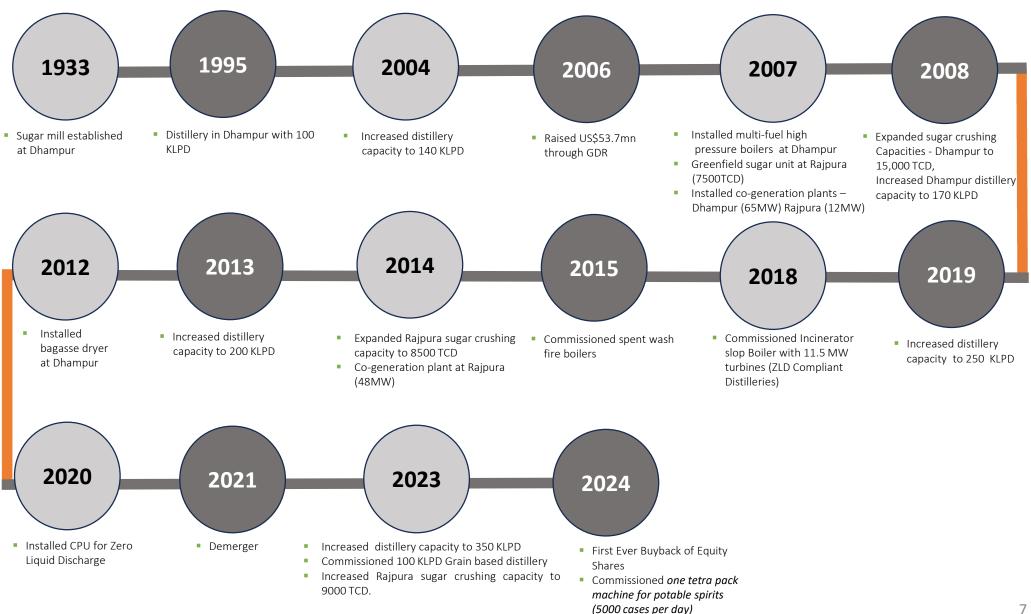

Shareholding Pattern





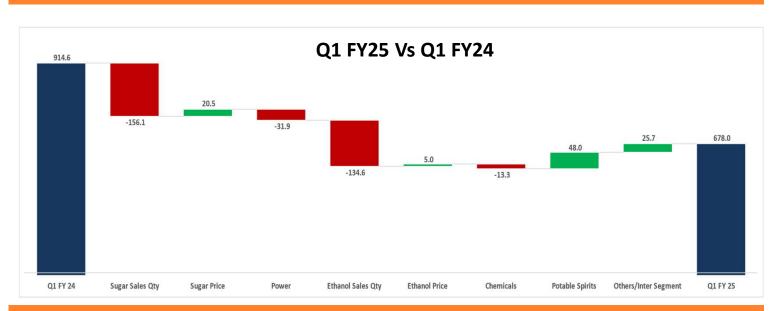

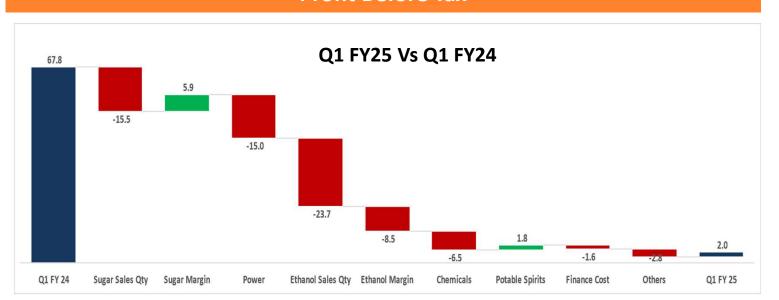




Revenue from Operations



Profit Before Tax

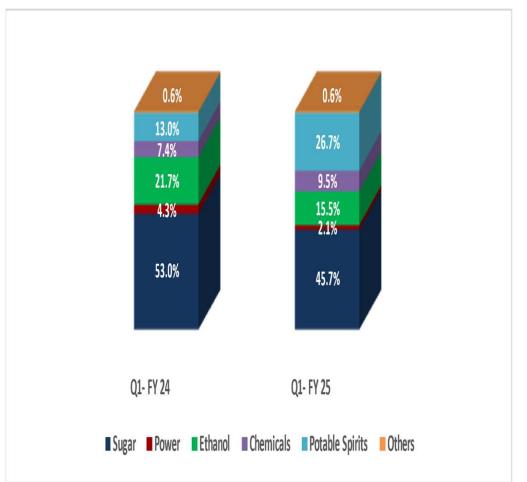


Major reasons for revenue drop:

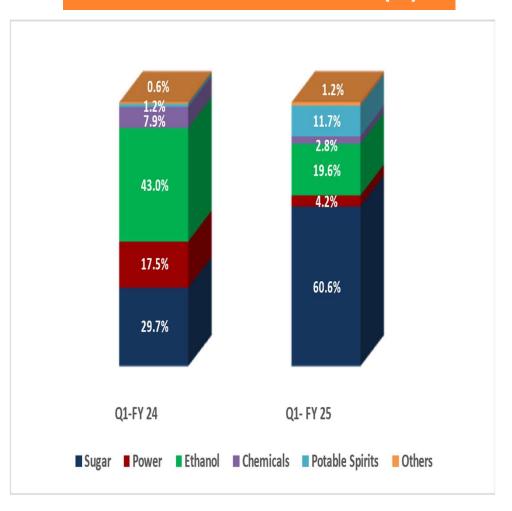
- Lower sugar sales volume Q1FY25 : 0.79 vs Q1FY24 1.22 lakh tons. Partly offset by higher sugar realization Q1FY25 : Rs. 38967/ton vs Q1 FY24 Rs. 36387/ton.
- Lower ethanol sales volume Q1FY25 145.12 lakh BL vs Q1FY24 357.45 lakh BL mainly due to ban of use of sugar cane syrup/BH molasses and lower cane crush.
- Lower power export caused by early closure of sugar season as a result of lower cane crush.

Drop in sugar sales quantity in Q1 FY 25 resulted in lower revenue share from sugar business vis a vis Q1 FY 24.

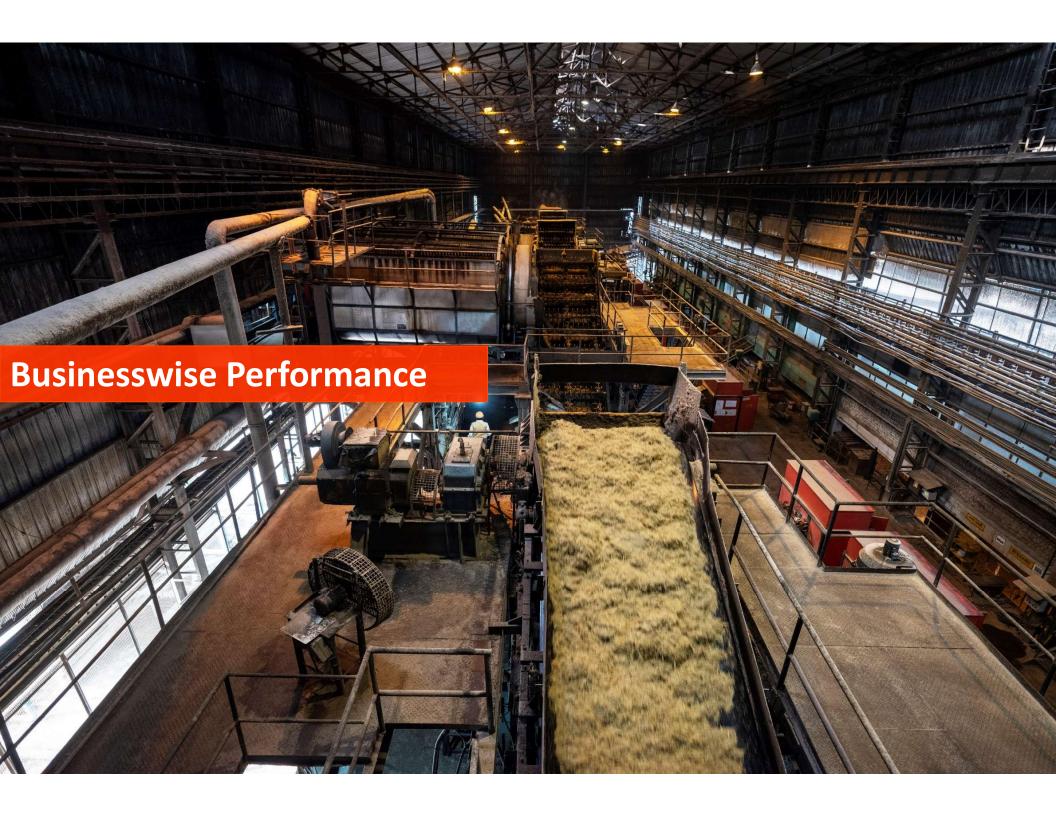
