Yellow vest protesters join union march

Brief scuffles mark the mostly calm Paris demonstration

France's yellow vest protest movement joined ranks with a major union, a first for both, in a day of nationwide protests over taxes and buying power that brought tens of thousands into the streets.

Brief scuffles marked the mostly calm Paris demonstration on Tuesday.

Police fired several rounds of tear gas, clearing troublemakers from the Place de la Concorde, which borders the US Embassy.

Tear gas was also used in Lille and elsewhere.

However, tension was minimal compared with the week-long protests held since mid-November by the yellow vest movement to demand fiscal and social justice in a major challenge to President Emmanuel Macron.

As protesters marched, lawmakers in the national Assembly, the Lower House of Parliament, voted 387-92 to pass a bill aimed at preventing violence during protests, and helping authorities maintain order.

The Bill would, for instance, authorise regional prefects to prevent people seen as a serious threat to public order from protesting, or force protesters involved in violence to pay for damage.

The Bill, which must go



before the Senate, would also make it a crime for protesters to conceal their faces — a common occurrence during Saturday protests by the yellow vest movement, by both those trying to offset the effects of tear gas and by troublemakers concealing their identities.

Meanwhile, the Communist-backed CGT union marched from Paris City Hall to the Place de la Concorde side-by-side with protesters from the yellow vest movement, which takes its name from the safety vests they wear that are required in all cars.

Union chief Philippe Martinez cheered the hand-in-hand protests with the yellow vests, promising daily initiatives and "something big" each Tuesday.

He noted overlapping demands between his union and yellow vest protesters. "There's no reason why we shouldn't demonstrate next to each other or one behind another."

What's important is that our first day together is a success, in the middle of the week," he said.

"I find business leaders have it easy and it's time we hold big company bosses in this country accountable," Martinez said. The grassroots yellow vest movement has no appointed leader and an array of demands.

However, increasing buying power and ending what they perceive as favoritism toward the powerful at the expense of the less fortunate are leading demands.

Trump praises legal immigrants

...says he wants people to come into US, but legally

Making yet another strong pitch for people to come into the US based on merit, US President Donald Trump said on Wednesday that tolerance for illegal immigration is not compassionate — it is cruel.

Trump, in his annual State of the Union address, said: "We have a moral duty to create an immigration system that protects the lives and jobs of our citizens."

The lawless state of the southern Mexico border is a threat to the safety, security and financial well-being of all Americans, he said.

"This (moral duty) includes our obligation to the millions of immigrants living here today, who followed the rules and respected our laws. Legal immigrants enrich our nation and strengthen our society in countless ways. I want people to come into our country, but they have to come in legally," said the US President in his address to a joint session of the US Congress.

Trump said his administration has sent to Congress a commonsense proposal to end the crisis on southern border.

"It includes humanitarian assistance, more law enforcement, drug detection at our ports, closing loopholes that enable child smuggling, and plans for a new physical barrier, or wall, to secure the vast areas between our ports of entry."

"In the past, most of the people in this room voted for a wall — but the proper wall never got built. I'll get it built."

Trump said. This is a smart, strategic, see-through steel barrier -- not just a simple concrete wall, he said. "It will be deployed in the areas identified by border

agents as having the greatest need, and as these agents will tell you, where walls go up, illegal crossings go way down.

"Simply put, walls work and walls save lives. So let's work together, compromise, and reach a deal that will truly make America safe," said the US President.

Asking the Congress to defend the very dangerous southern border, Trump said no issue better illustrates the divide between America's working class and America's political class than illegal immigration.

He said that wealthy politicians and donors push for open borders while living their lives behind walls and gates and guards. Meanwhile, working class Americans are left to pay the price for mass illegal migration -- reduced jobs, lower wages, overburdened schools and hospitals, increased crime, and a depleted social safety net, he told members of the US Congress.

'Reject politics of revenge, resistance, retribution'

US President Donald Trump on Wednesday called for rejecting politics of revenge, resistance and retribution, but insisted on building a wall along the US-Mexico border as he appeared before a divided Congress for his annual State of the Union address.

His calls for reconciliation were met with mostly stonewalled silence from Democrats, who bitterly oppose his agenda and accuse him of hastening the decline in cross-party cooperation.

The president had a record 35-day standoff with the Democrats led by House Speaker Nancy Pelosi over his proposed controversial wall

along the US-Mexico border, which shut down the government and postponed the address which was earlier scheduled on January 29.

"We must reject the politics of revenge, resistance and retribution," Trump told Congress near the beginning of his State of the Union address, claiming in his speech that he is putting forward "the agenda of the United States."

"An economic miracle is taking place in the United States -- and the only thing that can stop it are foolish wars, politics or ridiculous partisan investigations," the president said.

He said that tolerance for illegal immigration is not compassionate — it is cruel.

TEMPLE VANDALISED IN PAK, PM ORDERS ACTION

Islamabad/Karachi: A Hindu temple was vandalised in Pakistan's Sindh province by miscreants who set the holy books and idols on fire, drawing a strong reaction from Prime Minister Imran Khan who ordered swift and decisive action against the perpetrators.

EX-PAK PM GILANI STOPPED FROM LEAVING COUNTRY

Lahore: Former Pakistan Prime Minister Yousuf Raza Gilani was stopped from leaving the country by security officials at the Lahore airport late on Tuesday night.

IRAN ARRESTS 5 AFTER GUNMEN KILL COP

Tehran: Gunmen killed an Iranian policeman and wounded a police officer in a shootout on Wednesday during which a stray bullet hit a fuel tanker, causing it to explode, Iran's state TV reported. Authorities later said five suspects were arrested.

QATAR TAKES DELIVERY OF FIRST RAFALE JET

Merignac(France): Qatar on Wednesday took delivery of the first 36 Rafale multi-purpose jet fighters it has ordered from French manufacturer Dassault. The hand-over ceremony in Merignac, southwestern France, where the planes are built, was attended by Qatar Defence Minister Khalid bin Mohamed Al-Attiyah and Dassault Aviation chief Eric Trappier.

MACEDONIA SIGNS NATO ACCESSION ACCORD

Brussels: Macedonia signed accession papers with NATO on Wednesday, a key step on the way to joining the alliance after resolving a long-running name row with Greece. The Macedonian Foreign Minister Nikola Dimitrov and representatives of all current NATO members signed the protocol at alliance headquarters in Brussels. NATO Secretary General Jens Stoltenberg said it was a "historic day".

Venezuela's military blocks humanitarian aid shipment

Caracas: Venezuelan military officers blocked a bridge on the border with Colombia ahead of an anticipated humanitarian aid shipment Tuesday, as opposition leader Juan Guaido stepped up his challenge to President Nicolas Maduro's authority. The Opposition-dominated National Assembly had earlier warned the armed forces, which make up much of Maduro's power base, not to cross a "red line" by blocking aid.

Guaido, who proclaimed himself acting president on January 23 -- sparking an international crisis -- claims that up to 300,000 people face death if the aid is not delivered.

"You know there's a red line, you know well there's a limit, you know that medicines, food and medical supplies are that limit," lawmaker Miguel Pizarro said in a message to the military.

Sri Lanka to resume executions within 2 months: President

Colombo: Sri Lankan President Maithripala Sirisena said on Wednesday that he will implement death penalty for drug dealers within three months, ending a 42-year moratorium on capital punishment in the country.

Sirisena said that execution of drug convicts is a necessity in view of the fast spreading drug menace in the island nation. "I will implement the death penalty during the next 2-3 months," he said while addressing the parliament. Sri Lanka's last hanging took place in June 1976. Since then successive presidents have refused to sign death warrants to hang convicts. Sirisena took the decision despite Sri Lanka becoming party to a UN moratorium on death penalty in 2016.

He said that his decision which was expressed last year could not be carried out due to bureaucratic lethargy and the links between officials and drug mafias.

Pope tamps down Maduro's hopes for Vatican intervention

Pope Francis has acknowledged receiving a request from embattled Venezuelan President Nicolas Maduro to help relaunch talks to end the country's political crisis but ruled out any involvement unless opposition leader Juan Guaido requests it. Francis on Tuesday acknowledged that he hadn't read Maduro's letter, which he said arrived at the Vatican via a diplomatic pouch.

He added, "We'll see what can be done." But speaking to reporters en route home from the United Arab Emirates, he recalled that a previous Vatican diplomatic effort to facilitate talks between Maduro and the opposition "went up in smoke."

And he insisted on the basic diplomatic requirement that two sides to any conflict must jointly request external facilitation or mediation of negotiations.

Iraqi cleric rejects Trump's plan for US troops in Iraq

Iraq's most senior Shiite cleric on Wednesday joined a chorus of Iraqi politicians and clerics criticizing recent statements by President Donald Trump in which he said US troops should stay in Iraq to keep an eye on neighbouring Iran.

Grand Ayatollah Ali al-Sistani said Iraq aspires to have "good and balanced relations" with all of its neighbors "based on mutual interests and with-

out intervention in internal affairs."

Iraq "rejects being a launching pad for harming any other country," he said during a meeting with UN Iraq envoy Jeanine Hennis-Plasschaert at the cleric's base in Najaf.

Both Iraq's President and Prime Minister have hit back at Trump's statements to US media this week stating that US troops should stay at a base in Iraq so that America can "watch Iran."

My UAE trip wrote new page in Christian-Islam history, says Pope

Vatican City: Pope Francis says his pilgrimage this week to the United Arab Emirates wrote a "new page in history of the dialogue between Christianity and Islam" and in promoting world peace based on brotherhood.

Telling pilgrims at the Vatican on Wednesday about making the first-ever papal trip to the Arabian Peninsula.
