Nagpur BJP Leader Missing in Jabalpur: Suspect

Dark side of gaming: Rs 1.50 crore debt

Nagpur 8 August: Insignificant development regarding the missing Bharatiya Janata Party (BJP) West Nagpur leader Sana Khan in Jabalpur, sources have revealed a major breakthrough to reporters. Police have interrogated a Dhaba worker of Amit Sahu, the prime suspect in the case, who told authorities that Sahu had asked him to wash his car before leaving from Jabalpur. During the cleaning, the worker reportedly discovered blood stains in the car along with some clothes. He also informed the police that Sahu had obtained a SIM Card using his Aadhar Card before fleeing Jabalpur. According to police sources, cops are now convinced that the accused Sahu has killed Khan and disposed of her body, although locating the body will be a challenging task. Anticipating a significant impact on the political circle in Nagpur once Khan's body and phone are found, sources suggest a potential upheaval. It is important to note that Sana Khan, a local Bharatiya Janata Party leader from West Nagpur, went on a business trip to



Jabalpur on August 1 and has been reported missing since. Speculation is rampant that her business partner might be responsible for her potential demise. However, the police have yet to locate Khan's body, preventing any confirmation. Police sources reveal that Khan had a business partner named Amit Sahu in Jabalpur, who is the prime suspect in this case. She departed for Jabalpur on August 1 and has been missing since the following day. Sahu owns a Dhaba in Jabalpur. As a significant amount of time has passed without any communication from Sana to her family, suspicions have arisen, leading to a filed police complaint. Mankapur Police

Inspector Shubhangi Wankhede stated, "We have registered a missing person case based on the complaint. Our team has rushed to Jabalpur; however, Sana remains untraceable at this time. Since we have not come across any evidence of her death, we cannot comment on her current status. Our investigation is ongoing." According to police sources, Sana had visited Sahu's residence in Jabalpur, with locals confirming hearing noises from his place on the morning of August 2. Sahu, who owns a Dhaba, has reportedly gone missing along with his staff from Jabalpur. The police have also visited his native place, but Sahu's whereabouts remain unknown, sources say. Sahu's wife is currently with the Jabalpur Police. However, the latter has stated that they have separated and are in the process of getting a divorce. Police suspect that Sahu may have killed Sana and disposed of her body in a dam or the Narmada River. Authorities have also conducted a search at Barghi Dam, but it yielded no results.

Nagpur 8 August: The investigation by Nagpur Police into Rs 58 crore online gaming fraud case uncovered a link of the gaming fraud to the suicide of a 19-year-old boy hailing from Gondia. The teenager committed suicide last month at his residence in Gondia after losing a staggering Rs 1.50 crore in the online game. According to police, the information of the link between the suicide and online game was shared with Gondia Police. Shockingly, after the suicide case, the accomplices of elusive gaming fraudster Ananth Sontu Navratn Jain had approached the family members of the deceased in Gondia. They reportedly handed-over a sum of Rs 1 crore to the



family members to hide the suicide note, the police said. The investigation further revealed that apart from Gondia suicide case, the gaming fraud had caused suicides of two other persons — one in Odisha and another at Pune. On July 23, during the raid on Sontu's residence, the police had seized Rs 17 crore in cash, 14 kg of gold, and 294 kg of silver with a combined

worth of Rs 27 crore. Later, the police found Rs 85 lakh cash and gold worth over Rs 4.50 crore in the lockers of Sontu Jain. It has been revealed that the accused, Sontu, operated an illegal online gaming platform under the guise of 'Diamond Exchange.com'. The platform allegedly manipulated unsuspecting victims into engaging in various gambling activities, such as Rummi and Teen Patti, leading to significant financial losses to many. The investigation into this fraud case started when a Nagpur-based businessman approached the police, claiming to have been duped of Rs 58 crore by Sontu's gaming platform. He alleged that the results were manipulated, leading to substantial financial losses. When the victim demanded his money back, Sontu not only refused but also issued threats. Under immense financial pressure, the victim had arranged Rs 40 lakh and transferred it to Sontu via a hawala trader.

State Govt will follow CPCB guidelines on PoP idols, HC informed

Nagpur 8 August: In a significant development, the Maharashtra Government has assured the Nagpur bench of the Bombay High Court that it will adhere to the revised guidelines issued by the Central Pollution Control Board (CPCB) concerning idol immersion. These revised guidelines, dated May 12, 2022, are applicable to urban local bodies, Collectors, and Zilla Parishads, encompassing a broad spectrum of administrative bodies. The announcement was made during a hearing presided over by a division bench comprising Justice Atul Chandurkar and Justice Vrushali Joshi. The hearing pertained to a suo motu Public Interest Litigation (PIL) filed in



response to concerns about the sale of Plaster of Paris (PoP) idols, despite a ban imposed by the Nagpur Municipal Corporation (NMC). The court proceedings saw a pivotal moment last year on July 13, when the High Court directed the government to formulate a new policy that promotes environmentally safe methods for the creation and immersion of idols, including tazia. This directive underscored the court's commitment to safeguarding the environment and encouraging sustainable practices. The government's stance was clarified during an Assembly session, where it conveyed that while it hadn't prohibited the creation of PoP idols, it had

restricted their immersion in natural water bodies as a means to protect aquatic ecosystems. During the course of the hearing, amicus curiae Shreerang Bhandarkar and Sejal Lakhani raised an important aspect, highlighting that the revised CPCB guidelines primarily addressed PoP idols. However, they advocated for a broader consideration that encompasses idols crafted from other earthen materials. This plea was grounded in the understanding that the paints and materials used in idol-making can potentially pose harm to water bodies and the overall environment. Earlier, an affidavit by Deputy Secretary of State Environment and Climate Change Department, Chandrakant Vibhute, informed that the government had constituted two administrative and technical committees — one for formulating guidelines with its orders. "These committees have conducted several meetings and framed the draft policy. The recent meeting was conducted under Chief Minister Eknath Shinde on May 17 which was attended by the senior officials from various state departments. They were joined online by Collectors, Zilla Parishad Chief Executive Officers (CEOs), representatives of Ganesh Mandals, idol makers associations and others," he said. Vibhute said that it was deliberated that the household Ganesh Idols should be eco-friendly and proper implementation be done in this regard. The CM had directed the authorities to take effective steps for

Scamster dupes senior citizen of Rs 3 lakh

Nagpur 8 August: Ajai Vasantrao Vaidya, a 60-year-old resident of Silver State Apartment, Manish Nagar, fell victim to an online scam. According to police, Vaidya lodged a complaint with NMC about the garbage truck not removing waste and tree branches from the apartment's garden on Friday. While searching

for assistance on-line, he came across an unknown mobile number. The person behind this number posed as a representative of NMC and advised Vaidya to download the 'Rust Desk' app to file the complaint officially. Trusting the impostor's instructions, Vaidya downloaded the app, only to discover later that Rs 2.98 lakh had been fraudulently withdrawn from his bank account. The matter was reported to the police, and a case has been registered against the accused under Sections 419, 420, 465, 468, 469, 471 and 34 of the Indian Penal Code (IPC) along with Section 66(c) and 66(d) of the IT Act. An investigation into the incident is currently underway.
