We would like to submit that Religare Finvest Limited (RFL), subsidiary of Religare Enterprises Limited (REL/the Company), has filed a criminal complaint with the Economic Offences Wing of the Delhi Police against Lakshmi Vilas Bank (LVB), individuals that were directors on the board of LVB and certain LVB's specified employees, RHC Holding Pvt. Ltd.(RHC Holding), individuals that were directors on the board of RHC Holding and certain specified employees of RHC Holding, Ranchem Private Limited ('Ranchem'), individuals that were directors on the board of Ranchem and certain specified employees of Ranchem, Mr. Malvinder Mohan Singh, Mr. Shivinder Mohan Singh and other unknown persons for various offences under the Indian Penal Code, 1860 including the offences of cheating, criminal breach of trust, breach of trust by banker, criminal misappropriation and criminal conspiracy.

REL was controlled by Mr. Malvinder Mohan Singh and Mr. Shivinder Mohan Singh until February 2018. Post exit of Mr. Malvinder Mohan Singh and Mr. Shivinder Mohan Singh from the Board of Director of REL on February 14, 2018, the Boards of REL and RFL have been reconstituted. Pursuant to reconstitution, the REL & RFL Boards now consists of professionals widely recognized in their respective fields, who are unconnected to the promoters. The reconstituted Boards have appointed a new professional management to manage the affairs of REL and its subsidiaries.

The new management discovered that one of the major reasons for RFL's terrible financial condition was the misappropriation by LVB of monies due to RFL on account of four fixed deposits placed by it with LVB amounting to approx. Rs. 791 crores (including interest accrued on Rs. 750 crores of principal amount), such misappropriation had caused a massive unlawful loss to the RFL and consequently to all its stakeholders including the public shareholders.
