Focus on contact-tracing, monitoring containment zones, Uddhav tells district collectors

MUMBAI, AUGUST 7

CHIEF MINISTER Uddhav Thackeray instructed district collectors on Friday to focus on tracing contacts of Covid-19 patients, monitor containment zones and treat patients on time without any negligence to prevent a second wave of the pandemic in the state.

Thackeray issued the directives at meeting with all the district collectors, municipal commissioners and divisional commissioners through video-conferencing. Luv Agarwal, Joint Secretary from Union Health Ministry, also attended the meeting through video-conference.

"To prevent a second wave

of the Covid-19, the focus should be on the contact-tracing of Covid-19 patients, monitoring containment zones and treating patients on time. The spread of the coronavirus disease should be prevented. There should not be any negligence in it," the CM said.

Thackeray further said the jumbo facilities, on the lines of Mumbai, are being set up on priority in major cities of the state. "The mortality rate needs to be reduced. Also, it is a serious issue that there have been several complaints of overcharging by hospitals. The administration should deal with such cases strictly," he said.

Agarwal said 79 per cent cases in the state have been detected in 10 districts that include Pune, Thane, Mumbai, Nashik,

Ahmednagar, Raigad, Jalgaon, Nagpur, Palghar and Sangli. The mortality rate is also high in these districts, he added.

"The government is making good efforts but it also needs to pay attention to other important things. The attention should be given on monitoring the containment zones, door-to-door visits, testing 80 per cent contacts of a patient in 72 hours, and seeing whether any areas are becoming new hotspots. Attention should be given to patient treatment and hospital management as they play an important role in reducing the mortality rate," Agarwal said. If Mumbai and Maharashtra pay attention to some of the things, then it can be an example before the country on tackling the Covid-19 pandemic, he added.

For Ganesh Chaturthi, govt approves special trains from Mumbai to Konkan

MAHARASHTRA MAY soon see the resumption of inter-district train travel after the Uddhav Thackeray government on Friday gave its nod for running special trains from Mumbai to facilitate the movement of people to Konkan for Ganesh Chaturthi, which begins on August 22.

This comes as an exception to the existing guidelines of the state that do not permit inter-district train travel.

In a letter issued on Friday,

Director of Disaster Management Unit, Abhay Yawalkar, stated: "I am directed to state here that the special trains maybe scheduled for the Konkan region for the Ganapati festival in this current year. The number of trains maybe determined as per the demand for the same. A valid confirmed ticket for the same will serve as e-passes."

Lakhs of people from Mumbai and its adjoining areas head to Konkan districts of Ratnagiri and Sindhudurg for the 10-day Ganesh Utsav. With stringent restrictions imposed on travel amid the Covid-19 pandemic, several people from the

region had sought relaxations to visit Konkan, where Shiv Sena has a strong presence.

The state's nod comes as a response to a letter sent by the Central Railway (CR), which had sought the government's view, as rail officials were receiving appeals for such trains from public representatives.

"As passengers are not allowed to travel across districts in the special trains that are currently being operated, we wanted the state's view on the demand for special trains for Ganesh festival, as this will essentially only be inter-district travel," said a senior CR official.

Following the government nod, Central and Western Railway, along with Konkan Railway, is set to seek approval from the Railway Board and subsequently, issue a detailed timetable of special trains that would be run from Mumbai. Chief PRO of CR, Shivaji Sutar, said: "We will soon issue detailed information."

These special trains will take passengers to Konkan districts and ferry them back to Mumbai, said a government official. "No inter-district travel will be allowed in other trains but only in special trains that will be run for the festival," said

another official.

The proposal to run special trains comes three days after the government allowed inter-district travel for the festival in private and Maharashtra State Road Transport Corporation buses from Mumbai, Thane and Palghar.

Those traveling in buses have been asked to travel to Konkan latest by August 12 and undergo a 10-day home quarantine before the festival. The government had clarified on Thursday that it will create a separate portal for issuing e-passes to those opting for travel via private buses.

Tablighi reports can't be censored: Centre to SC

CITING PRESS freedom, the Centre has told the Supreme Court that the spread of Covid-19 among attendees of the Tablighi Jamaat convention in Nizamuddin Markaz, attacks on health workers by some sections, etc, were all matters of fact and that "news reports based on facts... cannot be censored".

"All the aforesaid facts are neither per se false nor per se fake. Though in isolated cases it may be exaggerated... news reports based on facts which are not prima facie not per se false or fake cannot be censored under Article 19(2) of the Constitution of India," the Ministry of Information and Broadcasting said in an affidavit filed in the top court.

The affidavit was filed in response to a plea by the Jamiat-Ulama-I-Hind, which sought

directions to prevent what it claimed was the communalisation of the Nizamuddin Markaz issue by certain sections of the print and electronic media.

Taking note, a bench headed by Chief Justice S A Bobde on Friday sought responses from the Press Council of India (PCI) and National Broadcasters Association (NBA).

The PCI counsel told the bench --- also comprising Justices A S Bopanna and V Ramasubramanian --- that it had taken cognizance of "around 50 cases" and will be

passing orders on the quasi-judicial side.

The Centre's affidavit said that the plea raised grievances against "certain section of media" without naming any and "certain news reports" without producing these reports. Instead, it "merely relied upon 'certain fact check news reports' to contend that entire media is perpetrating communal disharmony and hatred towards Muslims, and is therefore required to be censored/gagged", the government said.

Centre to states: Process health workers' insurance claims swiftly

THE CENTRE has asked state health secretaries to ensure swift processing of frontline health workers' claims under the government's insurance scheme in order to "secure and safeguard" them amid the Covid-19 pandemic.

In a letter to the secretaries on Thursday, Union Health Secretary Rajesh Bhushan wrote that the insurance cover of Rs 50 lakh for frontline healthcare workers under the Pradhan Mantri Garib Kalyan Package is available till September 2020, and that all states are "expected to quickly process such claims" and send them to the Health Ministry on priority. "The PMGKP was announced to provide an insurance cover of Rs 50 lakh for public healthcare providers and private hospital staff/retired/volunteer/local urban bodies/contract/daily wage/ad-hoc/out-sourced staff requisitioned for Covid-19 work... PMGKP will also include accidental loss of life on account of contracting Covid-19," Bhushan wrote to the states.

The Centre also stressed on the timely payment of salaries and honorarium to the healthcare workers.
