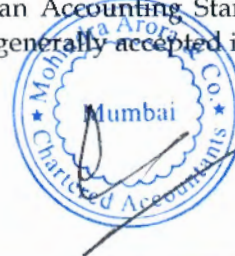
**Basis for Opinion**

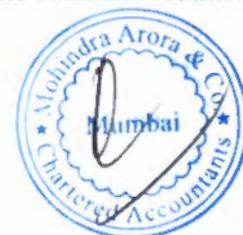
