

**AC blast sparks fire at Noida high-rise flat**

A fire broke out inside a flat in a posh high-rise society in Noida on Thursday morning, apparently due to a blast in an air conditioner in the house, officials said.

There were no casualties in the incident that took place at Lotus Boulevard society in Sector 100, they said.

Chief Fire Officer Pradeep Kumar Choubey said locals and society residents alerted the fire service about the incident in the flat on the 10th floor of the building at 10.10 am.

"We immediately rushed five vehicles (water tenders) to the spot. But before our vehicles could reach there, the firefighting systems installed in the society managed to put out the fire within 10 minutes," he said.

"The fire was triggered by a blast in the AC (air conditioner). Since the firefighting systems like sprinklers, extinguishers, hoses, were working fine, the fire did not spread out much and was contained in one room (of the flat)," Choubey said, adding that there was no loss of life or injury to any person in the episode.

Videos on social media showed heavy smoke billowing from the apartment in one of the residential towers of the society.

An "AC blast" generally refers to an explosion or fire involving an air conditioning (AC) unit.

Such incidents can occur due to various factors, often related to electrical or mechanical failures, according to officials.

**Worker dies after falling from under construction building**

A worker died after falling from an under-construction building in sector 150 of the Knowledge Park police station area.

Vipin Kumar, in-charge of the Knowledge Park police station, said that Ajay alias Netrapal son of Thun Singh, 28 years old, a resident of Alighar District, was working in the construction work of Antarisht Society located in sector 150.

He died on Wednesday night he fell down from a height while working in the said building and died in this incident. The further told that the Knowledge Park police station has taken the body in its custody and sent it for postmortem.

**Special anti-malaria campaign to begin from June 1**

The health department is going to launch special anti-malaria campaign here from June 1, 2024 to June 30, 2024.

CMO Sanjay Kumar Sharma said that in the campaign, health department workers will go door-to-door and investigate the affected areas. Along with this, surveillance will also be done in 50 nearby houses along with the family members of the houses where malaria patients have been found earlier.

He said that medicine will also be sprayed to prevent mosquito breeding at waterlogged places. The CMO further said that rapid response team will go to any place in case of malaria fever.

**Will write letter to Centre over non-release of Delhi's share of water by Haryana: Atishi**

Atishi said Delhi is staring at an "emergency situation" and announced a slew of emergency measures to tackle the crisis, including a ban on the use of drinking water for washing cars and at construction sites.

New Delhi: The Delhi government will approach the Supreme Court over Haryana not releasing the national capital's share of water, which has led to a crisis situation, Water Minister Atishi said on Thursday.

Addressing a press conference here, Atishi said Delhi is starting at an "emergency situation" and announced a slew of emergency measures to tackle the crisis, including a ban on the use of drinking water for washing cars and at construction sites.

The government held an emergency meeting regarding the water crisis that the city is facing amid a heat-wave.

"We are going to the Supreme Court so that the court tells Haryana and Uttar Pradesh, from where Delhi's water comes, that Delhi's share should get their rightful share of water. Apart from this, many emergency measures are being taken by the Delhi government," Atishi said.

He said a central water tanker control room is being set up in the Delhi Jal Board (DJB) and it will be monitored by an Indian Administrative Service (IAS) officer.

"There will be a central command and control centre. Any Delhi resident who wants a water tanker should dial 1916. From 1916, the request will go to our water tanker room and from there, tankers will be provided to places where there is a shortage of water supply," the minister added.

"We had announced on Wednesday itself that we are forming 200 enforcement teams of the DJB, which will check the water usage. A senior IAS officer is being appointed to head these teams. He will monitor these 200 teams and the challans issued by them," the minister said.

Further elaborating on the measures, he said there will be a complete ban on the use of potable water at construction sites, whether it comes from tankers, pipelines or borewells.

"We appeal to Delhiites to cooperate with the government. Use as little water as possible, do not waste water. Only when all Delhiites come together, we will be able to face this crisis," Atishi said.



"If any construction site is found using potable water, it will be sealed by the MCD," she said.

Atishi said the Municipal Corporation of Delhi's (MCD) enforcement teams will start visiting construction sites from Friday morning.

"There are many car-repair and car-wash centres that use potable water supplied by the DJB via the drinking water pipeline. The use of drinking water to wash cars and at car-repair centres is being completely banned."

From Friday, DPCC (Delhi Pollution Control Committee) teams will be on the ground to inspect car-wash and car-service centres. If any such centre is found using drinking water, it will be sealed immediately," the Aam Aadmi Party (AAP) leader said.

Delhi is "going through an emergency situation", she said while attributing it to the heatwave in the national capital and Haryana not releasing water from the Yamuna river.

"We appeal to Delhiites to cooperate with the government. Use as little water as possible, do not waste water. Only when all Delhiites come together, we will be able to face this crisis," Atishi said.

Delhi Health Minister Saurabh Bharadwaj said the health and water departments will play the most important role during this heat-wave. "But the health department's secretary and the CEO of the DJB have gone on leave without informing their ministers and without taking permission from them."

"We do not even know the reason why they have taken leave. The people of Delhi should be our priority. The chief secretary told Thursday's meeting that he has given leave to both of them. The chief secretary is giving leave to the head of such an important department on his own without informing the minister. This is surprising and unfortunate," he said.

Bharadwaj said they will tell the apex court that if there is any possibility of getting water from the neighbouring states, the states should provide water to Delhi for a few days.

"If we get at least 50 MGD (million gallons per day) water in the Wazirabad pond, it will provide some relief," he said.

The capital is facing a water shortage due to unprecedented summer heat, with temperatures hovering around the 50 degree-Celsius mark in parts of the city.

Delhi CM Kejriwal Faces Health Crisis Amid ED Custody

New Delhi: Delhi minister Atishi on Thursday said the ED has opposed Chief Minister Arvind Kejriwal's plea on medical grounds, as she questioned the probe agency's stand and asked it why it was not allowing the politician to undergo tests as has been suggested by his doctors.

Addressing a press conference, Atishi said Kejriwal experienced sudden and unexplained weight loss during the Enforcement Directorate custody and in judicial custody.

"Delhi Chief Minister Arvind Kejriwal filed an application for seven-day interim bail at the Rouse Avenue Court. He sought an extension to the bail for his health check-ups, because during his ED custody, he lost 6-7 kg of his weight. Such sudden and unexplained weight loss is an indicator of several serious diseases."

Delhi BJP chief Virendra Sachdeva on Thursday blamed the AAP government for the water crisis in Delhi and claimed that Haryana is supplying 1.0-0.99 cusecs of Yamuna water to the city, which he said exceeds the agreed-upon water sharing amount.

Sachdeva's statement came in response to Water Minister Atishi who has accused the BJP-ruled Haryana of stopping Delhi's share of Yamuna water, causing shortage in many parts of the city.

The national capital is facing water shortage due to unprecedented summer heat with temperatures hovering around the 50 degrees Celsius mark in parts of the city.
