# Cabinet extends ₹35k-cr plan to boost income of farmers

## Okays ₹24,500-Cr Rabi Fertiliser Subsidy

New Delhi: The govt on Wednesday approved the continuation of PM-Aasha, an umbrella scheme to ensure minimum support price (MSP) to farmers, and to subsidise phosphatic and potassic (P&K) fertilisers for the upcoming rabi season of 2024-25 with a cumulative outlay of nearly 60,000 crore.

While the Rs 35,000 crore for PM-Aasha aims to provide better prices to farmers and also control price volatility of essential commodities for consumers, the fertilizer subsidy will ensure supply of crop nutrients to farmers at affordable prices. The govt said rationalisation of subsidy on P&K fertilisers is in view of recent trends in the international prices of chemical nutrients and inputs.

Under the PM-Aasha move, the govt has now integrated Price Support scheme (PSS), Price Stabilisation Fund (PSF), Price Deficit Payment Scheme (PDPS) and Market Intervention Scheme (MIS) into one programme, and introduced some flexibility to procure higher quantity of oilseeds and pulses.

"The integrated scheme of PM-Aasha will bring in more effectiveness in the implementation which would not only help in providing remunerative prices to the farmers but also control the price volatility of essential commodities by ensuring their availability at affordable prices," an official state-

ment said. Under the PSS, procurement of notified pulses, oilseeds and copra at MSP will be 25% of national production from 2024-25 season onwards. This would enable states to procure more of these crops at MSP from farmers to prevent distress sale. "However, this ceiling will not be applicable to tur, urad and masoor for 2024-25 season as there will be a 100% procurement of tur, urad and masoor during this period," said the govt.

# Navy hi-tech drone junked in sea off Chennai after technical glitch

New Delhi: A top-notch MQ-9B Sea Guardian drone, an unarmed version leased by Navy from US firm General Atomics, had to be ditched into sea off Chennai after it encountered a technical failure on a routine surveillance mission in the Indian Ocean Region (IOR) on Wednesday afternoon.

The "controlled ditching" of the high-altitude, long-endurance remotely piloted aircraft (RPA) comes just when India is getting set to ink mega USD 3.9 billion (over Rs 33,500 crore) deal for 31 weaponised hunter-killer variants of the drone with the US next month, as was earlier reported by TOI.

The fighter-sized Sea Guardian operating from naval air base INS Rajali at Arakkonam, near Chennai, encountered technical failure around 2 pm. "There is a procedure to do a technical reset of the RPA in flight. It was tried but did not work. It was then navigated to a safe area over the sea and a controlled ditching at sea was carried out," an officer said.

Navy has sought report from General Atomics since company was "operating and maintaining" two leased Sea Guardians, which are variants of Predator or Reaper drones.

# 9 killed in north Maha during visarjan

Nashik: Nine people, including three children, were killed during immersion of Ganapati Idols in Nashik, Dhule and Jalgaon districts of north Maharashtra on Tuesday, the final day of Ganeshotsav, reports Santosh Sonawane.

In Dhule, a 25-year-old woman Gayatri Pawar and three young children—Laddu Pawra (3), Shera Sonawane (8), and Pari Bagul (15)—were killed, and five

others were injured after being hit by a tractor in the Ganapati procession. In Nashik, two men Omkar Gaote (23) and Sreyans More (24) drowned in Pathardi area. In Jalgaon, two brothers, Lokesh Patil (19) and Chaitanya Patil (22), drowned in Deepur area of Dhule city during the immersion procession. Meanwhile, 10-year-old Manoj Pawar drowned at an abandoned mining site.

# TISS pro-VC Shankar Das appointed interim VC of Pune's Gokhale Institute

Pune: Shankar Das, pro-vice chancellor at Tata Institute of Social Sciences, has been appointed interim vice chancellor (VC) of Pune's Gokhale Institute of Politics and Economics (GIPE) with effect from Sept 22.

GIPE chancellor Bibek Debroy said—in a letter dated Sept 15 to registrar Col Kapil Dheswar—Dr Das is the senior-most professor at the institute refused to take charge, Das was appointed interim VC, an official from GIPE said. "As per the rules, if the pro-VC is unavailable, the chancellor shall appoint the senior-most professor who shall per-

form the duties of the VC, until a new VC assumes office," the official said, quoting the letter.

As per the official, Debroy in his letter had stated that the senior-most professor of GIPE should be the interim VC, and accordingly, Debroy had requested Prof Deepak Shah. Since Shah refused, Das was appointed as the interim VC, the official said. On Sept 14, GIPE removed noted economist Ajit Ranade as its VC, ending months of controversy over his appointment after claims that he did not fulfil the eligibility criteria related to teaching experience.

# Kerala man who returned from UAE tests positive for Mpox

Kozhikode: A man from Edavanna panchayat in Kozhikode district, who had returned from UAE last week and was admitted to Manjeri govt medical college on Monday with symptoms of Mpox, has tested positive for the disease.

The zoonotic viral disease was confirmed in tests conducted at virology laboratory of Kozhikode govt medical college on Wednesday. According to health department officials, the man (38) had arrived from Dubai on an Air India Express flight on Sept 13 and, after

experiencing fever, headache, and body pain, he had sought treatment at a private hospital the same day. Seeing no improvement, he sought treatment at dermatology OP at Manjeri medical college on Sept 16.

After confirmation of Mpox, health department has arranged treatment and isolation facilities at 14 hospitals. Kerala health minister Veena George said people, including those arriving from abroad, should seek treatment if they have any symptoms and inform health department.

# Nashik couple ends life, child's body found with mouth taped

Nashik: A Nashik couple was Wednesday found hanging from the ceiling fan in their bedroom while the body of their nine-year-old daughter lay nearby with adhesive tape on her mouth, reports Santosh Sonawane. Police suspect the couple may have killed the child before ending their lives.

The deceased have been identified as 40-year-old Vijay Sahane, his wife Dnyaneshwari (32), and Ananya, resi-

dents of the city's Pathardi Pahatta area.

The incident came to light around 7am, when Vijay's father went to the upper floor room to call Ananya, as she had to leave for school. There was no response from inside the bedroom, the elderly man suspected something amiss and called the neighbours, who broke the door and called police. Vijay worked in a private company in Nashik.

# 3 on bike killed in crash with bus in Raigad

Navi Mumbai: Three youths were killed in a fatal road mishap on Pali-Khopoli highway stretch in Sudhagad taluka of Raigad on Wednesday, reports Umesh R. Parida.

The youths were riding on a single bike when their two-wheeler crashed with a school bus with 35 students onboard. The two-wheeler was heading towards Khopoli (Pune) while the school bus was moving towards Pali (Sudhagad). The youths have been identified as Vilas Gogare (30) and Navnath Jadhav (29) from Muthli taluka (Pune), and Manesh Waghmare (21) from Sudhagad taluka (Raigad). They were rushed to primary health centres Jambhulpada where doctors declared them brought dead. None of the school children were injured.
