Dear Sir/Madam,

This is in continuation to our letter no. SEIL/Sec./SE/2024-25/44 dated August 10, 2024, intimating about a Record of Proceedings from Supreme Court in the matter of Petition(s) for Special Leave to Appeal No(s). 6706/2023 filed by the Deputy Commissioner of Income Tax arising out of impugned final judgment and order dated 21-02-2023 in C/SCA/2713/2023 passed by the High Court of Judicature at Ahmedabad. The Company further informed that the Supreme Court allowed the Special Leave Petition and reserved judgement in the matter.

In this regard, the Company wishes to inform about the new development in the above matter wherein the Supreme Court of India has passed the Order dated October 3, 2024 in favor of Income Tax Department, reversing the decision of the Gujarat High Court (& other High Courts) and held that the notice issued for assessment year 2014-15 is within limitation period. Accordingly, the assessing officer will take the necessary action for the assessment year 2014-15 in terms of the law laid down in the Order passed by the Supreme Court.

The Company shall evaluate the appropriate legal remedy, if required.

We will keep the exchanges informed on subsequent update on the matter.
