Fag-end selling drags Sensex down 141 points

STOCK MARKET BENCH-MARK SENSEX on Monday declined by 141 points after a volatile session, dragged down by fag-end selling in blue-chip banking, pharma and IT, amidst a gloomy global trade

Among the major losers, oil retailer BPCL dropped more than 5% as it closed on a profit that the government has decreased the way of operation. Top gainers in the Sensex pack included ONGC, ITC, Tata Steel, M&M, Tata Motors, L&T, TCS, Sun Pharma, NTPC, Industrial Bank of India, and others.

Pharma major Glenmark tumbled more than 9% at the close after the US health regulators issued a warning letter to its manufacturing plant in Himachal Pradesh.

Aurobindo Pharma dived more than 12% after reports that the USFDA has issued observations to its facilities for violations of good manufacturing practices. The company clarified that the USFDA issues seven observations after an inspection, but none of the observations is related to data integrity. Lupin and Cipla also fell.

Cipla by 2.35%, and Sun Pharma dropped 1.57%. Defensive pharma stocks were up due to increasing USFDA observations while IT slid ahead of lackluster third quarter earnings, analysts said.

Devi Housing Finance Corp dropped 9.52% after deputy CEO said the shareholding of its promoters due to delay in the release of financial results. Banking fell, as did Yes Bank, which fell 0.8% on prospect of fresh investments in the company. Axis Bank, Bajaj Auto, Bharat Airtel, LIC, ICICI Bank, Hero MotoCorp and Rajiv Finance also rose to 0.23% on BSE.

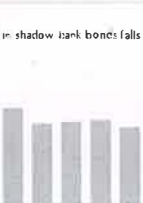
Shadow bank crisis in India makes it hard to cut bond losses
