

S Korean mobile carriers eyeing more cloud gaming users

Sepul, South Korean telecom operators are targeting wider market penetration of cloud gaming services by expanding availability. Industry officials said amid strong demand from mobile gamers.

The country's three major carriers — SK Telecom, KT Corp. and LG Uplus Corp. — have in recent months opened up their subscription services that stream console games on smartphones to other carrier users and networks, reports Yonhap news agency.

Last week, LG Uplus expanded its 5G cloud gaming service, GeForce NOW's availability to gamers on the 4G LTE network, which has the bulk of the country's mobile users. Through the expansion, GeForce NOW's launched last year with U.S. chipmaker Nvidia Corp. — supports 58 additional devices, compared with only releasing a PC version late last month.

The telecom operator's GeForce NOW offers over 100 games on the cloud, was launched in August this year, and was offered to other carriers in the following month.

"As of this month, GeForce has racked up 100,000 users," a KT spokesperson said. "We plan to further expand the service's availability to internet protocol TVs by the end of this year."

The carrier said it targets 1 million GeForce subscribers by 2022.

Telecom, the country's largest wireless provider, offered its cloud gaming service 5CX Cloud game to other carrier users at launch in September.

The service, released in partnership with Microsoft, allows gamers to stream the U.S. tech giant's Xbox games, such as its popular third-person shooter "Gears 5," on mobile devices.

SK Telecom has also bundled the service with Microsoft's latest generation One and One+ as a high-quality game on the go.

Similar carrier KT has taken rival measures to push its mobile cloud gaming service on its platforms by releasing a PC version late last month.

Activists team up with workers to protest against Amazon

New Delhi, An international group of climate activists have joined hands with warehouse workers in an online campaign called "Make Amazon Pay," demanding that the e-commerce giant reduce carbon footprint and respect worker's right to act for better payments.

The coalition include Aapki Garami in India, All India IT and ITes Employees Union, Amazon Employees for Climate Justice, Progressive International and UNI Global Union, among others.

Launched on Black Friday, the coalition has demanded that Amazon change its policies and warehouses change their laws to improve the workplace by raising workers' rights and intimidation if they spoke out for their rights to a fair wage. "The campaign, which is aimed at making Amazon pay back more to society, plans demonstrations in several countries around the world."

Amazon had earlier said that it is committed to building a sustainable business for its customers and the planet.

In 2019, the company pledged — a commitment to be net zero carbon across its business by 2040, 10 years ahead of the Paris Agreement.

"We encourage anyone interested in the facts to contact our overall pay and benefits, as well as our speed in managing this crisis, to other retailers and major employers across the country," the coalition said.

"The share of all smart speaker sales incorporating a display was 26 per cent in Q3 2020, compared to 22 per cent a year earlier."

In the overall smart speaker market, Amazon retained first place in Q3 with a 28.8 per cent share of global shipments, although its sales fell slightly compared to a year earlier.

Amazon's main rivals all increased sales and market share, with the exception of Xiaomi, which had a disappointing quarter, the report noted.

Amazon, Baido lead as Smart Displays sales hit 9.5mn units in Q3

New Delhi, Move beyond smart speakers as smart displays have come of age and in Q3, the sales of smart display speakers rose by 21 per cent (on-year) to reach 9.5 million units while sales of basic smart speakers (without a display) fell by 3 per cent over the same period.

According to a report by market intelligence and research firm Strategy Analytics, Amazon and Baidu led the market for smart displays.

The best-selling devices in Q3 were the Amazon Echo Show 5 and Baidu Xiaodu Zaijia 1.

Smart speaker users are switching increasingly to display-based devices or Smart Displays and a growing range of smart display apps and services as well as lower device prices are key factors in their success.

"Like many sectors, smart speakers have had a difficult year for well-rehearsed reasons," said David Watkins, Director, Smart Speakers and Screens.

"But the shoots of recovery are beginning to show, and vendor commitment is evident from the many new products and improved technologies now being introduced," he added.

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YouTube for Android TV app now supports 8K video playback

San Francisco, The latest YouTube for Android TV update has reportedly started rolling out limited support for 8K streaming.

According to a report in Android Police, YouTube TV for Android v.2.1208 version includes support for 8K streaming to TVs running Android 10 and above.

The changelog states that the update brings 8K streaming support to a limited number of devices, but it doesn't specify exactly which models are supported right now.

Apart from the limited 8K streaming support, the latest YouTube for Android TV update brings another noteworthy change — Cast Connect support.

Cast Connect will let users control cast media on their Android TV with the TV's remote control instead of controlling it with the device that's casting the media.

Interestingly, YouTube's changelog had initially featured support for AV1 HDR playback, but was later omitted to include the Cast Connect support.

Instead, it includes AV1 HDR playback support, but Google seems to have removed that from the updated changelog, the report said.

FB partners Sony to show exclusive content from India's Oz tour

New Delhi, Facebook on Saturday announced a digital content partnership with Sony Pictures Networks India for the India tour of Australia that will offer exclusive video-on-demand content to cricket fans.

The partnership will offer match content on Facebook Watch for three ODIs, three T20s and four Tests, including match highlights, in-play moments with best batsmen, best wickets, and man of the match, among others.

It will also feature on Sony Sports India's Facebook page, the companies said in a statement.

"We are delighted to work with Sony Pictures Networks India (SPNI) to bring some of the most exciting moments from one of India's most awaited overseas tours to cricket fans on Facebook Watch," said Manish Chopra, Director and Head of Partnerships, Facebook India.

Facebook's video-on-demand platform Watch is being visited by over 1.25 billion people every month, said Manish Aggarwal, Head Growth and Monetisation, Digital Business, Sony Pictures Networks India, said the association will enable them to offer interesting match content to cricket enthusiasts and drive further engagement.

"This collaboration will surely get the fans closer to the game," he added.

Samsung reveals upcoming Exynos 1080 chip for 5G smartphones

New Delhi, Samsung announced the Exynos 1080 SoC two weeks ago at an online event in Shanghai and now, the company has followed up with an official introduction video highlighting the key features of the new chipset that will power 5G smartphones.

The video was published on YouTube showing technical details of the chip that aims to build up the hype for the new chipset.

The new chipset will power the next generation of high-end 5G smartphones from Samsung and possibly other phones from other manufacturers.

Samsung is confident that other companies will adopt its Exynos chipset solution.

The chipset brings HDR10+ and support for screens with up to 144Hz of refresh rate at Full HD+ resolution.

When it comes to the camera department, the device supports camera sensors up to 200MP.

The chipset brings four power-efficient Cortex-A55 cores operating at 2.0GHz.

The SoC supports cutting edge LPDDR5 RAM standard and UFS 3.1 storage. It also is a capable gaming chipset thanks to the use of a Mali-G78 MP10 GPU.

The Exynos 1080 is Samsung's first processor fabricated on a 5nm EUV-based FinFET process.

This brings low power consumption and higher efficiency while reducing the chip size by 25 per cent as compared to the 7nm process.

Apr-Sep FDI inflow at \$30B; Mauritius, Singapore top sources

New Delhi, With India being an attractive destination for foreign funds despite the pandemic, FDI inflow rose 15 per cent during the April-September period to \$30 billion.

During the same period last fiscal, total FDI inflow stood at \$26 billion.

According to data from the Department for Promotion of Industry and Internal Trade (DPIIT), Mauritius and Singapore were the biggest sources of FDI for India with 29 per cent and 21 per cent contribution respectively.

The U.S., Netherlands and Japan followed with 7 per cent contribution each. Among the services sector continued to lead with the highest amount of FDI coming in. The sector which includes financial, banking, insurance, outsourcing, R&D among others, received 17 per cent of the FDI equity inflow during the period under review.

Amnesty asks EU to block Google-Fitbit deal over human rights risks

London, Amnesty International has asked the European Union (EU) competition regulator to block Google's \$2.1 billion acquisition of wearable maker Fitbit citing human rights risks.

The Commission must ensure that the merger does not proceed unless the two business enterprises can demonstrate that they have taken adequate account of the human rights risks and implemented strong and meaningful safeguards that prevent and mitigate these risks in the future, Amnesty said.

For Google the Fitbit acquisition gives it a toe into the now growing wearable market. This also arms the search engine giant with ways that "greaten human rights demonstrators in the field, as well as rich data troves. The deal is being hailed as a landmark in the evolution of Google's Wear OS.

According to Amnesty, Google's business model incentivises the company to continuously seek more data on more people across the online world and into the physical world.

The merger with Fitbit is a clear example of this expansionist approach to data extraction, enabling the company to extend its data collection into the health and wearables sector," the letter read. Notwithstanding that Google has committed to "not use Fitbit health and wellness data for Google ads," the incentive to use Fitbit health data in ways that "greaten human rights demonstrators in the field, as well as rich data troves. The US Justice Department and Australia's Competition and Consumer Commission have also raised their concerns over the Google-Fitbit deal.

According to Amnesty, Google's past practice around privacy further heightens the need for strict safeguards.

"The abuse of privacy and other rights has also helped concentrate power and enable Google's dominance. The accumulation of greater amounts of data enables a company to be better able to train the machine learning models and algorithms which produce behavioural predictions," the NGO emphasised.

SMBs that quickly disclose hacking face 40% less financial loss

New Delhi, The small and medium businesses (SMBs) that decide to voluntarily inform about a data breach, on average are likely to lose 40 per cent less financial damage than their peers that saw the incident leaked to the media, according to a new report.

The financial loss for SMBs that disclose a breach to the public within 72 hours of the time are estimated at \$93,000, while their peers that had an incident leaked to the media suffered a \$155,000 in damage.

The failure to suitably inform the public about a data breach in a timely manner can make the financial and reputational consequences of a data breach more severe, revealed the Kaspersky A report that says SMBs can minimize the cost of a data breach.

The same tendency has also been found to be the case in enterprises.

Those that voluntarily inform their audiences about a breach experienced less financial damage (28 per cent) than those whose incidents were not reported to the press (41 million A \$ 1.3 4 million A compared to \$1.583 million).

"Proactive disclosure can help turn things around in a company's favour A and it goes beyond just the financial impact. If customers know what happened firsthand, they are likely to maintain their trust in the brand," said Yana Shevchenko, Senior Product Marketing Manager at the cyber security firm A Kaspersky.

Some high-profile cases include Yahoo!, who was fined and criticised for not notifying their investors about the data breach it ex-

businesses that managed not to disclose the incident, this approach is far from ideal.

Such companies are at a disadvantage if they are not more likely when a cybersecurity incident is revealed to the public against their intentions," the report mentioned.

The survey further proved that risks are especially high for those comparatively who do not immediately detect an attack.

Nearly 29 per cent of SMBs that took more than a week to identify that they had been breached found the news in the press, which is double those that detected the breach immediately (15 per cent).
