Ward 67 | Bhargav's surprise visit takes him aback Residents complain about erratic water supply, cleanliness

Mayor Pushyamitra Bhargav's surprise inspection at Ward 67 on Friday took him aback as residents openly expressed their dissatisfaction with the erratic water supply and the inability of garbage vehicles to access the narrow streets, resulting in garbage being dumped on the roads.

In a move to ensure better civic amenities, Bhargav conducted a surprise inspection at Ward 67, covering Balkrishna Colony (Balda Colony) and Lodha Colony.

Accompanied by health in-charge Ashwini Shukla, Ward corporator Seema Dangi, additional municipal commissioner Devdhar Darwai, and other officials, the mayor sought to address critical concerns related to cleanliness, drainage, and water supply in the area.

During his visit, the mayor interacted with local residents to gather feedback on the cleanliness system and garbage collection services. The residents expressed dissatis-



faction with the unreliable water supply and the inability of garbage vehicles to access the narrow streets. Resultantly, people dump in garbage on the roads, they told Bhargav.

Responding promptly, Bhargav directed officials to arrange appropriate vehicles for garbage collection and emphasised strict action against those who continue to litter the streets. "If residents persist in throwing garbage on the road, challans should be issued," he said.

During his inspection, the mayor found the cleanliness

conditions unsatisfactory. Garbage accumulation and poor hygiene prompted him to take immediate action. Inspector Jai Chintaman, who had been overseeing Ward 67 for the past decade, was removed from his position on the mayor's orders, with instructions to additional commissioner Abhilash Mishra for swift implementation.

Addressing the residents' water supply concerns, the mayor assured them that the issue would be resolved soon. He urged residents without water connections to obtain them promptly, assuring,

"Once you have the connection, there will be no further water problems. Testing is underway, and getting the connection within a week will solve the issue."

He also instructed officials to repair the area's government hand pump and stressed that cleanliness must be maintained.

The mayor expressed dissatisfaction with the condition of the roads following the laying of a new water supply line. He ordered municipal officials to ensure the road was restored to its original condition and instructed CSI to expedite the repair.

Furthermore, regarding road construction in Balkrishna Colony, the mayor noted that tenders for two roads had already been allocated to an agency. However, citing inefficiency, he directed the removal of the current agency and the assignment of the project to a new contractor. He set a deadline, stating, "I will revisit in 20 days, and by then, both the water supply and roadwork should be underway."

Traffic diversion near Khajrana temple for Ganesh Utsav

To ensure smooth traffic flow during the annual Ganesh Utsav near Khajrana Ganesh Temple between September 7 and September 17 in which thousands of devotees are expected to visit, the traffic management police have made several arrangements for the convenience of commuters.

Route to Khajrana Ganesh Temple: Vehicles heading to the temple will move through the service road from Khajrana Square, turn-

ing left at Siddhivinayak Hospital towards Ganeshpuri Main Road. From Goyal Vihar Rain Basera Tri-section, vehicles can move to the temple's entry gate and reach the designated parking area.

Exit after Darshan: After visiting the temple, vehicles will exit the parking lot via the Kalka Mata Temple Gate, turn left at Ganesh Temple Tri-section and proceed through Peepal Square to return to Khajrana Square.

Route for Khajrana: Those heading to Khajrana will take Goya Road from

Khajrana Square. Similarly, those coming to Khajrana Square can use the route via Jamjam Tri-section and Mannat General Store on Goya Road. Restricted Areas: No vehicles will be allowed on the service road from Bengali Square to Siddhivinayak Hospital. The city buses will also be restricted on the route from Khajrana Square, Goya Road to Star Square and from Peepal Square towards Khajrana. The traffic police urged commuters to use the alternative routes and to cooperate with the traffic management.
