B'desh Minister blames Opp, Pro-Pak elements

Information and Broadcasting Minister M Hasan Mahmud on Thursday blamed Opposition Bangladesh Nationalist Party (BNP) and pro-Pakistan elements for the recent communal violence in the country during Durga Puja.

Addressing the media at Kolkata Press Club, Mr Mahmud said, "The people of Bangladesh and West Bengal are well aware of who is behind this. Some parties like BNP and Jamaat believe in communalism and they capitalise on it and create instability."

"You all know that even during the country's liberation struggle (1971), there were some people who supported the Pakistani army. Don't forget that their descendants are still there," added the

At least five people were killed and scores injured in the clashes. Based on the analysis of the CCTV footage, the police identified Iqbal Hossain, a resident of Cumilla, as the person responsible for the incident.

He further blamed the communal politics of BNP and Pakistan for the violence in the country and stated that the Bangladesh government has taken strict action against all

Bangladesh government has taken strict action against all the culprits after communal incidents took place in different parts of the country," said Mr Mahmud.

"When elections come, these people give anti-India, anti-Hindu slogans and also say that you people should not go to vote and these people have done this incident for political purpose," Mr Mahmud said.

He said that atrocities on the Hindu community were one such attempt through which they wanted to incite riots across the country.

"No Hindu had kept the Quran in the puja pandal. In the end, the investigation revealed that a Muslim named Iqbal had done it under provocation. Agencies are probing the matter and strict action is being taken," he added.

In Bangladesh, we do not believe in minorities. Everyone is Bangladeshi and this is our first identity. The festival of worship is not only for Hindus as we all participate in it and so is the case with Eid, which is celebrated by all," added the

"When Eid is celebrated in Bangladesh, not only Muslims but people of all religions take part in it and the same happens in India. Out of 32,000 pujas, only five or six were attacked by some people who are trying to communalise Bangladesh's pol-

"I loved my country, loved it very much, but had to leave because my children were in danger," Moradi told The Associated Press from her modest quarters in the Albanian town of Golem, whose beachside resorts have been converted to makeshift homes for some 2,000 Afghan refugees. Moradi, 83, was one of 10 children born to a Jewish family in Kabul. At age 16, she ran away from home and married a Muslim man. She never converted to Islam, maintained some Jewish traditions, and it was no secret in her neigh-

"She never denied her Judaism, she just got married in order to save her life as you cannot be safe as a young girl in Afghanistan," Moradi's daughter, Khorshid, told the AP from her home in Canada, where she and three of her siblings moved after the Taliban first seized power in Afghanistan in the

Despite friction over her decision to marry outside the faith, Moradi said she stayed in touch with some of her family over the years. Her parents and siblings fled Afghanistan in the 1960s and 1980s. Her parents are buried at Jerusalem's Har Menuhot cemetery, and many of her surviving siblings

But until this week, she had not spoken to some of her sisters in over half a century.

"Yesterday, I saw my sisters nieces and nephews after around 60 years through a video call. We spoke for hours," Moradi said. "I was really happy, I saw their children and they met mine." "They said it's like she came back from the grave," Khorshid said. During the first period of Taliban rule, from 1996 until the 2001 USled invasion, Moradi tried to maintain a low profile. But she risked her life by hiding Rabbi Isaak Levi, one of the few remaining Afghan Jews, from

The meeting took place in Doha on Wednesday, TOLO News reported. During the meeting, "Minister Muttaqi elaborated on the new Islamic government, ensuring security, ties with the international community, economic situation, sanctions imposed on Afghanistan, and elimination corruption", Foreign Ministry spokesman Abdul Qahar Balkhi said in a state-

"Afghanistan is witnessing a dominant government in 40 years, therefore the international community should call on the US to remove sanctions on the Afghan people's national wealth," the Minister was quoted as saying in the meeting. The new Afghan government "as a responsible govern-ment" fulfilled all of the conditions and that it should be recognised, he added.In the meeting, reportedly mediated by the Qatari government, the envoys urged the Taliban to abide by international rules, respect human rights, guarantee safe passage to Afghanistan and eradicate terrorism. China abruptly restricts use of BeiDou along borders with India important activities or prepa-

Chinese People's Liberation Army (PLA) has abruptly restricted the use of its navigation system, BeiDou along borders with India fearing their movement might tracked.Sources said the change in Chinese stance happened the moment India increased its surveillance mechanism along the Line of Actual Control. China, lately, has been making attempts of transgression in Indian territory.

Taking note of all these, the India Army enhanced surveillance both close to the LAC as well as in the depth areas by synergizing efforts of all surveillance equipment right from the strategic level till the tactical level where soldiers actually deployed. As surveillance increased, Intelligence agencies stated, a decrease in activation of BeiDou terminals all along the Northern Borders in the last one month was observed. Sources said that PLA is now using it only to send confirmations that they have reached their desired loca-

"It may be a deliberate attempt by the PLA to hide its rations across Northern Borders," the source said.

The system was launched on June 23, 2020 finally ending a project that went on for two decades.BDS, stated to be rivalling US' GPS, is the fourth global satellite navigation system in the world. Other systems are Russia's

GLONASS and the European Union's Galileo. India too is developing its own navigational system called the Indian Regional Navigation Satellite System (IRNSS), with an operational name of NAVIC.China wants to end the US-based GPS hegemony and push for its own developed navigation system first in the Asian region. To do so. China has estab-

lished a monitoring station at its Space and Upper Research Atmosphere Commission (SUPARCO) for monitoring and assessing the BeiDou Ğlobal Navigation Satellite System (GNSS).Now China is pushing the use of Beidou in many countries as part of their ambitious Belt and Road Initiative.

Currently, Beidou covers nearly 30 countries including Pakistan, Egypt and Indonesia.
