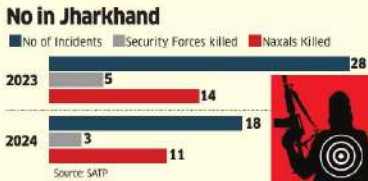

# Woman Commander Among 2 Maoists Killed

Arms and ammunition seized; deceased woman identified as wife of arrested Maoist leader



New Delhi: Two Maoists, including a woman commander, were killed during an encounter with security forces in Upperghat area of Bermo sub-division, Bokaro district in Jharkhand on Wednesday, police officials said, adding that there were also injured in the incident.

According to officials, the clash took place in the dense forests of Hamsahani Jarwa, under the Maoist-affected Pank Naxayugan police station jurisdiction. The woman, identified as Shanti (55), was the area commander and a member of banned CPI (Maoist), they added. The woman's husband and top Maoist leader Ranvijay Mahto (50), who carried a bounty of ₹15 lakh on his head, was arrested a day earlier in Chandrapura, officials further said, adding that the operation is still going on to arrest the remaining Maoists.

INTELLIGENCE RECEIVED

Arrest of top Maoist leader Ranvijay Mahto led to the encounter in Banshi and Jarwa in Jharkhand

received intel about a six-member armed Maoist group hiding in the forests of Jarwa and Banshi. As the search teams closed in on the hideout, the Maoists opened fire, prompting an intense exchange of gunfire. In the ensuing battle, a male and a female Maoist were killed, while two policemen sustained injuries, Singh added.

Chabassa Sarakela-Khunti tri-junction had been freed from Maoists in Jharkhand, and they have been confined to a small area.

In Jharkhand, 11 Maoists were killed in 2024 while 10 of them were killed by security forces in 2023, according to official data. Meanwhile, the number of bodies recovered from the encounter in Chhattisgarh on Tuesday rose to 27 from 13. They consist of both male and female Maoists, including top commander Joiram alias Chalpati, a central committee member of the CPI (Maoist). He carried a reward of ₹1 crore and was allegedly involved in several cases of encounter and arson, police added.

New Delhi: Prime Minister Narendra Modi slammed the Aam Aadmi Party-led Delhi government on Wednesday for engaging in rampant corruption, leading to a situation where liquor is more readily available than drinking water even as the ex-chief minister Arvind Kejriwal splurged money on his 'Sheeshmahal (QM official residence)'. There has been a deterioration in the health services here in the last decade and the people have decided to vote out AAP in the Assembly polls, he claimed.

Referring to the last BJP government in Delhi that existed till 1968, Modi said those born in the last 25 years or those in the age group of 35-40 have only witnessed a fall in the living conditions in Delhi. Only after Delhi is freed from AAP rule will the pledge of making it a 'developed capital of a developed nation' be achieved, he emphasized.

Mumbai: At least 12 people were killed and over a dozen injured after passengers aboard Pushpak Express, fearing a potential fire, jumped off the train and were run over by Benguluru Express. The accident happened in Maharashtra's Jalgaon district at around 1:15 pm on Wednesday, officials said.

"The tragic incident of the loss of lives in a very unfortunate incident near Pachera in Jalgaon district is deeply distressing. I pay my heartfelt tributes to them," he posted on X.

New Delhi: Senior Congress leader Ajay Maken on Wednesday alleged a '₹382 crore scam' by the Aam Aadmi Party (AAP) government in Delhi in the health sector, targeting the Arvind Kejriwal-led party through a hitherto undisclosed Comptroller and Auditor General (CAG) report.

Quoting a CAG report, Maken said that only three new hospitals were built in the last 10 years by the AAP regime.

# SC Delivers Split Verdict on Tahir Hussain's Bail Plea

New Delhi: A division bench of the Supreme Court Wednesday delivered a split verdict on a plea filed by former Aam Aadmi Party (AAP) councillor Tahir Hussain seeking interim bail to campaign for upcoming Delhi assembly polls.



The bench, comprising Justices Pankaj Mishra and Alismammad Amanullah, passed the split verdict. While Justice Mishra rejected Hussain's plea, Justice Amanullah held that Hussain should be granted interim bail.

As conditions for interim bail, Justice Amanullah added that Hussain would be under a strict obligation not to speak on the Delhi riots cases while campaigning. "He (Hussain) would also promptly surrender before the authorities after the expiry of the term granted," the judge ruled.

Recalling that Kejriwal and the AAP regime used to claim that they would complete works ahead of scheduled save funds allocated to projects and eradicate corruption, he claimed that the AAP regime had done just the opposite in the health projects of the Delhi government.

55 L students failed Class 10, 12 Boards last yr; several dropped out as per govt assessments

New Delhi: Even as schools across the country gear up for Class 10 and 12 Board exams, the Education Ministry is rushing for another major challenge: arresting dropout of those who may not pass the Board exam.

open school option. NIOS claims not more than 13 lakh students enrolled in senior secondary and secondary levels against a 55 lakh board exam failure number in 2024, showing upturn for gaps in the system.

The challenge is significant, given the numbers. In 2023, the number was as high as 65 lakh. Even the last board exam cycle of 2024 saw over 55 lakh Class 10 and 12 students fail their Board exams. A huge number from this segment simply dropped out of the schooling system, internal govt assessments indicate.
