'Looking to create multiple Singapores in India'

JOINT EFFORT. Modi and his Singaporean counterpart discuss cooperation in advanced manufacturing, digitalisation and healthcare

Prime Minister Narendra Modi held wide-ranging bilateral talks with his Singaporean counterpart Lawrence Wong, focusing on areas such as advanced manufacturing, connectivity, digitalisation and healthcare & medicine, and said that India aimed to create multiple 'Singapores' within itself.

"Singapore is not merely a partner country; it serves as an inspiration for every developing nation. We also aim to create multiple 'Singapores' within India. I am pleased that we are collaborating towards this goal. The ministerial roundtable we have established is a path-breaking mechanism," Modi said during his talks with Wong in Singapore on Thursday.

Collaborative initiatives have been identified in areas

such as skilling, digitalisation, mobility, advanced manufacturing, semiconductors and AI, healthcare, sustainability and cybersecurity, Modi said.

Modi, who concluded his two-day visit to the country on Thursday, also met Singapore's President Tharman Shanmugaratnam and interacted with the chiefs of top

businesses such as Temasek Holdings, DBS Group, Singapore Airlines, GIC Pvt Ltd, SingTel and Changi Airport Group.

"Over the past 10 years, our trade has more than doubled. Mutual investment has increased almost threefold to cross \$150 billion. Singapore was the first country with which we

launched the UPI Person-to-Person payment facility," Modi said during his meeting with Wong.

ELEVATING TIES

The two leaders agreed to elevate bilateral ties to a "comprehensive strategic partnership" which India hopes would also give a major boost to its Act East Policy.

"They also reviewed existing cooperation in the fields of defence and security, maritime domain awareness, education, AI, fintech, new technology domains, science and technology and knowledge partnership. The two leaders called for strengthening connectivity between the countries to enhance economic and people-to-people ties. They also called for acceleration in green corridor projects," according to a statement issued by the Ministry of External Affairs.

Both leaders witnessed

exchange of MoUs for co-operation in semiconductors, digital technologies, skill development and healthcare, which were the outcomes of the deliberations during the two rounds of India-Singapore Ministerial roundtables held so far.

Modi and Wong called for accelerated action under the pillars of cooperation identified during the Ministerial roundtables — advanced manufacturing, connectivity, digitalisation, healthcare & medicine, skills development and sustainability.

In his meeting with businesses, the Prime Minister acknowledged the role played by the Singaporean industry leaders in strengthening bilateral relations and promoting economic co-operation between India and Singapore.

Modi announced the setting up of an 'Invest India' office in Singapore to further facilitate their collaboration with India, per the statement.

The PM said the elevation of India-Singapore ties to a Comprehensive Strategic Partnership would give a major thrust to bilateral economic relations.

Telangana unveils 200-acre AI City project

The Telangana government has unveiled its plan to build a 200-acre AI City with an aim to become a global hub for artificial intelligence. Chief Minister A Revanth Reddy has launched the logo for the project after inaugurating the two-day Global AI Summit at the Hyderabad International Convention Centre.

Telangana IT Minister Duddida Sridhar Babu said that the State was not merely participating in the AI race. "We are leading it. This is backed by a robust growth of 11.3 per cent in the Gross State Domestic Product (GSDP) of \$176 billion," he said. "The AI City would focus on research, development, and application. It will

promote ground-breaking innovations in the field of AI. We will also set up an AI School in the AI city," the minister declared.

As the work begins on the AI City, the State government has tied up with the World Trade Centre, Shamshabad, to provide 2 lakh square feet of office space for AI-driven companies, ensuring they can commence operations swiftly while the AI City takes shape.

Earlier addressing the gathering, the Chief Minister acknowledged the concerns around job losses. "Uncertainties and apprehensions are common when a new technology is introduced," he said. He said the Telangana AI Mission and Nascom would help the government in implementing the AI framework in the State. "We will work with the stakehold-

ers as we lay strong foundations for a thriving AI ecosystem," he said.

PARTNERSHIPS

In order to promote the AI sector in the State, the government entered into 26 memoranda of understanding with various companies, start-ups and organisations, in the areas of computer infrastructure, start-up innovation, Generative AI, research and collaboration, skilling and data annotation.

Data centre company Yotta Data Services announcing plans to set up a 25,000 GPU supercomputer at the upcoming purpose-built 50 MW data centre campus. In the first phase, which would be implemented over the next two years, the supercomputer would have 4,000 GPUs along with high-speed networking and storage in-

frastructure. "Yotta H1 located within the campus will be the first purpose-built high-density liquid cooled AI Cloud Data Centre in the State," Sunil Gupta, Co-founder, Managing Director and Chief Executive Officer of Yotta Data Services, has said.

The government would work with PATH and Nazara Technologies to build Centres of Excellence that would focus on promoting AI in crucial and emerging areas in the State. It also signed agreements with NxtWave, Amazon Web Services and Microsoft to develop talent and promote skill development among the youth. This is expected to benefit over 2.5 lakh students and professionals. A three-year agreement was signed with Nvidia Corporation to accelerate AI adoption in the State.

In AI push, India eyes 50,000 GPUs in 3 years

India, a late entrant to the AI party, is making efforts to make up for the lost ground to be in the top league. Abhishek Singh, Additional Secretary in the Union Ministry of Electronics and Information Technology (MeitY), said that the country would have at least 50,000 graphic processing units (GPUs) in the next 2-3 years, giving AI start-ups the much-needed firepower. GPUs are at the heart of the computation backbone for AI applications.

"We are lagging in computing power and research papers. The government itself commits for 10,000 GPUs, while Yotta announced plans to build a 25,000-GPU

clusters and Tatas and Jios had announced plans to build 50,000 GPUs. We don't know their timelines but we should be reaching a minimum of 50,000 GPUs in the next 2-3 years," he said.

"The response to the RFPs for establishing computing infrastructure has been very good. As many as 50 companies showed interest. That

should address the computing infrastructure issue," he added.

Talking to reporters on the sidelines of the two-day Global AI Summit that began here on Thursday, he said that the Mission launched an application development initiative where 14 problem statements were identified across the five themes of education, agri, healthcare, flood forecast, climate change, and governance.

"For each problem statement, we announced a prize money of ₹1 crore. The AI Mission has been approved. It backs all the seven key pillars including computing, foundational models, datasets, and start-ups. As many as eight out of 200 start-ups that submitted ideas to address some key challenges have been

identified for funding support," he said.

SEVEN PILLARS

Highlighting the seven pillars of the country's AI Vision, he said a key focus of the mission is to improve the country's computer infrastructure and provide affordable computing resources to start-ups, researchers, and students.

Though the country has about 5 lakh datasets, not many of them are usable (by AI companies), he said. "Many of these datasets are not AI-usable due to challenges related to data standardisation, privacy, and accessibility. To address this, a data management framework is being worked out. We will be working with various departments to make relevant data usable," he said.

US, Britain, EU to sign first international AI treaty

The first legally binding international AI treaty will be open for signing on Thursday by the countries that negotiated it, including European Union members, the United States and Britain, the Council of Europe human rights organisation said. The AI Convention addresses the risks AI may pose, while promoting responsible innovation. "This Convention is a major step to ensuring that these new technologies can be harnessed without eroding our oldest values, like human rights and the rule of law," Britain's justice minister, Shabana Mahmood, said.

The AI Convention mainly focuses on the protection of human rights of people affected by AI systems and is separate from the EU AI Act, which entered into force last month.
