

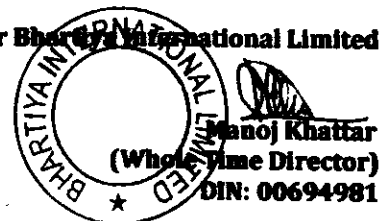

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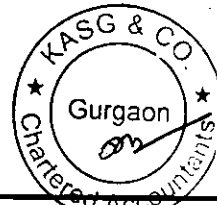

1. We have reviewed the accompanying consolidated unaudited financial results ('the Statement') of M/s Bhartiya International Ltd. ('the Parent') and its subsidiaries (the Parent and its subsidiaries together referred to as "the Group") and its associates for the quarter ended 31<sup>st</sup> December 2020 and consolidated year to date results for the period 1<sup>st</sup> April 2020 to 31<sup>st</sup> December 2020 ('the Statement'), being submitted by the Parent pursuant to the requirement of Regulation 33 of SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015 (as amended), including relevant circulars issued by the SEBI from time to time.
2. This statement, which is the responsibility of the Parent's management and approved by the Parent's Board of Directors, has been prepared in accordance with recognition and measurement principles laid down in Indian Accounting Standard 34, Interim Financial Reporting (Ind AS 34), specified under section 133 of the Companies Act, 2013 and other accounting principles generally accepted in India. Our responsibility is to express a conclusion on the statement based on our review.
3. We conducted our review of the statement in accordance with the Standard on Review Engagements (SRE) 2410 'Review of Interim Financial Information Performed by the Independent Auditor of the Entity' issued by the Institute of Chartered Accountants of India. A review of interim financial information consists of making inquiries, primarily of persons responsible for financial and accounting matters, and applying analytical and other review procedures. A review is substantially less in scope than an audit conducted in accordance with Standards on Auditing and consequently does not enable us to obtain assurance that we would become aware of all significant matters that might be identified in an audit. Accordingly, we do not express an audit opinion.

We also performed procedures in accordance with the circular issued by the SEBI under Regulation 33 (8) of the SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015, as amended, to the extent applicable.



Based on our review conducted and procedures performed as stated in paragraph 3 above and based on the consideration of the review reports of the other auditors referred to in paragraph 6 below nothing has come to our attention that causes us to believe that the accompanying statement prepared in accordance with the recognition and measurement principles laid down in applicable Indian Accounting Standard ('Ind AS') specified under Section 133 of the Companies Act, 2013 as amended, read with relevant rules issued thereunder and other recognized accounting practices and policies has not disclosed the information required to be disclosed in terms of Regulation, read with the circular, including the manner in which it is to be disclosed, or that it contains any material misstatement.
6. We did not review the interim financial results of 9 subsidiaries, included in the consolidated unaudited financial results, whose interim financial results reflect total revenues of Rs. 4749.93 lacs & Rs. 14767.24 lacs and total net profit/(loss) after tax of Rs 289.26 lacs & 404.39 lacs and total comprehensive loss of Rs. 0.16 lacs & 0.48 lacs for the quarter & nine month period ended December 31, 2020, as considered in the consolidated unaudited financial results. The consolidated unaudited financial results also includes the Group's share of net loss after tax and total comprehensive income of Rs. 344.99 lacs & 1832.78 lacs for the quarter and for the nine month period ended December 31, 2020 respectively as considered in the consolidated unaudited financial results, in respect of 2 associates whose interim financial results have not been reviewed by us. These interim financial results have been reviewed by other auditors, whose reports have been furnished to us by the Management and our conclusion on the Statement, in so far as it relates to the amounts and disclosures included in respect of these entities is based solely on the reports of the other auditors and the procedures performed by us as stated in paragraph 3 above.
7. Certain of these subsidiaries are located outside India whose financial results and other financial information have been prepared in accordance with accounting principles generally accepted in their respective countries and which have been reviewed by other auditors under generally accepted auditing standards applicable in their respective countries. The Holding Company's management has converted these financial results of such subsidiaries located outside India from accounting principles generally accepted in their respective countries to accounting principles generally accepted in India. We have reviewed these conversion adjustments made by the holding company's management. Our conclusion in so far as it relates to the balances and affairs of such subsidiaries located outside India is based on the report of the other auditors and conversation adjustments prepared by the management of holding company and reviewed by us.

Our conclusion on the statement in respect of matters stated in para 6 & 7 above is not modified with respect to our reliance on the work done and the reports of the other auditors.
