ECB honour for Stokes on 100th Test match

Rajkot, Feb 15: As a part of the celebrations for Ben Stokes's 100th Test that will be on Thursday, the England Cricket Board put out a six-minute-three-second video on their website with his current teammates being given a photo each capturing their favourite moments with the English skipper over the years of playing with him.

Each of them spoke high about Stokes, his match-winning knocks or bowling efforts or simply a stunning catch in the slip cordon. One common thing that stood out was their admiration and respect for Stokes as a complete team-man, putting everything else above self.

This was visible in the way he has handled this team since taking over as captain two years ago. And, on Wednesday, at the pre-match media conference, the 32-year-old from Durham put on his leadership cap and spoke how the team was important and rallying around his players was so crucial to him than just talking about his milestone game or all about himself.

Stokes and his coach Brendon McCullum have guided this England team in a new direction, in playing aggressive cricket and scoring at a run rate in Test cricket that used to be very good for the limited-overs cricket.

And, Stokes is available for lengthy conversations with his players at good times and bad. After taking not more than seven minutes to look at the pitch on Wednesday before the team's training session, McCullum and Stokes, along with selector Luke Wright and performance analyst Rupert Lewis, decided on the playing 11 for the third Test beginning on Thursday. In the only change to the playing 11 that was involved in the 106-run loss to India in Visakhapatnam last week, England have brought back seamer Mark Wood and left out off-spinner Shoab Bashir, who debuted in the Port City of Andhra Pradesh. India haven't named their playing 11 until after the toss.

"Baz (McCullum) does all the good news and the bad news, and I am there to speak to any of the players if they want any further conversations with that. Bash (Bashir) performed incredibly well in his first Test for England. He wants to play every game possible. I've got no doubt there will be more opportunities going forward in this series. He is more than happy to be there, helping out the lads and improving his skill every single day," Stokes, who will be playing in his 100th Test here, said that the Rehan Ahmed

visa issue has been sorted. He said: "It's always one of those situations for an individual to wait and go through the anxious period. Thankfully, we got through this morning. The (Rajkot) airport had given his visa initially but then everyone at BCCI, the government got the visa through quickly. We don't have to worry about any more of those issues. We were very confident of getting the visa before the game started. No thoughts about not playing him this week. It's about youth, taking everything in their stride. He handled the situation that could have affected quite a lot of people very well. He's such a young kid. In the Test matches he has played so far, he has done very well. He has done everything that we have asked of him, gone out and tried to deliver and am looking forward to the game with him this week."

Stokes did not believe in wasting time with the blame game as to who's responsible for the visa issues, bringing to the fore his leadership skills, a good man-manager that he is besides scoring runs and picking up those wickets and taking some incredible catches.

He said: "When you have problems like this, rather than blame someone or find the blame, you just go and find the solution. We have had two of those situations on this trip. And, we managed to do that (find solutions). I don't know what goes on and how we

ended up in this situation. When the situation came up at the airport, we tried to do what we needed to do rather than waste time finding whose fault it was."

Was saddened to hear that 'Churchgate', the most recognised railway station in the country, was being renamed. Churchgate, signified many decades ago, the entrance gate to the Fort of Bombay, where a church stood. So, the gate got to be called 'Churchgate' and since the station was built down the same road, it bore the same name.

Just imagine the unfolding of pages of history, with just a name opening it up.

I see the same happening elsewhere: A church choir in good ole Madras, now Chennai, decided to have a reunion of its old members, many who'd sung in it, more than fifty years ago. The reason being they were not part of the choir anymore.

Shouldn't the present board members have realised they were just stewards of the church, and that the church's history also belonged to the old choir members. But they made the mistake of imagining they were the 'owners' of time!

When stewards think they are owners, catastrophe happens, and the environmental issues we face today are mostly because of that. Imagining we were the owners of the earth we passed on a sick and dying planet to them.

And those on that church board deserve no less a punishment. They took away from the present congregation the right to listen to music and choral singing their fathers had grown up on.

History was literally torn out of their grasp.

It's like a billionaire shouting, and many do so, "I am a self-made man!"

"Self-made man," whispers his dead mother from the grave, "It was I who carried him to school!"

"And I, who paid his fees, working overtime!" nods his father also from the grave.

I can hear the walls of that same church in Vepery whisper, "Those choral voices of old, built the love for singing the present congregation now has!"

But till we change our attitude from being owners to realising we are stewards of a slot of time, such warning whispers from walls and graves will go unheard, and future generations will be robbed of their rightful heritage..!
