Pursuant to Regulation 30 of the Listing Regulations, this is to inform that the Company has received an order for the period April 2021 to March 2022 passed by Assistant Commissioner of Revenue, Government of West Bengal confirming demand of GST of INR 11,12,79,712/- (Rupees eleven crores twelve lakhs seventy nine thousand seven hundred and twelve only) with interest of INR 5,46,81,021/- (Rupees five crores forty six lakhs eighty one thousand and twenty one only) and penalty of INR 1,11,27,971/- (Rupees one crore eleven lakhs twenty seven thousand nine hundred and seventy one only).

The details of order as required under Regulation 30 of the Listing Regulations read with SEBI circular no. SEBI/HO/CFD/PoD-1/P/CIR/2023/123 dated 13 July 2023 is enclosed herewith as **Annexure - I**.
