SUMMARY OF THE PROCEEDINGS OF THE POSTAL BALLOT IN CONNECTION WITH SPECIAL RESOLUTION APPROVED BY THE SHAREHOLDERS OF BERGER PAINTS INDIA LIMITED ON 17TH SEPTEMBER, 2024

The Board of Directors of the Company, vide resolution passed on 9th August, 2024, decided to obtain consent of the Members through Postal Ballot under Section 110 of the Companies Act, 2013 read with Rule 20 and 22 of the Companies (Management and Administration) Rules, 2014 and relevant circulars as issued by the Ministry of Corporate Affairs from time-to-time, in respect of the Special Resolution for 'Amendment in Berger Paints India Limited Employee Stock Option Plan 2016'

The Postal Ballot Notices were sent to the Members whose names appeared on the Register of Members / List of Beneficial Owners as received from the National Securities Depository Limited (NSDL) and Central Depository Services (India) Limited (CDSL). The Company had on 16th August, 2024 completed the dispatch of the Postal Ballot Notice. Members whose names appeared on the Register of Members / List of Beneficial Owners as on Friday, 9th August, 2024 i.e. the cut-off date, were eligible for the purpose of voting.

The Company had made arrangements for e-voting and availed the services of National Securities Depository Limited (NSDL) to provide the facility to the Members for e-voting. Members whose names appeared on the Register of Members / List of Beneficial Owners as on Friday, 9th August, 2024 i.e. the cut-off date, were considered eligible for the purpose of voting. In view of prevailing MCA Circulars on postal ballot process, the voting on the resolution covered in the Postal Ballot Notice took place through remote e-voting only and no physical ballot was used. The voting period commenced on Monday, 19th August, 2024 at 9.00 a.m. and ended on Tuesday, 17th September, 2024 at 5.00 p.m. (inclusive of both the days). The e-voting module was disabled by NSDL at 5.00 p.m. on 17th September, 2024.

The Company had appointed Mr Atul Kumar Labh (FCS -4848/CP-3238), Practicing Company Secretary of M/s A.K. Labh & Co., Company Secretaries as the Scrutinizer for conducting the Postal Ballot process in a fair and transparent manner. The Scrutinizer submitted his report to the Company Secretary after completion of e-voting process.

Dear Sir,

- (1) We have been appointed as Scrutinizer by the Company in connection with Postal Ballot conducted in terms of MCA Circular No. 14/2020 dated 8th April, 2020, MCA Circular No. 17/2020 dated 13th April, 2020, MCA Circular No. 22/2020 dated 15th June, 2020, MCA Circular No. 33/2020 dated 28th September, 2020, MCA Circular No. 39/2020 dated 31st December, 2020, MCA Circular No. 10/2021 dated 23rd June, 2021, MCA Circular No. 20/2021 dated 8th December, 2021, MCA Circular No. 3/2022 dated 5th May, 2022, MCA Circular No. 11/2022 dated 28th December, 2022 and MCA Circular No. 09/2023 dated 25th September, 2023 (collectively referred as "MCA Circulars") for the purpose of scrutinizing the electronic voting process through remote e-voting ("e-voting") in a fair and transparent manner in terms of the resolution of the Board of Directors of the Company dated 9th August, 2024.
- (2) The management of the Company is responsible to ensure the compliance with the requirements of the Companies Act, 2013, MCA Circulars and Rules relating to e-voting on the resolution contained in the Notice of Postal Ballot dated 9th August, 2024. Our responsibility as a scrutinizer for the voting process through e-voting is restricted to make a Scrutinizer's Report of the votes cast "in favour" or "against" the resolution, based on the reports generated from the e-voting system of National Securities Depository Limited ("NSDL"), the agency engaged by the Company to provide e-voting facility.
- (3) We submit our report as under:
 - (a) The Company has completed dispatch of the Notice of Postal Ballot through electronic mode on 16th August, 2024 to its Members, whose name(s) appeared on the Register of Members / list of beneficiaries as on the close of business hours on 9th August, 2024.
 - (b) Members were provided the opportunity to cast their vote(s) through electronic voting system in terms of the platform as provided by NSDL e-voting system (<u>www.evoting.nsdl.com</u>).
 - (c) The e-voting period remained open from 09:00 A.M. IST on Monday, 19th August, 2024 up to 5:00 P.M. IST on Tuesday, 17th September, 2024.











- (d) The shareholders holding shares as on the "cut off" date, i.e. Friday, 9th August, 2024 were entitled to vote on the proposed resolution as mentioned in the Notice of Postal Ballot dated 9th August, 2024.
- (e) The result of the e-voting was downloaded after 5:00 p.m. on Tuesday, 17th September, 2024 from NSDL website providing the platform for e-voting system (<u>www.evoting.nsdl.com</u>) and were unblocked in the presence of two witnesses, namely, Mr. Rohit Kumar, residing at Basundhara Apartment, Flat No. 6, 3rd Floor, 1 No. Airport, North 24 Parganas, Kolkata 700079 and Mrs. Anushree Dasgupta, residing at 28/N, Dwijen Mukherjee Road, Behala, Kolkata 700060, and has been included in our report.

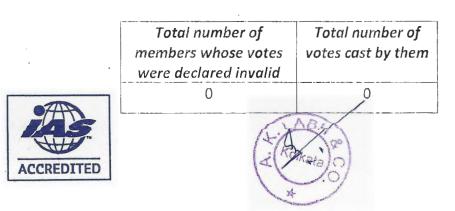
