On 22nd April, 2019, Mr. Ness Wadia was given a suspended sentence of two years, which sentence is suspended for a period of five years.

Mr. Ness Wadia has since been available to the Company and is performing his duties in accordance with his role.

We have also obtained clear legal opinion that there is no question of disqualification / vacation of the office of director/Managing Director under Indian law since the matter relates to a court outside the territory of India, and since the sentence has been suspended and is without effect.
