Haaland leads Manchester City to win
Manchester: Erling Haaland scored his first goals since returning to Manchester City's team after injury to lead the champions to a 2-0 win over Everton in the Premier League here on Saturday. The Norway striker finally broke Everton's obdurate resistance when he latched onto a loose ball in the area and smashed home a fierce right-foot shot in the 71st minute. Haaland added a second in an 85th-minute counterattack by running into substitute Kevin De Bruyne's pass, strutting off Jarrod Branthwaite and slotting home a low finish. It was Haaland's second start - and third appearance - since coming back after nearly two months out with a foot injury. With the double making him the outright top scorer in the league with 16 goals. That's two more than Liverpool's Mohamed Salah.

Nagal sets up title clash against Nardi
Chennai: India's top-ranked tennis player Sumit Nagal overcame the challenge of Dvorc Svorc, the third seed from Czech Republic, in straight sets to move into the final of the Chennai Open here on Saturday. The second-seeded Nagal defeated the 21-year-old Czech player 6-3, 6-4 in a match that lasted nearly two hours to set up a title clash with top seed Luca Nardi of Italy. The 20-year-old Nardi overcame stiff challenge from unseeded Chinese Taipei player Chun-Hsin Tseng 6-4, 4-6, 7-5 (6) in a marathon three-hour encounter. The 25-year-old Nagal was definitely the better player on the day, serving superbly in the first set and earning a whole lot of points on his second serve. In the second set, Nagal converted both the break points he earned even as his opponent committed a string of unforced errors.

Ramkumar gets wild card for B'uru Open
Bangalore: Ramkumar Ramanathan, India's second-highest-ranked player, was on Saturday granted a wild card entry into the singles main draw of the Bangalore Open, starting February 12. Ramkumar, who had won the Chennai ATP Challenger and Chennai ATP Challenger, had lost in the first round of the ongoing Chennai ATP Challenger and the opportunity will give him a chance to do well on home soil. Ramkumar has reached the singles final on the ATP Challenger circuit seven times, winning his lone title in Manama, Bahrain, in November 2021. Interestingly, Ramkumar had won the Chennai ATP Challenger title in Bangalore with compatriot Saketh Myneni, two years back.

Cardoso shines as Betis defeats Cadiz
Madrid: US midfielder Johnny Cardoso turned in a man-of-the-match performance to help Real Betis beat Cadiz 2-0 and move into sixth place in the Spanish league on Friday. Cadiz has gone 20 league games without a win since Sept. 1. Even so, Cadiz was third from bottom in the league. Betis leapfrogged Real Sociedad and Valencia into sixth. Betis was missing its top goal-scorer Isco, but for several weeks with a slight injury, but the absence was barely noticed as the visitor took the lead after five minutes. Cardoso won the ball on the right flank and his cut back was swept home first time by William José. Pablo Fornals made it 2-0 less than a minute into the second half when he curled a superb left-foot strike past the outstretched hand of Jeremias Ledesma.

Metz ends seven-game losing streak
Paris: Metz snapped a seven-game losing streak in drawing at Marseille 1-1 in the French league and will rue not taking advantage of facing 10 men for more than an hour on Friday. A defeat in Marseille would have equalled Metz's worst losing run and his hopes were raised for 30 minutes when Marseille captain Samuel Gigot was sent off for a professional foul. However, Metz could not make its numerical advantage count ultimately.
