**Kishida re-elected as Japan PM in special Parliament session**  
 TOKYO: Fumio Kishida, President of Japan's ruling Liberal Democratic Party (LDP), has been re-elected as Prime Minister in a special Parliament session after the LDP secured a majority of votes in the House of Representatives on October 31. Kishida is expected to appoint former education minister, Yoshimasa Hayashi, as his foreign minister, who leads a non-partisan parliamentarians' group promoting Japan-China relations.

# Historic resolution cements Xi's power

As only the third Chinese leader to have issued such a resolution, the move aims to establish Xi as an equal to party founder Mao Zedong and his successor Deng Xiaoping

A high-profile conclave of the ruling Communist Party of China (CPC) has adopted a "landmark resolution" of the party's major achievements in the last 100 years besides paving the way for a record third term for President Xi Jinping next year.

The "landmark resolution" - the only third of its kind in the party's 100-year history - was reviewed and adopted at the sixth plenary session of the 19th CPC Central Committee, held in Beijing from November 8 to 11, an official communique released at the end of the meeting on Thursday said.

The party is due to hold a press conference on Friday to announce further details. Xi made an important speech at the session. The meeting also heard and discussed a work report Xi delivered on behalf of the Political Bureau of the CPC Central Committee, it said.

He also explained the draft of the resolution whose details have not yet been revealed.

The session also reviewed and passed a resolution on convening the 20th National

Congress of the CPC in the second half of 2022 in Beijing, which was expected to formally endorse Xi's unprecedented third term.

Xi, 68, who holds China's all three power centres - General-Secretary of the CPC, Chairman of the powerful Central Military Commission (CMC) which is the overall high command of

the military, and the Presidency, is set to complete his second five-year tenure next year.

Politically, the meeting is regarded as significant for Xi who - in the last nine years of his tenure - has emerged as the most powerful leader after party founder Mao Zedong.

He is widely expected to

continue for a third term unlike his predecessor, Hu Jintao, who retired after two terms, and perhaps may remain in power for life in view of a key constitutional amendment in 2018 which removed the two-term limit for the President.

He was also made "core leader" of the party in 2016, a status enjoyed only by Mao.

## PREVIOUS RESOLUTIONS

Both Mao Zedong and Deng Xiaoping, who passed previous resolutions, used it as a way to break with the past.

The first resolution, adopted at a party plenum in 1945, helped Mao consolidate his leadership so that he had full authority when he declared the creation of the People's Republic of China in 1949.

When Deng took over as leader in 1978, he initiated the second resolution in 1981 where he criticised Mao's "errors" during the Cultural Revolution from 1966 to 1976, which led to millions of deaths. Deng also set the foundations for China's economic reforms.

## UN CLIMATE TALKS

# China, US pledge to increase cooperation

The world's top carbon polluters, China and the United States, agreed Wednesday to increase their cooperation and speed up action to rein in climate-damaging emissions, signalling a mutual effort on global warming at a time of tension over their other disputes.

In back-to-back news conferences at UN climate talks in Glasgow, Chinese climate envoy Xie Zhenhua and U.S. counterpart John Kerry said the two countries would work together to accelerate the emissions reductions required to meet the goals of the 2015 Paris Agreement on climate change.

"It's beneficial not only to our two countries but the world as a whole that two major powers in the world, China and the U.S., shoulder special international responsibilities and obligations," Xie told reporters.

"We need to think big and be responsible." "The steps we're taking ... can answer questions people have about the pace at which China is going, and help China and us to be able to accelerate our efforts," Kerry said.

China also agreed for the first time to crack down on methane leaks, following the lead of the Biden administration's efforts to curb the potent greenhouse gas. Beijing and Washington agreed to share technology to reduce emissions.

Governments agreed in Paris to jointly cut greenhouse gas emissions enough to keep the global temperature rise "well below" 2 degrees Celsius (3.6 degrees Fahrenheit) since pre-industrial times, with a more stringent target of trying to keep warming to 1.5 degrees Celsius (2.7 degrees Fahrenheit) preferred.

## Climate finance isn't charity: India

India's environment and climate minister says rich countries have "an obligation, responsibility, duty and a vow" to provide climate finance to developing nations and should deliver on an unfulfilled promise to raise \$100 bn a year. "Climate finance isn't charity. This is an obligation, responsibility, duty and a vow," Bhupender Yadav said.

# Pak FM calls for int'l engagement with Afghanistan

Urging the international community to continue to engage with the Taliban, Pakistan's Foreign Minister Shah Mehmood Qureshi said that engagements will help consolidate peace and stability and promote sustainable economic development in Afghanistan.

"No one wishes to see a relapse into civil war; no one wants an economic collapse that will spur instability. We all want to prevent a new refugee crisis," Ariana News quoted Qureshi as saying during his address at the opening of the Troika Plus meeting here on Thursday.

The minister also emphasised that all regional countries have concerns and a shared interest in Afghanistan's peace and stability, reported Geo News.

Stressing that everyone wants terrorist elements that are operating inside Afghanistan to be tackled effectively, Qureshi said that the meeting reflects the common desire to see a "peaceful, stable, unified, sovereign and pros-

perous Afghanistan".

"Located next door, we have borne the brunt of four decades of conflict and instability in the shape of refugees, drugs and terrorism," Qureshi said, adding, "We see the current situation as an opportunity to end the prolonged conflict." The meeting, held at Pakistan's Ministry of Foreign Affairs here, is being chaired by Qureshi and National Security Advisor Moeed Yusuf.

The dialogue is being attended by representatives from the US, Russia, China and a high-level delegation led by the Taliban government's Acting Foreign Minister Amir Khan Muttaqi.

The US special representative to Afghanistan Thomas West and participating officials of the other three countries will meet Muttaqi here.

Last year, the previous meeting in this format was held in Doha, where the US was represented by the former special envoy for Afghanistan Zalmay Khalilzad. This is the first full-fledged meeting of the Troika Plus after the Taliban's takeover of Afghanistan.

## Pashupatinath-Kashi motorcycle rally flagged off in Kathmandu

KATHMANDU: A motorcycle rally from Pashupatinath to Kashi Vishwanath was jointly flagged off on Thursday by Nepal's Minister for Culture, Tourism, and Civil Aviation Prem Bahadur Ale and Ambassador of India Vinay Mohan Kwatra. Nearly 50 Indian and Nepali motorcycle enthusiasts are participating in the rally which is aimed at showcasing the people-to-people connection between India and Nepal and further strengthening mutual cultural relations.

# Aus to start quarantine-free travel with Japan

CANBERRA: Australia's Prime Minister Scott Morrison has flagged travel bubble arrangements with Japan and South Korea as the country gradually reopens to the world.

Morrison recently said that quarantine-free travel between Australia and the two Asian countries would soon resume after a suspension of more than 18 months, reports xinhua news agency.

As of Monday, fully vaccinated Australians are able to travel to Singapore without quarantining.

From November 21, Australia's borders will open the other way, meaning fully vaccinated travellers from Singapore will be able to fly into Canberra, Melbourne and Sydney without undergoing quarantine.

## Lockdown for unvaccinated is likely

Austria's chancellor on Thursday stepped up threats of lockdown measures for unvaccinated people, as new coronavirus cases in the Alpine country are soaring. On Monday, new rules took effect barring unvaccinated people who haven't recovered from an infection from restaurants, hotels, hairdressing salons and large public events. The chancellor insisted that "we can break this wave together."

# PAK REMOVES TLP CHIEF FROM TERROR SUSPECT LIST

ISLAMABAD: Pakistan's Punjab government has removed the name of Tehreek-i-Labbaik Pakistan (TLP) chief Hafiz Saad Hussain Rizvi from the list of proscribed individuals suspected of terrorism, reported local media. The government had already removed the TLP from the list of the proscribed organisations in the country on November 7. "Name of Hafiz Mohammad Saad is hereby deleted from the list of 4th Schedule of Anti-Terrorism Act, 1997 (a list of proscribed individuals who are suspected of terrorism or sectarianism under the Anti-Terrorism Act (ATA), 1997), with immediate effect. Dawn quoted the notification issued by the Punjab Home Department on Wednesday. Notably, the TLP chief was arrested on April 12, 2021, before the protests by the outfit and FIR was registered against Rizvi, according to Dawn. Rizvi's name featured on the Fourth Schedule after four days on April 16. TLP was declared a proscribed outfit in April this year after the violent protest by the group across Pakistan. Weeks ago, the TLP had staged large-scale protests nationwide calling for the release of its chief and removal of the proscribed status from the group.

# S Africa's last apartheid president Klerk dies

FW de Klerk, who shared the Nobel Peace Prize with Nelson Mandela and as South Africa's last apartheid president oversaw the end of the country's white minority rule, has died at the age of 85.

De Klerk died after a battle against cancer at his home in the Fresnaye area of Cape Town, a spokesman for the F.W. de Klerk Foundation confirmed on Thursday.

It was de Klerk who in a speech to South Africa's parliament on Feb. 2, 1990, announced that Mandela would be released from prison after 27 years. The announcement

electrifying a country that for decades had been scorned and sanctioned by much of the world for its brutal system of racial discrimination known as apartheid.
