Theatre workshop organised by The Canvas, Udalguri

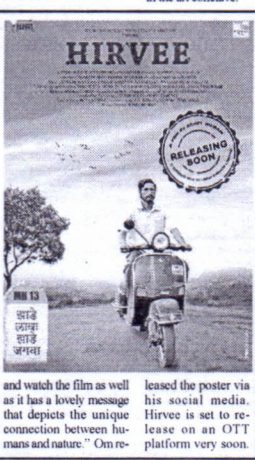
