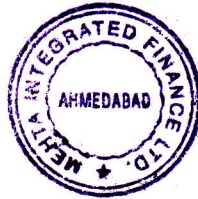

Bees immensely contribute to the agricultural system

Ahmedabad, in order to raise awareness of the importance of pollinators, the threats they face and their contribution to sustainable development, the UN designated 20 May as World Bee Day. World Bee Day was proposed by Slovenia in April 2015 when the Slovenian Beekeepers' Association presented the initiative to the United Nations about celebrating the day on May 20. Slovenia is one of the few countries in the world with the highest number of beekeepers and the only country that has adopted legal measures aimed at protecting bees.

With an expected, rapid increase in human population in the next decade, there will be a greater demand for food rich in the micronutrients, vitamins, and minerals required for a balanced diet. The main purpose of the events is to spread awareness of the significance of bees and other pollinators for our survival. Over the past 50 years, the amount of crops that depend on pollinators (i.e.



fruit, vegetables, seeds, nuts and oilseeds) has tripled. Bees play an important role in relation to the scope of agricultural production. Effective pollination increases the amount of agricultural produce, improves their quality and enhances plants' resistance to pests. Furthermore, agricultural plants that require pollination are an important source of jobs and income for farmers, especially small farmers and family-owned farms in developing countries.

Bees immensely contribute to the agricultural system, which is a major source of employment and income for farmers, particularly in developing countries. Moreover, they help these households in poverty reduction and hunger alleviation contributing towards the achievement of the global vision 2030. The bees are wonderful builders. A bee-hive is a good piece of architecture. It has a large number of cells in it. Some of the cells are used for storing up honey. Other cells are used as bed-rooms and sitting rooms. Long passages connected to the cells are used for carrying pollen dust that comes out and going in is quite easy. Bee-hives are general made on the branches of trees. But sometimes they are also made the walls and window tops of the house.

There are around 20,000 different species of bees around the world and every single species of bees live in colonies where there are three types of bees viz. the queen, the worker and the drone. However a lot of scientists and beekeeper have notices that the population of bees in the world started declining. Many people earn their living by rearing bees and selling honey and tapers. Honey is delicious, sweet and nourishing food. Bees promote the growth of flowers by carrying pollen dust from flowers. Bees are a lesson to us. The world would smile with health and plenty if all men are as industrious as the bees.

Scientists have developed several theories why the bee population is declining. The cell phone theory was the first to be tested. Scientists placed a ringing cell phone near the hives of hundreds of bees. They hypothesized that the radiation from the cell phones was disturbing the bees' sense of direction, but the results were not conclusive. In America, many bees are disappearing far from mobile phone signals.

We must realise that simply proclaiming World Bee Day does not do much for bees and other pollinators; the main work aiming towards their preservation still needs to be undertaken and World Bee Day is an excellent opportunity in this regard. JK Lakshmi Cement Posted Net Profit up at Rs 161.26 Cr. in Jan-Mar.22

Ahmedabad, JK Lakshmi Cement Ltd., one of the leading cement companies of India, recorded a turnover of Rs.1497.64 crore in Jan-Mar.22 with an increase of 13% over Rs.1321.99 crore in the corresponding quarter Jan-Mar.21. Despite unabated increase in Petcoke and Diesel prices which are hovering at all time high, JK Lakshmi Cement could achieve healthy profitability by continuous improvement in operational efficiencies, energy cost, better product mix and higher volumes. 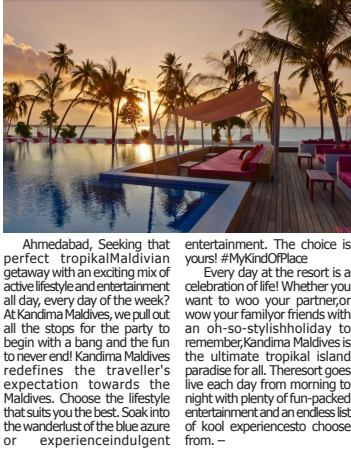
Gujarat reports 33 Covid cases

AHMEDABAD: Gujarat reported 33 Covid-19 cases on Monday, which took its tally to 12,24,574, while the death toll remained unchanged at 10,944, an official said. With 25 patients getting discharged, the number of recoveries rose to 12,13,588, leaving the state with an active caseload of 222, he said. Ahmedabad reported 26 cases, Gandhinagar and Vadodra three cases each, and Surat one case, he added. With 24,086 people getting vaccinated against Covid-19 during the day, the number of doses administered so far in the state went up to 10,84,37,000. There is no active case in the Union Territory of Dadra and Nagar Haveli, Daman and Diu, local officials said.

Gujarat: Unqualified school teachers under scanner

AHMEDABAD: The state education department has asked the offices of all district education officers (DEOs) to prepare a list of teachers in private primary schools who are not qualified for the job. The department has issued a notification to the DEOs' offices following an unstarred question asked by Congress MP Manoj Kumar Jais in the state assembly. He has asked how many unqualified teachers have been removed from their jobs at private primary schools over the past three years and how many are yet to be removed. The notification asks the DEOs to provide the status of such teachers as on October 31, 2021. Under the Right To Education Act of 2009, private primary schools cannot employ a teacher who is not qualified and who has not undergone teachers' training courses such as BEd or PTC.

Lack of adherence to treatment significant contributors to the increasing Asthma burden

Ahmedabad: The Global Burden of Disease (GBD) study has estimated that India is home to over 30 million asthmatics, accounting for 13.09% of the global burden. However, when it comes to mortality, India accounts for over 42% of all global asthma deaths. Despite being a leading cause of morbidity and mortality, the disease continues to be undiagnosed and untreated for years. Population-based studies done globally, have estimated that 20% to 70% of patients with asthma remain undiagnosed and hence untreated.

Citing the GAN study, Dr. Mukesh Pate, MD Chest - Sparsh Hospital said stressed on the importance of addressing the social stigma towards asthma. "When an asthmatic patient consults a doctor, only 71% of doctors give the diagnosis of 'Asthma' as the name of their disease while close to a third (29%) use other terminology. Also, at the patient level, only 23% asthmatic patients call their disease as asthma. Social stigma associated with asthma and use of inhalers is prevalent. Further, patients barely adhere to medication and mostly take symptom driven treatment. Awareness, Acceptance and Adherence need to be aligned to win against asthma." (19-10)
