A mixed bag for Air India under Tatas

Loses almost 3% of its market share, but sees a rise in passenger numbers

It will be a long road ahead for the Tatas to turnaround Air India, according to industry experts. The airline has lost almost three per cent of the market share in the past six months. In January, it had a market share of 10.2 per cent, which dropped to 7.5 per cent in June, and lost most of its market share to Vistara.

On the other hand, the passengers carried by Air India between January and June recorded an increase of 19 per cent.

'To play a bigger role' But industry experts aren't worried. According to most of them, they'd give a benefit

of the doubt to the Tatas. The Tatas re-entered the airline market in 2013 with Vistara and AirAsia India. For almost a decade now, they have been closely observing how an ICAI-AirAsia India and ICAI-Vistara have been operating. They are now ready to play the bigger innings, and the purchase of the divested Air India airline is a testimony, Ram Shankar, Independent aviation expert explained.

Experts say that being a full-service carrier, Air India could possibly increase average fares.

However, "though Air India was acquired by the Tatas, the product and the

crew remain the same. Over the years, the quality has deteriorated, and it needs improvement", explained a senior aviation analyst, requesting anonymity.

On the flip side, though, experts are betting on Air India's fleet expansion strategy to be a huge game-changer, "which could support Tata's negotiation scale in fuel, maintenance, aircraft leasing, landing and parking fees, airport charges for commercial offices and technology licences", Shankar explained.

Another major achievement for Air India, according to one of the persons quoted above, is the voluntary retirement scheme. According to reports, over 4,500 employees of Air India have opted for the scheme.

The person explained: "This reduces a lot of dead weight from the company. Eventually, it will make space for deserving candidates."

'Monkeypox not a new disease'

Monkeypox is not a new disease in India and the world and it has been around since 1970s, Union Health Minister Mansukh Madaviya told Rajya Sabha on Tuesday.

In a bid to allay fears around the virus and its spread, the Minister further said that the ICMR has already isolated a virus strain and that the Ministry is open to working with vaccine-makers to develop a cure.

According to the Minister's response, there have been eight cases of monkeypox in the country till August 1, which includes one death. Many of these have a history of foreign travel. The first monkeypox case was reported from Kerala on July 14. So far, five cases (including one death) have been reported from Kerala and three from Delhi.

Monitoring, surveillance and contact tracing have begun and guidelines issued to States on the matter.
