

Indian Railways Introduced New Freight Incentive Schemes



Ahmedabad, In a bid to boost the freight traffic by Indian Railways, Western Railway, under the dynamic leadership & able guidance of Shri Alok Kansal- General Manager of WR, has set up multi-disciplinary Business Development Units (BDU) at Zonal Headquarters and its Divisional Units. The aim of setting up these BDUs is to improve business prospects in freight market by incorporating new ideas and initiatives. As per the directives of the Railway Board, Western Rly has now come up with five new incentive schemes to attract freight transporters to tie up with Railways for transportation of their goods and parcels, in addition to earlier freight incentives. With the help of these new incentives, Indian Railways will offer the traffic to freight customers at competitive unit rates, which are lower as compared to Road transportation and to add to this, freight will be delivered to the destination at

speedier pace with assured timings. According to a press release issued by Shri Sumit Thakur - Chief Public Relations Officer of Western Railway, these Freight Incentive Schemes are in existence to provide ease of business to customers and to garner additional volume of traffic and revenue to the Railways. Here are the five latest major schemes available for transportation of goods through Railways:

- 1) Permissible Carrying capacity for PET Coke: The Permissible Carrying Capacity (PCC) has been lowered by 2 to 5 tonnes for loading of Pet Coke for BOXN & BONHL w.e.f. 13th October, 2019, while for BOXNHS has been effective from 27th June, 2020. Similarly, the liberalised PCC of BOXNR, BOXNCR, BOXNHSM1, BOXNM1 and BOXNEL has been liberalised w.e.f. 5th August, 2020. These load relaxations are valid upto 11th October, 2020. - 2) Discount on Haulage Charges for movement of loaded containers: On the lines of 25% discount being

given on haulage rate per TEU for movement of empty Containers & empty flat wagons, Railway Board has granted a 5% discount on haulage charge per TEU rates for movement of loaded containers. This is with effect from 4th August, 2020 to 30th April, 2021. More details regarding this freight incentive can be found on - https://www.indianrailways.gov.in/railwayboard/uploads/directorate/traffic_comm/Freight_Rate_2020/Discount%20on%20loaded%20containers%2003082020.pdf- 3) Classification of Salt for Industrial Use: Railway Board has sanctioned the reduction of classification of 'Salt for Industrial Use' from Class 120 to Class 100A. Salt for Industrial Use has been allowed to be loaded as loose condition in open wagons. The loose loading is permitted with condition that the floor of wagons and sides are covered by tarpaulins so as to ensure that there should not be any damage/corrosion of wagons due to Salt. In case of such damage/corrosion, customer will be liable to pay for such damages. The instructions for this incentive are effective from 5th August, 2020 and is valid till further notice. - 4) Loading of Fly Ash in open wagons under Freight Incentive Scheme: Concession was given to loading of Fly Ash in uniform bagged condition. Railway Board has permitted loose/bulk loading in open wagons for Fly Ash, for three types of wagons such as for Open Wagons 40% concession on NTR of applicable class with packing condition of bagged or bulk/loose, for Flat Wagons 40% concession on NTR of applicable class with packing condition as bagged and Covered Wagons which will be charged at NTR of Class LR1 with the packing condition as bagged. Customers may note that Open Wagons have also been permitted for bulk/loose loading. In case of bagged Fly Ash, it should be in uniform bags of standard size and in case of loose Fly Ash, customer must ensure hydrating the Fly Ash and covering the wagons with tarpaulins, at its own cost. Tarpaulins, if any being used for covering the bagged Fly Ash in open wagons should also be provided by the customers at their own cost. The customer will be required to furnish an undertaking on the Forwarding Note giving their consent to loading of bagged Fly Ash in open & flat wagons, and to the effect that

they would bear the full risk of damage/pilferage of the consignment. Customers shall strictly ensure the adherence to the conditions stipulated by State/Central Government regarding pollution control. These instructions will be effective from 8th August, 2020. More details regarding this can be found on - http://www.indianrailways.gov.in/railwayboard/uploads/directorate/traffic_comm/Freight_Rate_2020/fly%20ash%20concession%2003082020.pdf- 5) Stabling Charge in case of Container Traffic: Railway Board has also relaxed stabling charges applicable @ Rs. 525/- per wagons per day, hence no stabling charge shall be levied in case of Container Traffic from 18th May, 2020 to 31st October, 2020. Shri Thakur stated that earlier 14 freight incentives schemes were implemented for the benefit of freight customers & in addition to those now 5 more freight incentives have been initiated, which will definitely play a vital role in boosting the freight traffic over Western Railway.

Kudos to PM Modi for "Raksha Bandhan gift" to women of Manipur



The human right to water include five factors which are sufficient, safe, acceptable, physically accessible and affordable, however in these five factors, sufficiency and safety are the top two serious issues which is the need of the hour.

The Manipur Water Supply project, an externally funded project, was designed to provide FHTCs to remaining households in the Greater Imphal Planning area, 25 towns, and for 1,731 rural habitations covering 2,80,756 households in 16 districts of Manipur.

Access to drinking water is a priority and our union finance minister Nirmala

Sitharaman has during her Union Budget 2019 speech, reiterated the newly formed Jal Shakti Ministry's aim of 'Har Ghar Jal' by 2024 under the Jal Jeevan Mission. The water supply project in Manipur will help more than one women in Manipur. Many people living in poverty and are not having much of anything like safe places to live let alone clean and safe drinking water which also comes under good health due to drinking and washing in the polluted water it becomes even harder to stay healthy.

It is nice that the fund for the project has been provided by the Centre under 'Jal Jeevan Mission' to provide freshwater household tap connections (FHTCs) to 1,185 habitations with 1,42,749 households. Due to lack of clean and safe drinking water the issues that arise are diseases, lack of education, death just because of not having safe drinking water. Due to lack of safe drinking water there are diseases and viruses that are carried in the water to the rivers with

families then washing and drinking the water it becomes even worse, even more dirtier.

The project outlay is about Rs 3054.58 crore with a loan component funded by the New Development Bank. There is no doubt that the project is an important component of the efforts of the state government to achieve the goal of 'Har Ghar Jal' by 2024.

Flood-like situation, landslides continue to cause havoc in rain ravaged parts of Karnataka

Bengaluru, Flood like situation persists in the border regions of Belagavi district, with rising water levels in Krishna river and its tributaries due to rains in ghat areas of Maharashtra and water being released from the dams there. Flood-like situation and landslides continue to cause havoc in several parts of Karnataka that has been battered by torrential rains. Many places in Malnad, coastal and north interior regions of the state have been affected by deluge, putting life and properties at risk. While most of the rivers in these regions are swollen due to rising inflow because of showers continuing in the catchment areas, there are

reports of landslips in hilly regions of Kodagu and Chikkamagaluru. Flood like situation persists in the border regions of Belagavi district, with rising water levels in Krishna river and its tributaries due to rains in ghat areas of Maharashtra and water being released from the dams there. Adding to this, the district too has been receiving rains, inundating low lying areas and crops. In Uttara Kannada and Shivamogga districts also there is similar situation of swollen rivers and inundation of low lying areas. Water is being released from several dams in the state including Alamatti and Kabini by opening the gates as inflow has increased.

8.64 lakh people registered with Delhi govt's 'Rozgar Bazaar' job portal: Gopal Rai



New Delhi, Delhi Employment Minister Gopal Rai said on Friday that 8.64 lakh job aspirants have registered with the government's 'Rozgar Bazaar' job portal which has set up a "new model of employment" in the national capital. Addressing a press conference, Rai said there were currently nine lakh vacancies available on the portal, where 6,271 companies, including Flipkart, Amazon and HDFC Bank have made registrations.

The minister said around

22 lakh vacancies had been posted by employers at the job portal so far, out of which 3.5 lakh were cancelled by the department during scrutiny due to doubling or other reasons. "So far, around 10 lakh vacancies have been closed by companies after they initiated or completed the process of hiring candidates," he said. "The Delhi government's job portal has set up a new model of employment in Delhi." Rai, who is also the labour minister, said the AAP dispensation would soon launch a poster campaign to inform more job aspirants about 'Rozgar Bazaar'. He underlined that the government was providing a common platform where job seekers and employers could meet their requirements. The minister said there was no charge for this service and appealed to job aspirants to not pay money to those who promised to get them registered at the portal and jobs. Chief Minister Arvind Kejriwal had launched the job portal on July 27 and appealed to the traders, industrialists and people to join hands to revive Delhi's economy.

Helipad, 360 degree camera: Nepal's actions at India borders raises concern

Dehradun, The West Champaran districts officials in Bihar said that the Nepal government has started construction of a helipad at a disputed location on the Indo-Nepal border near Valmiki Tiger Reserve (VTR) in West Champaran district. At the same time, Indian officials in Rudraprayag district of Uttarakhand objected to Nepal authorities installing 360 degree CCTV cameras in no-man's land between the borders of the country countries.

The discontent, simmering on the border, has been growing since Nepal decided to include certain parts of Uttarakhand in its new map inviting strong objections from India with New Delhi dismissing Kathmandu's fresh territorial claims as untenable and without any historical evidence.

"To the best of our knowledge, construction of the helipad meant for small

choppers started a few days back on the disputed area," said Commandant Rajendra Bhardwaj of 21st SSB Battalion.

The helipad is near completion at Narsahi village, a short distance from Thari border outpost of Sashtra Seema Bal (SSB) near VTR, 80 km from Bettiah, headquarters of West Champaran district, he said, adding that he would send a report to the headquarters soon. In the western part of India-Nepal border in Uttarakhand's Champawat district, the authorities on Thursday raised objection to the installation of omnidirectional CCTV cameras by Nepalese personnel near the disputed land and asked Nepal officials to remove them, said India officials aware of the development.

District magistrate Champawat, Surendra Narayan Pandey, who attended the meet with Nepal officials on Tuesday, said, "The Nepalese side had installed CCTV cameras a few days ago at the border. When the meeting was held, the SSB from our side raised the issue before Nepal since omnidirectional CCTV cameras pose an obvious risk of monitoring of Indian security agencies."

"The Nepalese authorities reasoned that the cameras were meant to keep an eye on activities on their side of the border but we asked them to replace the 360 degrees cameras with uni-directional CCTV cameras, placed away from the Indian side of the border. They said they will consider the request," said Pandey. RK Tripathi, SSB Commandant near the Indo-

Nepal border confirmed the development and said, "We raised several issues in the meeting but didn't get any assurance from their side. They just said that they will try to solve them by dialogues." The informal meeting was attended by district magistrate of Champawat, superintendent of police (SP), Champawat and commandant of Sashstra Seema Bal (SSB) from the Indian side. The Nepalese side comprised chief district officer (equivalent to DM in India) of Kancharpur district adjoining the border in Nepal, SP Kancharpur and SP Armed Police Force (SSB's counterpart).

Science City organized Live Talk on Hiroshima Day



Ahmedabad, Gujarat ScienceCity organized a Live Talk on social media platform on #HiroshimaDay, today. It is also marked 75 years since the Japanese city was bombed by the United States during #WorldWarII in 1945. Dr. Mukesh Bhatt, Associate Professor Parekh Brothers Science College Kapadvanj, conducted the Live Talk. Explaining the science behind bombs, Dr. Bhatt commenced the thought-provoking session explaining fusion and fission reactions. He briefed the participants about various kinds of nuclear weapons including Atomic bomb, Hydrogen bomb and Salted bomb and electro-magnetic pulse weapons.

The resource person also briefed about the design and the operation of 'Little Boy' and

'Fat Man' code names given to bombs that were dropped on Hiroshima and Nagasaki respectively. "Little Boy" was dropped on #Hiroshima, which killed more than 80,000 and three days later (August 9, 1945), "Fat Man" killed more than 40,000 people in #Nagasaki.

Dr. Bhatt illustrated the devastating effects of the bomb with file pictures of the tragedies. The explosion was so huge that it immediately killed 70,000 people wiping 90% of the city and later on around 10,000 people died due to the effect of radiation exposure.

Before concluding, Professor Bhatt also narrated importance of peace, Nuclear Weapon-free world for the future of the #humankind and #PlanetEarth. --
