We did not review the consolidated interim financial information of one subsidiary included in the consolidated unaudited financial results, whose interim financial information reflects total revenues of Rs. 3,545.61 lakhs and Rs. 7,583.08 lakhs, total net (loss) after tax of (Rs. 69.55) lakhs and (Rs. 97.27) lakhs and total comprehensive income/(loss) of (Rs. 4.54) lakhs and Rs. 35.03 lakhs, for the quarter ended December 31, 2020 and for the period April 1, 2020 to December 31, 2020, respectively, as considered in the consolidated unaudited financial results. This interim financial information has been reviewed by other auditors in accordance with SRE 2400, Engagements to Review Historical Financial Statements and their report dated February 9, 2021, vide which they have issued an unmodified conclusion, has been furnished to us by the Management and our conclusion on the Statement, in so far as it relates to the amounts and disclosures included in respect of this subsidiary, is based solely on the report of the other auditors and the procedures performed by us as stated in paragraph 3 above. Our conclusion on the Statement is not modified in respect of this matter.

The consolidated unaudited financial results also include the interim financial information of one subsidiary, which has not been reviewed by their auditors, whose interim financial information reflects total revenues of Rs. 17.29 lakhs and Rs. 26.90 lakhs, total net profit after tax of Rs. 12.89 lakhs and Rs. 21.86 lakhs and total comprehensive income of Rs. 18.30 lakhs and Rs. 27.00 lakhs, for the quarter ended December 31, 2020 and for the period April 1, 2020 to December 31, 2020 respectively, as considered in the consolidated unaudited financial results. According to the information and explanations given to us by the Management, this interim financial information is not material to the Group. Our conclusion on the Statement is not modified in respect of this matter.
