Ram Ram to Education Minister from a distance to the flood victims

Vadodra After three days of flood situation in Vadodra city, all the leaders, be it party or opposition, are being protested by local people everywhere. Then today (September 2) Education Minister Kuber Dindor came to Somnath Society near Waghadia Road in Vadodra for a grain kit distribution program. Before going to the venue of the program, he was in Balakrishna had a meeting with Shukla and the workers.

Where the residents of the adjacent society came and protested. When he went to distribute grain kits in Somnath society, a resident signaled him to go ahead. The minister had to be caught looking down in the midst of the people.

After spending 3 days between water and crocodiles, people are very angry. Heavy rains a few days before the program in Vadodra on August 27 and 28. It was a situation where

the entire city was submerged in water. After spending two to three days in the water, people were very angry with the system, which is still being seen. At present, in the flood-affected areas of the city, where the leaders go, people are getting complaints. Today, Education Minister Kuber Dindor distributed food kits in a flooded society near Waghadia Road in Dindor. It was there that some locals arrived to make a presentation, where they said that what we need is not a kit, but a drainage system.

A local even asked to stay away from BJP while local BJP workers and Dandak tried to convince the protesting people. In the meantime, the local people also clashed with the BJP workers. A local here had even said that he has been with BJP for years, but now he has to stay away from BJP.

We don't need any kit; Yogesh Sheth in this matter, Yogesh Sheth, a local, said that if it rains six inches, the water comes up to one foot, what should we do about it. There is no solution to this. We have been suffering for the past five years. We have a water log problem here, which should be solved, we have no other submissions. We don't need any grain kit, just water disposal.

No help, need for drainage: Parulben Gandhi, a local who came for Parulben's presentation, said that immediately after the rains, water comes to our house. There are two little girls in the house and do something about it. We do not need cereal kit materials. Help whoever needs it, we need to drain the water. One and half to two feet of water comes as soon as it rains. We live in Vallabh Vatika. We don't need aid, we need drainage.

Money withdrawn from accounts of 37 people in the name of ration card e-KYC in Manekpur, Unana

Unna : The people of Manekpur village are poor and backward class working people, they do black labor day and night and run their family's Gujarat. When the account has been removed, the young man who came

to do KYC is also in trouble as he is not aware of the existence of Ford app. Police questioned this young man and found documents of 181 people. It is known that people have given the PDF of the online document to the police. All data went to him: Sarpanch representative. Sarpanch representative of Manekpur, Lakhbhai Ranshibhai Rathore, expressed fear that people's ten finger fingerprints along with Aadhar card, ration card, mobile number in the Ford ID biometric system in the name of EKYC have gone to the people doing the bypass operation on Ford ID. At present, money has been withdrawn from the accounts of working women and expressing fear that ford may happen again in the future, after investigating this matter to the root, collecting the data of the people.

Coastguard helicopter PM Modi in hometown on birthday crashes in Porbandar sea

Porbandar An Indian Coast Guard helicopter carrying out flood-related relief and rescue operations in Gujarat crashed-landed in the Arabian Sea. Meanwhile, two pilots of the Indian Coast Guard aboard the helicopter are missing. A rescue diver was also traveling with him. There is no information about it either. According to reports, one crew member has been rescued, but the remaining three are missing.

An Indian Coast Guard (ICG) helicopter made an emergency landing at sea near Porbandar on its way to rescue an injured crew member on board an oil tanker in the Arabian Sea. This tragedy happened then. The helicopter crash-landed in the sea near Porbandar late on Monday night. There were four people on board including the pilot. A crew member was rescued by an emergency rescue operation after the crash landing, but three others are still missing. The information was given by tweeting by the Indian Coast Guard.

Immediate rescue of 26 people Part of staircase of Madhuram flat in Vejalpur collapsed, fire-pole team rushed to get call; Snorkled people down

Ahmedabad A part of the staircase of a block collapsed in Madhuram Flats in Vejalpur, Ahmedabad. As soon as the call of this incident was received, the team of fire and police department reached the spot. An immediate rescue operation was carried out for the people living in the block. 26 people were rescued by snorkel within a matter of hours by a team of fire and police department. All the people living on the upper floors were brought down with the help of ladders. Currently, there is no news of any casualty in this incident.

According to the information received by the fire team at the spot as soon as the call was received, a part of the staircase suddenly collapsed in Jivaraj Park, Madhuram Flat next to HP Petrol Pump in Vejalpur around 5 am today (September 2). As soon as the sound of falling stairs was heard, the people who were nearby also reached the place.

After which the fire department was immediately informed and the fire and police team rushed to the spot. One to two fire engines and an ambulance also reached the spot. In this incident, the residents of 4 floors were trapped inside. He needs amendment of this certificate to get insurance, property and retirement benefits.

The rescue of 26 people was carried out by the fire department team with the help of snorkels on the upper floors. In which people were slowly lowered down with the help of a ladder by tying a heavy rope around their waist. Within a few hours, the fire department successfully rescued 26 people.
