Parliament nod to amend SC, ST lists in AP, Odisha



New Delhi: Parliament gave its nod to two bills which seek to modify the list of Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes in Andhra Pradesh and Odisha, with Lok Sabha on Thursday passing it with voice vote. The first Bill seeks to modify the list of Scheduled Tribes in Andhra Pradesh while the second one seeks to modify the list of Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes in Odisha.

Karnataka: Foxconn invites bids to construct plant

New Delhi: Foxconn has invited bids to construct a plant in Karnataka with an outlay of ₹7,200 crore, according to sources. The project will be awarded through Foxconn Hon Hai Technology India Mega Development. The Karnataka government had approved an investment proposal of around ₹22,000 crore from Foxconn. "Foxconn's recent bid for plant construction is for an iPhone factory which it is setting up in Karnataka," a source said.

Congress 'Black Paper' says Modi govt 'devastated' economy

Countering the Union government's 'White Paper', the Congress on Thursday released a critique on Prime Minister Narendra Modi's decade-long rule, titled 'Black Paper' that asserted that the present regime has "devastated the country's economy, aggravated unemployment", and "destroyed the agricultural sector".

The Congress also alleged that the NDA regime "abetted crimes against women and committed grave injustice against minorities in the country".

BLACK TILAK

Responding to the Congress accusation that his tenure has been a period of injustice, Prime Minister Narendra Modi said, "I thank Khargeji for this. The black tilak will ward off the evil as the country is very happy with the unprecedented growth in the last 10 years. The past ten years have seen India ascend to new heights, with the country experiencing a period of unprecedented prosperity".

The Congress said the

NDA regime has given the highest unemployment rate in 45 years.

The total unemployment was 1 crore in 2012 but rose to about 4 crore in 2022 even though Modi promised 2 crore jobs annually, it said.

STAGNANT WAGES

Ten lakh sanctioned Central government posts remain unfulfilled and the unemployment rate for graduates is about 33 per cent — one in three are looking unsuccessfully for a job — the Congress stated in its document.

It also said that India's workers have experienced a lost decade, with stagnant real wages.

Wages growth has been less than 1 per cent per year for all rural workers and salaried workers now earn less, was the observation of the Congress.

The Opposition party stated the prices of essential commodities are at all-time highs. It said that the prices of commodities, if compared before and after 2014, rose by 120 per cent in the case of LPG, 71 per cent in milk, 37 per cent in petrol, 64 per cent in diesel,

59 per cent in mustard oil and 59 per cent in atta.

AGRICULTURE SECTOR

The Black Paper said farmers were promised a doubling of their income but instead they received pathetic MSP increases and the three farm laws were rail-road through the Parliament to enrich the FM's corporate cronies. While 700 farmers died protesting against the black laws, insurance companies under the PM Fasal Bima Yojna have made a profit of ₹90,000 crore, the Congress alleged.

'Centre's Union over States mentality crippling democracy'

After Karnataka, Kerala and the AAP governments of Delhi and Punjab also hit the streets on Thursday to "protect federalism" and to protest against the Modi government's "neglect" of Opposition-led States and its encroachment of their domain.

Kerala Chief Minister Pinarayi Vijayan, who led the Left Democratic Front's (LDF's) protest at Jantar Mantar, said democracy was being "crippled" by the Centre's undemocratic "Union over States" mentality. According to him, the Union's supremacy over the States is not only reflected in financial matters, but was also evident in the functioning of Governors in Opposition-led States.

"TELLING EXAMPLE" Citing another "telling example", the Kerala CM also stated that the Centre was making laws that impinge on States' powers and duties in different spheres like law and order that are "absolutely in the States' list in the Constitution".

Present during the protest were Delhi Chief

Jammu and Kashmir National Conference Chief Farooq Abdullah and Tamil Nadu's Minister of Information Technology and Digital Services Palanivel Thiagarajan also lent their support to the protest which the Prime Minister Narendra Modi described on Wednesday as an attempt to create a North-South divide within the country.

Govt suspends free movement between India and Myanmar

The Ministry of Home Affairs (MHA) on Thursday said it would scrap the Free Movement Regime (FMR) between India and Myanmar, keeping in mind the country's internal security and to maintain the demographic structure of the north-eastern States bordering Myanmar.

The decision comes amid the exodus of Myanmar army personnel and its people to the north-eastern States through the porous border owing to fighting between rebel

forces and the military junta in the neighbouring country. Indian Army Chief General Manoj Pandey had said early last month that more than 400 Myanmar Army personnel had sneaked into the country through the border in the last two months.

"WILL SECURE BORDER" Home Minister Amit Shah in a post on X said his ministry took the decision "to be sure and secure our borders". "Since the Ministry of External Affairs is currently in the process of scrapping it, MHA has re-

commended the immediate suspension of the FMR," Shah stated.

The Home Minister had earlier said the entire 1,643-km-long India-Myanmar border, stretching

through Mizoram, Manipur, Nagaland and Arunachal Pradesh, would be fenced, restricting free movement in the identified geographical areas of the two countries.

As per the FMR introduced in 2018 to facilitate India's Act East policy, people residing close to the India-Myanmar border were allowed to venture 16 km into each other's territory without documents.

SITUATION IN RAKHINE Meanwhile, India on Thursday said the security situation in Myanmar's Rakhine state is "worrisome" and indicated its concerns over possible impact on the Indian con-

cerns over possible impact on the Indian consulate in Sittwe.

On Tuesday, India had asked all its citizens in the Rakhine state to leave the troubled-region immediately in view of the deteriorating security situation.

"The security situation in the Rakhine state is worrisome. We issued an advisory for our citizens to leave Rakhine and told those planning to travel not to go there," External Affairs Ministry Spokesperson Randeep Jaiswal said at his weekly media briefing.

Ayodhya Airport handles over 42,000 passengers in first 30 days

February 5 was the busiest day at the airport as it handled 3,151 passengers

The Ayodhya Airport has handled over 42,000 passengers in the first thirty days after the launch of commercial flights on January 6. Prime Minister Narendra Modi had inaugurated the airport on December 30. Regular service began a week later with IndiGo's Delhi-Ayodhya flight. Now the airport handles 11-12 departures daily connecting the temple town to Ahmedabad, Bengaluru, Chennai, Delhi, Mumbai, and other destinations.

According to provisional data shared by the Airport Authority of India, the airport handled 42,341 passengers between January 6 and February 6. This included 22,546 passenger arrivals and 19,795 departures. This does not include data on non-scheduled

flights, the maximum of which were seen on January 21 and 22, ahead of the consecration of Ram Mandir. February 5 was the busiest day at Ayodhya airport when it handled 3,151 passengers — the most in the first thirty days.

Panel raises flag over funding cut at Tourism Ministry at RE stage

Parliamentary Standing Committee on Tourism has raised concerns about a persistent reduction in allocations at the Revised Estimates (R.E.) stage since 2019. The Committee attributed this trend to perceived inefficiencies within the Ministry's operational framework. The Committee, chaired by V Vijayaram Reddy, has said that there is an imperative need for the Ministry of Tourism to re-evaluate its planning, organising, and implementing strategy.

The Committee voiced its apprehensions about the reduction in allocations, stat-

ing, "The Committee observes that in every year from 2019 onwards, the allocation under the Scheme has been reduced by about 50 per cent at the Revised Estimates stage." It urged the Ministry of Tourism for a comprehensive re-examination of the Ministry's strategies to eliminate bottlenecks and enhance efficiency at all levels.
