At the Vivekananda Rock Memorial, the PM embarked on meditation on the evening of May 30 and he is scheduled to complete it on the evening of June 1.

Final phase today

Lok Sabha seats in 28 States and Union Territories. The Assemblies of Andhra Pradesh, Arunachal Pradesh and Sikkim also went to polls. Counting of votes will be taken up on June 4. In Arunachal Pradesh and Sikkim, the counting for the Assembly polls will be held on June 2.

According to Election Commission guidelines, television channels and news outlets will be able to run exit poll data and its results on June 1 after 6.30 pm.

The EC said polling parties have been dispatched along with machines and poll materials to their respective polling stations. At the 1.09 lakh polling stations, basic facilities including ample shade, drinking water, ramps, and toilets are being provided to ensure that polling takes place in a comfortable and secure environment, it said. The poll panel has also directed CEOs and state machineries to take adequate measures to manage the adverse impact of hot weather or rainfall wherever predicted. The parliamentary seats where polling will take place in Uttar Pradesh are Maharajganj, Gorakhpur, Kushinagar, Deoria, Bangsaon (SC), Ghosi, Salempur, Ballia, Ghazipur, Chandauli, Varanasi, Mirzapur and Robertsganj (SC), spread across 11 districts. In Varanasi, those contesting against Modi are Ajay Rai (Congress), Ather Jamal Lari (BSP), Kolisetty Shiva Kumar (Yuga Thulasi Party), Gagan Prakash Yadav, (Apna Dal, Kameravadi), and independents Dinesh Kumar Yadav and Sanjay Kumar Tiwari. In Punjab, prominent candidates in the fray are four-time MP Preeten Kaur, former CM Charanjit Singh Channi, three-time MP Harsimrat Kaur Badal and Ravneet Singh Bittu.

Heatstroke claims 25 poll...

According to the India Meteorological Department, the Kanpur (IAF) weather station recorded the maximum temperature in the country at 48.2. Haryana's Sirsa was the second hottest place at 47.8 degree Celsius. Delhi's Ayanagar recorded the maximum temperature for the city at 47 degrees Celsius.

Overall, the IMD said heatwave to severe heatwave conditions prevailed over many parts of Rajasthan, Punjab, Haryana, Chandigarh, Delhi, Uttar Pradesh; in some parts of Bihar, east Madhya Pradesh; in isolated pockets of Odisha, Jharkhand.

Prajwal arrested

He was later produced before the 42nd Additional Chief Metropolitan Magistrate K N Shivakumar, who heard the remand application and objection argument from Prajwal's advocate. He later remanded Prajwal to police custody.

The NDA Lok Sabha candidate from Hassan, facing allegations of sexually abusing several women, was arrested after completing the due process, Karnataka Home Minister G Parameshwara said.

Prajwal's advocate Arun G said the former was extending full cooperation to the SIT probe and cautioned against any media trial in the case.

"Prajwal Revanna landed around 12.40-12:50 am from Germany's Munich. As there was an arrest warrant against him, SIT accordingly arrested him and took him into custody," Parameshwara said.

Donald Trump convicted...

Over a six-week trial, the court heard from 22 witnesses, including Daniels, whose alleged sexual encounter with the former President was at the centre of the case.

As the verdicts were read, Trump remained silent and still. But the former President spoke to reporters outside the courtroom, calling the trial a "rigged, disgraceful trial" and saying that the "real verdict" will be rendered on Election Day. Prosecutors had argued that, by approving a scheme to disguise the money as legal expenses, Trump broke election law.

Trump's sentencing is scheduled for July 11, four days before the Republican National Convention in Milwaukee, Wisconsin, where he will be formally nominated as the party's presidential candidate against incumbent Joe Biden, an 81-year-old Democrat, in the elections. For now, Trump has been released without having to pay bail.

Trump alleged that this was done by the Biden administration to wound or hurt a political opponent. No former President or presumptive party nominee in the US has ever faced a felony conviction.

ED arrests U'khand resident in crypto-drug trafficking case

Uncovers over 8,000 bitcoins in illicit proceeds

DEHRADUN, May 31 (ANI)

THE Enforcement Directorate has arrested one Uttarakhand resident on charges of operating an international drug trafficking group to sell drugs in the US, the UK, and other European countries and receiving at least 8,088 Bitcoins as proceeds of crime, the agency said on Friday. ED's Dehradun unit arrested Banmeet Singh, a resident of Haldwani in Uttarakhand, under

the provisions of the Prevention of Money Laundering Act (PMLA), 2002, on May 29.

Banmeet was produced before a special court in Dehradun, which granted ED custody of the accused for seven days considering the socio-economic ramifications of the proceeds of drug money and the involvement of large-scale cryptocurrency.

The ED's investigation was prompted by a Mutual Legal

Assistance (MLA) request from US authorities, invoking a unique provision under Section 2(r) of PMLA, 2002, indicating cross-border offences. The scheduled offences correspond to violations under the NDPS Act.

The brothers, namely Banmeet Singh and Parvinder Singh, along with others, were operating an international drug trafficking group named the Singh DTO (Drug Trafficking Organization), said the ED in a

statement.

"They used vendor marketing sites on the dark web, numerous free advertisements on clear web websites, and a network of narcotics and controlled-substance distributors and distribution cells to sell drugs in USA, UK, and other European countries," stated the federal agency.

The Singh Organisation received the drug trafficking proceeds through sales on dark web markets, then laundered those

proceeds through cryptocurrency transactions, it further said. Both brothers, the ED said, used monikers "Liston" on a variety of dark web markets, including Silk Road 1, Alpha Bay, and Hansa.

As per the information, ED mentioned, the Singh brothers received at least 8,088 Bitcoins associated with 'Liston' monikers, which is nothing but the proceeds of crime through the sale of drugs in various countries.

One more infant succumbs during treatment in Delhi hospital fire

NEW DELHI, May 31 (PTI)

THE death toll in a fire in an east Delhi neonatal hospital rose to seven on Friday after a 50-day-old infant who was rescued from the incident site succumbed during treatment, police said.

"A 50-day-old girl child was under treatment. She succumbed on Friday morning. Further probe has been initiated," a senior police officer said. A family member of the victim also confirmed that the child has died. "Doctors told us about her death on Friday morning," said a family member.

SIT to investigate Prajwal's mother in kidnapping case

BENGALURU, May 31 (PTI)

THE Special Investigation Team (SIT) probing suspended JD(S) MP Prajwal Revanna, who is facing allegations of sexually abusing several women, has informed his mother Bhavani Revanna that they want to inquire her in a kidnapping case on June 1.

In a notice to Bhavani the SIT Inspector and Hemant Kumar M said there was a need to conduct an inquiry.

FOUR JAILED INDIANS REPATRIATED FROM PAKISTAN: FOUR Indian prisoners in Pakistan were repatriated to India this week, officials said on Friday.

The prisoners are Suraj Pal (Uttar Pradesh), Wahida Begum (Assam) and her son Faiz Khan and Shabir Ahmad Dars (Rajasthan), they said.

They were repatriated on May 29, the officials said.

It is learnt that the Indians were released after completion of their jail terms.

It is not immediately known what the charges against them were and how long they were imprisoned in Pakistan.

## बच्चों के यौन शोषण पर तत्काल शिकायत करें

» पाँक्सो एक्ट में पुलिस संवेदनशीलता से करेगी कार्रवाई » नहीं मिलेगी अग्रिम जमानत

भोपाल | पाँक्सो अधिनियम बच्चों को यौन शोषण के अपराधों से बचाने का प्रावधान है। यह कानून न सिर्फ बालिकाओं के यौन शोषण बल्कि नाबालिग लड़कों के साथ भी कोई अश्लील छेड़-छाड़ होती है तो उसे भी अपराध की ही श्रेणी में माना जाएगा। इस अधिनियम के तहत दुष्कर्म की पारंपरिक परिभाषा के अलावा उन कृत्यों को भी दुष्कर्म के संज्ञा दी गई है। जिससे बच्चे के साथ गलत भावना से छेड़-छाड़ की जाती है। यदि किसी व्यक्ति का पाँक्सो एक्ट के अन्तर्गत दोष सिद्ध हो जाता है तो उसे अपराधी मानते हुए कड़ी सजा देने का प्रावधान रखा गया है। पाँक्सो एक्ट में संशोधन से पहले अग्रिम जमानत का प्रावधान था। लेकिन संशोधन के बाद आरोपी को अग्रिम जमानत भी नहीं दी जाती।

पाँक्सो अधिनियम के तहत शिकायत दर्ज करने की प्रक्रिया अगर आप या आपका कोई जानने वाला यौन शोषण का शिकार

हुआ है तो आप पाँक्सो एक्ट के तहत शिकायत दर्ज करा सकते हैं। पहला कदम पुलिस से संपर्क करना और घटना की रिपोर्ट करना है। आप या तो व्यक्तिगत रूप से पुलिस स्टेशन जा सकते हैं या शिकायत दर्ज (Complaint Register) कराने के लिए पुलिस हेल्पलाइन नंबर पर कॉल भी कर सकते हैं। आपको घटना की तिथि, समय और स्थान के साथ-साथ यदि संभव हो तो अपराधी की पहचान जैसे विवरण प्रदान करने की आवश्यकता होगी। पुलिस दुर्व्यवहार के सबूत इकट्ठा करने के लिए पीड़िता की मेडिकल जांच की व्यवस्था करेगी। अगर पुलिस को पता चलता है कि शिकायत पाँक्सो अधिनियम के दायरे में आती है, तो वे प्रथम सूचना रिपोर्ट दर्ज करेंगे और जांच शुरू करेंगे। पाँक्सो अधिनियम के तहत एक नामित अदालत में मामले की कोशिश की जाएगी। पीड़िता और गवाहों (Witnesses) को कोर्ट में गवाही

(Testimony) देनी होगी। यह ध्यान रखना महत्वपूर्ण है कि पाँक्सो अधिनियम पीडित (Victim) और गवाहों की पहचान की सुरक्षा के लिए भी प्रावधान करता है। पाँक्सो के तहत पुलिस की जिम्मेदारियाँ पुलिस इस कानून को लागू करने और ऐसे अपराधों के पीड़ितों के लिए न्याय सुनिश्चित करने में महत्वपूर्ण भूमिका निभाती है। पाँक्सो एक्ट के तहत जब किसी बच्चे के खिलाफ यौन अपराध की शिकायत प्राप्त होती है, तो पुलिस को तुरंत शिकायत दर्ज करेगी। पुलिस पीड़ित या किसी गवाह के बचाने को इस तरह से दर्ज करने के लिए जिम्मेदार है जो बच्चे की उम्र, लिंग और मानसिक स्थिति के प्रति संवेदनशील हो। पुलिस को यह सुनिश्चित करेगी कि अपराध के सबूत इकट्ठा करने के लिए शिकायत के 24 घंटे के भीतर पीड़िता की मेडिकल जांच

हो। यदि अपराध में उनकी संलिप्तता (Involvement) का उचित संदेह है तो पुलिस के पास आरोपी व्यक्ति को बिना वारंट के गिरफ्तार करने की शक्ति है। पुलिस को जांच और मुकदमे के दौरान सुरक्षा और सहायता प्रदान करने सहित पीड़ित की सुरक्षा सुनिश्चित करनी चाहिए। पुलिस को अपराध की गहन जांच करनी चाहिए, अपराध से संबंधित सभी सबूतों को इकट्ठा करना चाहिए और उसे Court में पेश करना चाहिए। पुलिस को यह सुनिश्चित करना चाहिए कि पाँक्सो अधिनियम के प्रावधानों के अनुसार अभियुक्तों का मुकदमा समयबद्ध तरीके से चलाया जाए और उसमें तेजी लाई जाए। बच्चों की सुरक्षा सुनिश्चित करने और बच्चों के खिलाफ यौन अपराधों के अपराधियों को न्याय दिलाने के लिए पाँक्सो अधिनियम के तहत पुलिस की एक महत्वपूर्ण जिम्मेदारी है।

पाँक्सो एक्ट में सजा और जमानत नहीं मिलेगी अग्रिम जमानत एक बहुत ही गंभीर अपराध माना जाता है। जिसमें दोगो व्यक्ति को कड़ी से कड़ी सजा दिए जाने का प्रावधान होता है। जो भी व्यक्ति इस अपराध को करने का दोषी पाया जाता है। इस अधिनियम में अपराध की गंभीरता के आधार पर न्यूनतम 3 वर्ष से लेकर आजीवन कारावास तक की सजा का प्रावधान है। पाँक्सो एक्ट में संशोधन के बाद यह फैसला लिया गया कि अगर कोई 12 साल से कम उम्र की लड़कियों के साथ दुष्कर्म का दोषी पाया जाता है तो दोषी व्यक्ति को मौत की सजा दी जा सकती है। यदि किसी व्यक्ति पर नाबालिग बच्चे के साथ यौन शोषण जैसे अपराध करने के तहत मुकदमा दर्ज किया जाता है तो उसे किसी भी प्रकार से जमानत नहीं दी जा सकती है।

है। यदि लगातार एसी चलाते हैं तो Compressor काफी गर्म हो जाता है। कंप्रेसर पर दबाव बढ़ने से आग लगने का खतरा बढ़ जाता है। इसके अलावा गैस लीकज के कारण भी ब्लास्ट का खतरा बढ़ जाता है। इन बातों की रखें सावधानी : • अपने AC की नियमित रूप से सर्विस कराएं। • एसी के वोल्टेज का भी ध्यान रखें। वोल्टेज स्टेबलाइजर का भी उपयोग करें। • एयर फिल्टर और कूलिंग कॉइल्स को लगातार साफ करते रहें। • कंप्रेसर और कंडेनसर यूनिट के आस-पास सही वेंटिलेशन होना चाहिए। • कंप्रेसर को सीधे धूप या ज्यादा गर्म जगह पर न रखें।
