**NABHA POWER BAGS PRESTIGIOUS BRITISH SAFETY COUNCIL AWARDS FOR SAFETY**

Nabha Power Limited (NPL), which operates 2x700MW supercritical Rajnagar Thermal Power Plant, has achieved a major milestone by bagging the prestigious Distinction Award from the British Safety Council. (The entire power generated from this plant is contracted with Punjab State Power Corporation Limited (PSPCL) for a period of 25 years under a Power Purchase Agreement (PPA). The award was received by Mr. R. S. Lall, Plant head of Nabha Power, during the British Safety Council International Safety Awards Ceremony held on May 10, 2023, in Mumbai.
