The above results for the year ended 31 March 2019 have been audited by statutory auditors of the Company in terms of Regulation 33 of the SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015.
- The results has been prepared in accordance with the Companies (Indian Accounting Standards) Rules, 2015 (as amended), prescribed under section 133 of the Companies Act, 2013 and other recognised accounting practices and policies, to the extent applicable.
- The Company's business segment consists of a single primary segment of Specialty petroleum products, as per Indian Accounting Standard (Ind AS-108) Operating Segment.
- The Board of Directors in it's meeting held today, have recommended for the approval of members a Dividend of ₹ 1.20 per equity share of ₹ 2/- each for the financial year 2018-2019.
- The figures of the quarters ended 31 March 2019 and 31 March 2018 are balancing figures between the audited figures in respect of the full financial year ended on 31 March 2019 and 31 March 2018 (Ind AS) respectively and the published year to date Ind AS figures upto third quarters ended on 31 December 2018 and 31 December 2017 respectively. which were subjected to a limited review.
- Consequent to the introduction of Goods & Services Tax (GST) with effect from 1 July 2017, Central Excise, Valued added Tax (VAT) etc. have been subsumed into GST. In accordance with the Indian Accounting Standard-18 on Revenue and Schedule III of the Companies Act 2013, Revenue from operations are required to be disclosed net of GST/VAT etc and inclusive of Excise duty. Accordingly, the figures of revenue from operations for the year ended 31 March 2019 are not strictly comparable with the corresponding year ended 31 March 2018.
- Ind AS 115 " Revenue from Contracts with Customers", mandatory from reporting periods beginning on or after 1 April 2018, replaces existing revenue recognition. The Company has elected the option of the modified retrospective approach and there were no material adjustments required to be made in the retained earnings as at 1 April 2018. The adoption of Ind AS 115 did not have material impact on the above financial results.
- Figures of corresponding previous year/period(s) have been restated/regrouped/reclassified wherever necessary.



- 5) The Board of Directors in its meeting held today, have recommended for the approval of members a Dividend of ₹ 1.20 per equity share of ₹ 2/- each for the financial year 2018-2019.
- 6) The figures for the quarters ended 31 March 2019 and 31 March 2018 are balancing figures between the audited figures in respect of the full financial year ended on 31 March 2019 and 31 March 2018 (Ind AS) respectively and the published year to date Ind AS figures upto third quarters ended on 31 December 2018 and 31 December 2017 respectively, which were subjected to a limited review.
- 7) Consequent to the introduction of Goods & Services Tax (GST) with effect from 1 July 2017, Central Excise, Valued added Tax (VAT) etc. have been subsumed into GST.
