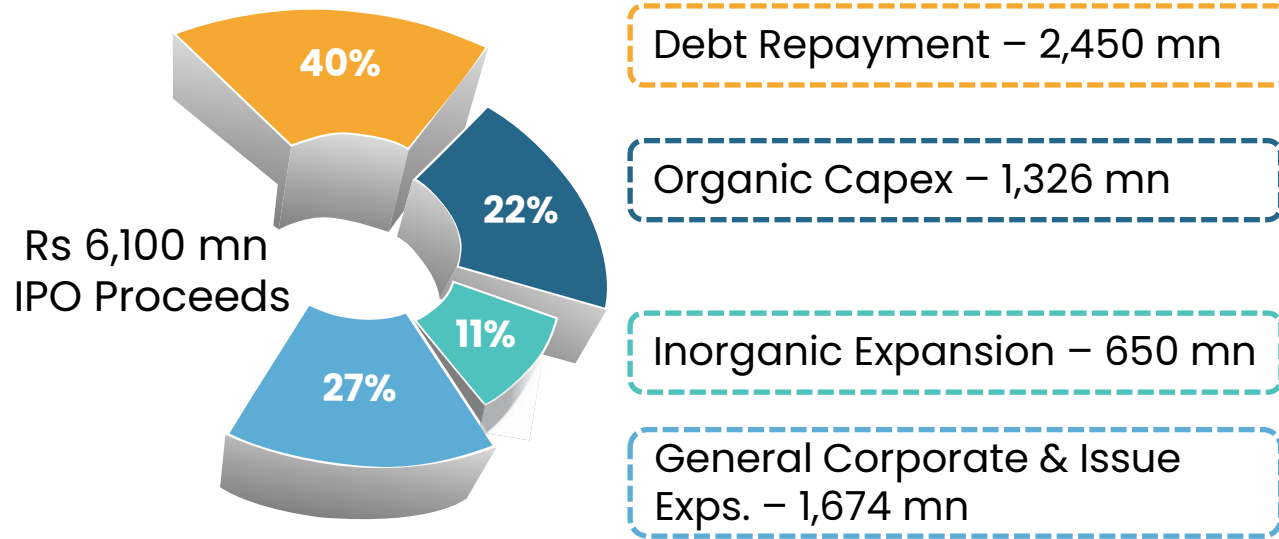

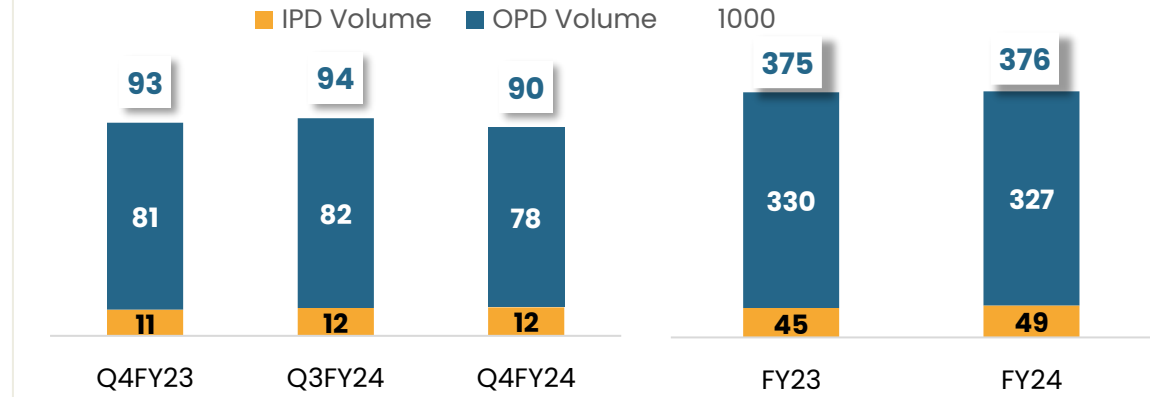

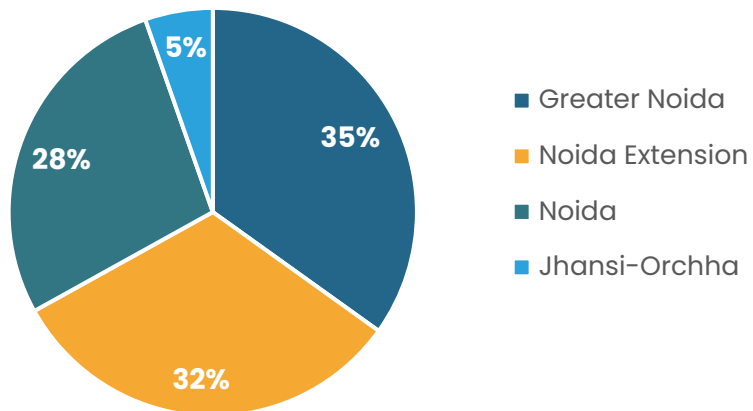
IPD & OPD Revenue (Rs mn)



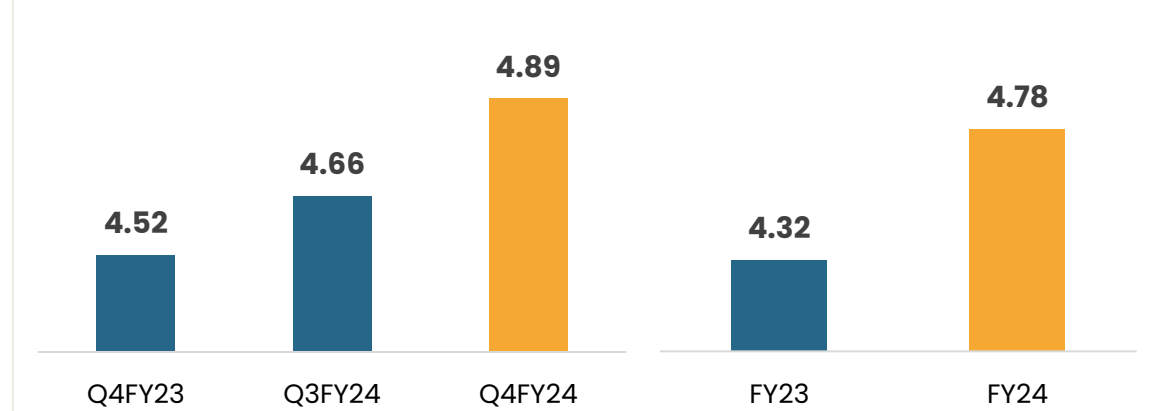
IPD & OPD Volumes (in '000s)



Revenue Mix – FY24 (%)



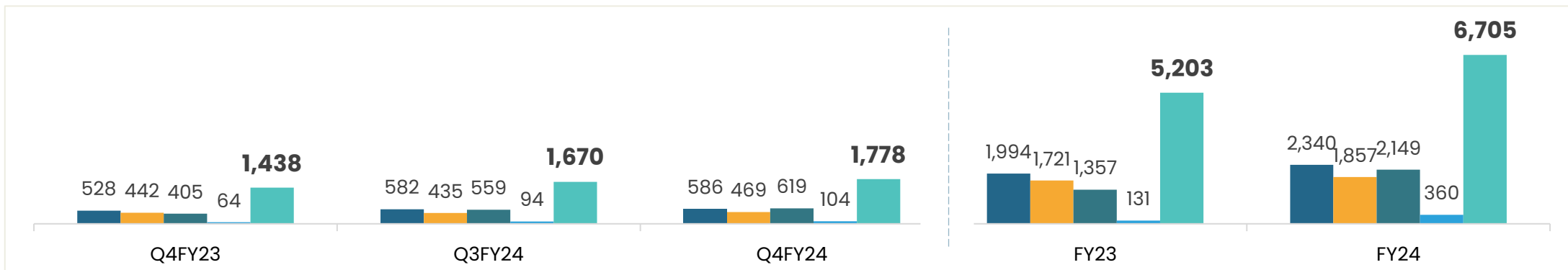

Performing the liver transplant on this patient was a challenging yet rewarding experience. The surgery required careful planning and precision



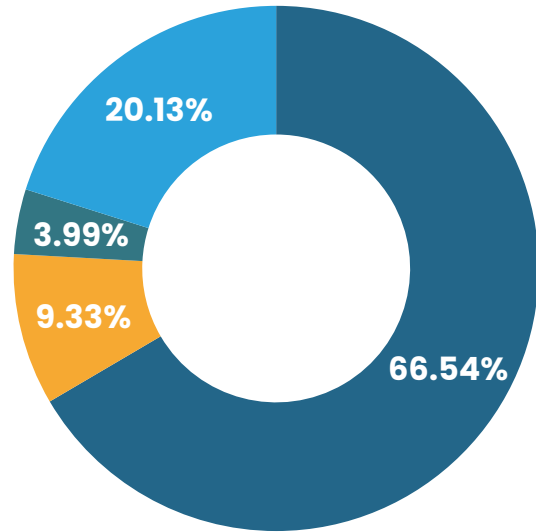
