# 3 MLAs Beaten Up by Meitei Group During Imphal Meet

**Guwahati:** Three MLAs, two from the ruling BJP and one from the Congress, were beaten up and compelled to take an oath by radical armed Meitei group Arambai Tenggol at Kangla Fort in Imphal on Wednesday. The incident happened at an ethnic meeting of legislators called by the extremists. How an ethnic meeting was allowed by the Biren Singh government after the state has experienced ethnic violence since last May had not been questioned so far.



COMPELLED TO TAKE OATH

Singh and Rajya Sabha MP Leishemba Sanajaoba also attended the meeting. The group convened the meeting after the prolonged violence in the past 9 months between Meiteis and Kukis. Thousands of youths, donned distinctive combat uniforms, rallied alongside women's groups, students and citizens echoing chants for Manipur's unity and resilience against disintegration. "We cannot claim victory or success today. The ten Kuki lawmakers stand united, but regrettably, our Meitei lawmakers are not. Many valley lawmakers have yet to address the issues since the war erupted in May. Today, in Kangla, we called upon them to unite," chief of the group Koroungamba Khuman said.

# No Stone-pelting, Civilian Death in J&K in 2023: Shah

Says some state parties made democracy hostage of their families

**Srinagar:** Union Home Minister Amit Shah on Thursday said that Jammu and Kashmir has changed since Article 370 was abrogated. He said the number of killings by militants has dropped by 70% and that there were no civilian deaths or planned protests in 2023.

Reiterating that J&K is seeing a new dawn of peace, prosperity, and progress, Shah e-inaugurated the e-bus service for Jammu with 100 buses in the fleet. He was virtually addressing a gathering in Jammu from New Delhi.

"J&K is undergoing a transformation. In place of terrorism, bombings, bullets, stone-throwing, and hartals, we are currently seeing the rise of medical and management schools and infrastructure growth. This shift needs to be facilitated by the people here, Shah added.

The minister made light of the regional political parties by saying that they had taken democracy hostage for their families and by spreading the myth that Article 370's abrogation would not actually bring about any changes in the real world.

"We are witnessing a new age of peace, happiness and security in J&K under the leadership of Narendra Modi. Terrorism related incidents have decreased by 70 percent. Civilian deaths have decreased by 81 percent and there was no organised stone-pelting, organised hartal and no civilian killings in stone pelting in 2023," said Shah. The minister said that the government is attaching properties of alleged militants and militant sympathisers and have banned some groups here as well.

He said that the J&K had recorded Rs 297 crore investment in 2019 which



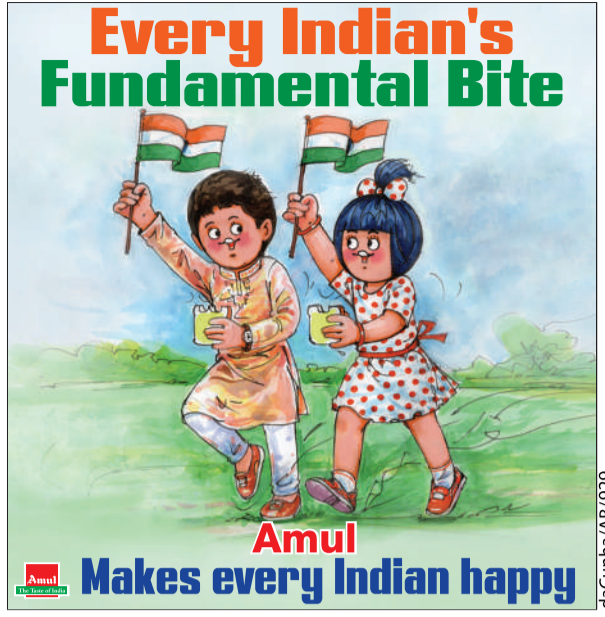
34,440 VACANCIES FILLED

has increased to Rs 2153 crore in 2022-23 with Rs 6000 crore investment in pipeline.

The minister informed that 34,440 vacancies were fulfilled since abrogation of Article 370 and 35 (A), with no opportunity or space for corruption. "Earlier jobs were given through parchi (sifarish) instead of merit, but today there is no room for corruption," said Shah. The union minister urged youngsters to enrol in the voter list and become part of democratic process and participate in strengthening the democratic republic of India. "Youth have left stones and taken computers in their hands to be part of the story of development of the country," said Shah.

Sharp Dip in Trafficking of Drugs: ICG

**Mumbai:** The number of drug trafficking cases in the Indian waters dropped sharply in 2023, a year after nine such cases were recorded, a Coast Guard official said as he credited enhanced surveillance and seamless coordination among security agencies for the decline. Bisham Sharma, IG and Commander Coast Region (West), said the Indian Coast Guard has also deployed more ships on the fringes of the EEZ. -PTI

80 Gallantry Awards Approved

New Delhi: President Droupadi Murmu approved gallantry awards to 80 armed forces personnel, including 12 posthumous, on the eve of 75th Republic Day. More than 1,110 police personnel have also been

awarded with different categories of gallantry and service medals.

These include six Kirti Chakras, including three posthumous, 16 Shaurya Chakras, including two posthumous, 53 Sena Medals, including seven posthumous, one Nao Sena Medal (Gallantry) and four Vayu Sena Medals (Gallantry).

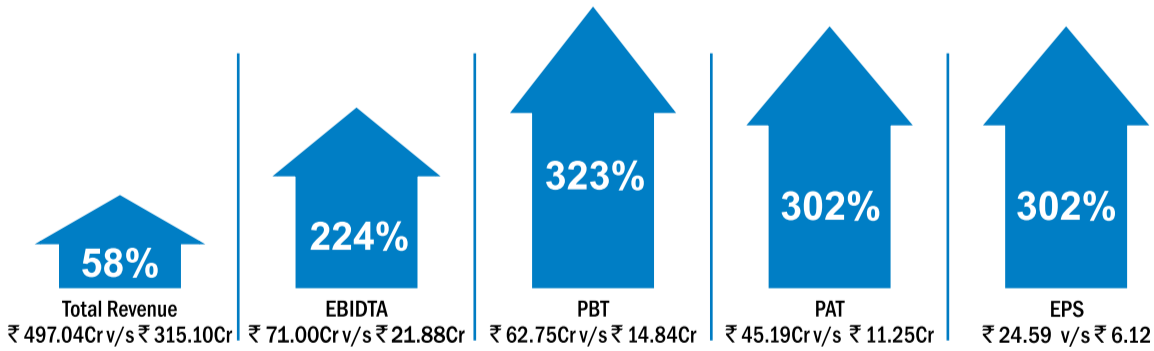
