UBT opposes huge robotic car parking

The Shiv Sena (UBT) has launched a signature campaign against a proposed 17storey robotic parking tower behind Mumbadevi temple in

Around 900 including devotees visiting the temple and residents of Mumbadevi, have signed the campaign.

"We plan to continue the campaign for two or three days, gather 4,000 to 5,000 signatures, and submit it with a letter to the BMC commissioner," a local Sena UBT leader said.

The BMC has undertaken the Rs122 crore project at Mumbadevi, which will accommodate more than 500 vehicles. The project is one of the four robotic parking towers the corporation has planned. The other three are located at Fort (Hutatma Chowk), Worli and Matunga.

Shiv Sena (UBT) leader and MLA Aaditya Thackeray has also voiced his opposition to the project and alleged that it is planned to benefit contractors. He met Bhushan Commissioner Gagrani earlier this week and urged him to scrap the project. Along with Thackeray, the manager Mumbaidevi Temple Trust, Hemant Jadhav, was also present. "We are not against the development. However, we had requested to construct the tower on the other corner of the plot. The 17-storey tower right behind the temple is nothing but a safety

'MSRTC fare hike failed to lift revenues'

The Maharashtra State Road Transport Corporation (MSRTC) is struggling to generate revenues despite the recent fare hike, a workers' union has warned

The demand for bus services is high, but the corporation's fleet has dwindled to 14,000 buses from 18,000 before the pandemic, the Maharashtra Employees Congress has said.

Shrirang Barge, general secretary of the union, appealed to the chief minister to ensure the swift arrival of new buses. This will alleviate the shortage and provide better services, he said. According to the union,

MSRTC raised fares by 14.95% in January 2025, but a review of the last 10 days of revenue reveals only a 7.5% increase. "Prior to the fare hike, daily revenue was approximately Rs28 crore, and with the fare hike, the expected daily revenue was Rs32.74 crore. However, only Rs30.22 crore has been earned, resulting in a shortfall of approximately Rs2.51 crore per day," read the statement issued by Barge.

Funds to fight pollution spent on electric buses

Under the National Clean Air Programme (NCAP) launched in 2019, Mumbai was identified as one of 131 non-attainment

cities in India – that is in the list of cities that consistently fail National Ambient Air Quality Standards. Accordingly, to curb the pollution in the city, the central government granted Rs95.5 crore and till now Rs 620 crore has been provided under 15th Finance

The BMC, in its progress report on NCAP, has stated that it has utilised 100% of the central government funds and 94% of the funds provided Commission to implement measures to control pollution.

In the report, which was presented during the eight steering committee meeting of NCAP, the BMC has stated that maximum of the funds was used for procuring electric BEST buses, followed by minor expenses against procuring seven mechanised sweeping machines and converting six traditional crematoria into electric or PNG.

Although the BMC claims the NCAP has been implesuccessfully Mumbai, the Air Quality Index (AQI) in the city continues to worsen. "Unfortunately there has been no meaningful consultation with the public nor civil society regarding the preparation and implementation of the program. Spending money on buying electric buses was the easy way out, and also very lucrative for the decision-makers since the buses were ordered from a company that has failed to deliver most of the buses," said environmentalist and trustee of Conservation Action Trust,

Debi Goenka "The critical issues of pollution caused by construction activities, industrial pollution. biomass burning, etc, have not been addressed, which is why we continue to suffer," Goenka added, Activist Zoru Bhathena said that the best way to clean Mumbai's air is not to pollute it in the first place. "Spending Rs10,000 crore to needlessly dig up every road, and then to spend Rs95 crore to clean the pollution caused by all this dig-

ging, makes no sense," he said. A senior officer from BMC's Environment Department said, "Under the 15th Finance Commission, Rs1240.25 crore has been allocated to the BMC for air quality management. Till now Rs620.11 crore has been granted and we have utilised 94% of the funds to imple-

BMC seizes 18 properties of DBS Realty over ₹179cr dues

The BMC has launched a crackdown against defaulters. As part of the initiative, the Assessment and Collection (A&C) Department has seized 18 properties owned by DBS Company Chandivali, with dues totalling Rs178.64 crore. The authorities have warned that if the company fails to pay the dues within the 21-day deadline, the properties will be put up for auction.

The BMC has set a tax collection target of Rs6,200 crore for 2024-25. Between May 26, 2024, and February 12, 2025, it collected Rs4,823 crore. Officials are working to collect the remaining Rs1,377 crore by March 31. To ensure this, the BMC has been issuing attachment notices under Section 203 to big defaulters who delay payments or fail to pay property tax despite having the financial capacity.

If the taxes are not paid within the stipulated period,



the BMC initiates the process of attaching and auctioning goods from the defaulting property, in accordance with Sections 203, 204, 205, and 206 of the Mumbai Municipal Corporation Act. The officials have placed attachment notices on 18 properties owned by DBS Realty located Sangharsh Nagar at Chandivali.

"Despite follow-ups, no response has been received, leading to the attachment notices being affixed to all these properties. If the taxes are not paid within the next 21 days, as per MMC Act, the will be seized and auctioned," said BMC said.

Meanwhile, the BMC has compiled a list of 500 Meanwhile, the BMC defaulters, which includes names of real estate developers, corporations, and even civic offices. According to civic calculations, the pending dues up to March 2010 amounted to Rs3.242 crore, which have now escalated to Rs5,397 crore after the addition of penalties over

the last 15 years.
