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ANNEXURE - I

a) Brief details of the litigation viz. names of the opposing party, court/tribunal/agency where litigation is filed, brief details of dispute/litigation:	Name of the Defendant – (1) The Owners and Parties interested in the vessel M.V. PH GIANG MINH (IMO NO 9481623); (2) Dava Pte Ltd. Litigation is Filed – Before the Hon'ble High Court at Calcutta in its Admiralty Jurisdiction. Brief Details of the Litigation: The Company imported pulp from Indonesia and the goods arrived at Haldia Port on 25 th July,2024, upon arrival partial quantity was found damaged. The Company claimed the damage and filed an Admiralty Suit before the Hon'ble High Court at Calcutta to arrest and detain the vessel, M.V. PH GIANG MINH (IMO NO 9481623) which was carrying the goods. The Hon'ble High Court ordered the arrest and detention of the said vessel. The Court also ordered that in the event Defendants deposit an amount of Rs. 7 Cores as security on or before 12 th August,2024, this order of arrest shall stand automatically vacated. The next hearing is scheduled for 12th August, 2024.
b) expected financial implications, if any, due to compensation, penalty, etc.	There is no material impact on financial, operational or other activities of the Company due to the said order passed.
c) quantum of claims, if any	The Company claimed that the damaged 1312 MT of the Goods equivalent to INR 7.48 crores along with legal costs.
