Armyman among two killed in twin stray bull attacks in UP

Amroha/Pilibhit: A 28-year-old Indian Army soldier was killed while his wife and two children were injured after a stray bull hit their two-wheeler on Hasanpur Atrasi road near Bavankhedhi village in Amroha district on Monday. In another such incident in Pilibhit, a 24-year-old man, identified as Banti Lodhi, was attacked by a stray bull on the outskirts of the city when he was on his way home on Sunday, report **Harveer Singh & Keshav Agarwal**.

The soldier, Ankit Kumar, was posted at 507 ASC Battalion in Punjab's Ferozepur. Police said Kumar died on the spot as the bull's horn pierced his stomach, while his wife, Sonam (25), and their two children suffered minor injuries.

Hasanpur police station SHO Sushel Verma said, "We will catch the bull and send it to a cow shelter. Kumar belonged to a farmer family." Amroha district magistrate BK Tripathi said, "The matter has come to my attention. I have instructed the Hasanpur SDM to take serious note of the incident."

Meanwhile, Banti Lodhi was on his bike around 10 pm when a stray bull hit him and he fell on the road. As he fell, the bull kept attacking him. Locals rushed him to the district hospital where doctors declared him dead. Sungarhi police station SHO Jagat Singh said, "We have informed the family of the deceased about the accident. The body has been sent for autopsy."

Toxic gas in septic tank at home kills man, son & 2 others

TIMES VIEW: Both septic tanks and sewers are killer traps. The toxic gases trapped inside them can claim lives in seconds. In 2014, the Supreme Court prohibited working in them. Stepping into them is permitted only in case of emergency after putting on adequate safety gear, as per central government rules. It is time that authorities carry out a vigorous nation-wide awareness drive against the perils of entering septic tanks and sewers and also take deterrent action where the rules are found to be violated.

Lucknow: Four persons, including a 48-year-old construction worker and his 25-year-old son, who was to get married on June 10, died after inhaling toxic gases inside a septic tank in Uttar Pradesh's Kushinagar district on Sunday evening.

According to Nibua Naurangiy police station SHO Atul Srivastava, Nand Lal Kushwaha of Bahora Rammagar village entered the septic tank of his house to clean it and fell unconscious because of toxic gases. "Nand Lal entered the overflowing septic tank and used a bucket to scoop out sewage. He passed out soon afterwards. His son Nitesh called out for him many times and on getting no response, entered the septic tank himself," the SHO said, based on the villagers' accounts.

After Nitesh, too, did not come out, his grandfather Ram Bali called neighbours and relatives for help. Three others — Anand Kushwaha (26), Dinesh Kushwaha (38), Raj Kumar (28) — entered the tank to help Nand Lal and Nitesh, but they too, were knocked unconscious.

A tank-cleaning machine was then called and police were informed. The five persons were pulled out and rushed to a community health centre, where doctors declared the father-son duo and their neighbours, Anand and Dinesh, dead on arrival. Raj Kumar was referred to the district hospital. DM Ramesh Ranjan announced a relief of Rs 4 lakh each to the kin of the deceased. Ram Bali, who lost his son and grandson, said Nitesh was the only educated person in the family and was a B Pharma graduate.

- The above Standalone/ Consolidated financial results have been reviewed and recommended by the Audit Committee and approved by the Board of Directors in their meeting held on **29th May, 2023**.
- The financial results have been audited by as required under Regulation 33 of the Securities and Exchange Board of India (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015, (as amended).
- The Standalone/Consolidated financial results have been prepared in accordance with the Indian Accounting Standards (Ind AS) as notified under Section 133 of the Companies Act, 2013 read with Rule 3 of the Companies (Indian Accounting Standard) Rules, 2015 and Companies (Indian Accounting Standards) amendment Rules, 2016 and other recognized accounting practices and policies to the extent applicable. The consolidated financial results also include the financial information in respect of 1 (One) subsidiary and 11 (Eleven) joint venture which have not been audited by their auditors.
- The Company /Group operates in a single reportable operating Segment 'Development of Rail Infrastructure', hence there are no separate operating segments as per Ind AS 108-Operating Segments.
- Section 115BAA has been inserted in the Income Tax Act, 1961 vide Taxation laws (Amendment) Act, 2019, which enables domestic companies to exercise a non-reversible option to pay corporate tax at reduced rates effective 1st April, 2019 subject to certain conditions. The company has not exercised this option yet.
- The Board of Directors has recommended the final dividend of Rs. 0.36 per equity share having face value of Rs. 10 each for the financial year 2022-23, subject to the approval of the shareholders at the ensuing Annual General Meeting. This is in addition to the interim dividend of Rs. 1.77 per equity share paid during the Financial Year 2022-23.

Balances of some of the Trade receivables, other assets, Trade and other payables accounts are subject to confirmations/reconciliations and consequential adjustment, if any. Reconciliations are carried out on an on-going basis. Provisions, wherever considered necessary, have been made. However, management does not expect to have any material financial impact of such pending confirmations/reconciliations.

In respect of Krishnapatnam Railway Company Limited (KRCL), RVNL is entitled for departmental charges @ 5% of the total cost of work as per the detailed estimate/revision estimate/completion estimate as provided in paragraph 1137 of the Code for Engineering Department of Indian Railways. RVNL has received representation from KRCL for waiver of the aforesaid departmental charges apart from other relaxations from contractual obligations. Based on the representation made by KRCL, the management of the Company has decided to keep in abeyance the claim of the said departmental charges pending detailed review of the subject matter by the Board of Directors of the Company.

Figures of last quarter are balancing figures between audited figures in respect of the whole financial year and the published year to date unaudited figures up to the 3rd quarter of the relevant Financial Year.

The audited accounts are subject to review by the Comptroller and Auditor General of India under section 143(6) of the Companies Act, 2013.

Wherever necessary figures for the previous periods/year have been regrouped, reclassified/recasted to conform to the classification of the current period/year.
